

June 11, 2016, Notes for the Bible Study on His Word (Seed), and Evening Prayer Call

Tonight I would like to review a Word of God that many know very well, the Word of God "Seed". I would like to do this by looking at the example of how the Lord prepares the Way for us to receive the Word. It is the Work of the Word "Seed". I would like to point out that we are to be Seed planters and tillers of the earth. All of us are made from the dust of the Dry Land called as Earth that came forth from the Waters. And we were made to bear fruit and to bring forth the Seed that God has given each of us.

Genesis 1:9-13 ⁹Then God said, "Let the waters under the heavens be gathered together into one place, and let the dry land appear"; and it was so. ¹⁰And God called the dry land Earth, and the gathering together of the waters He called Seas. And God saw that it was Good. ¹¹Then God said, "Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb that yields seed, and the fruit tree that yields fruit according to its kind, whose seed is in itself, on the earth"; and it was so. ¹²And the earth brought forth grass, the herb that yields seed according to its kind, and the tree that yields fruit, whose seed is in itself according to its kind. And God saw that it was Good. ¹³So the evening and the morning were the third day.

There are many ways to consider the Word of God "Seed". We should know about the Seed of the Word, and the Way of the Seed of the food that we plant. In the Parable of the Sower the Lord reveals the Way of the Word of God "Seed". He says that the Seed is the Word of God. Do you see that there is a difference between God's Words in the Bible versus the entirety of the words in the Bible? We should, if we know our Lord. If you know the Word and you listen to His Voice you will not go hungry and be starved in the Day of Trouble.

Mark 4:14 ¹⁴"The sower sows the Word."

Luke 8:11-15 ¹¹"Now the parable is this: THE SEED IS THE WORD OF GOD."

John 8:43-47 ⁴³Why do you not understand My Speech? BECAUSE YOU ARE NOT ABLE TO LISTEN TO MY WORD. ⁴⁴You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, AND DOES NOT STAND IN THE TRUTH, BECAUSE THERE IS NO TRUTH IN HIM. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, FOR HE IS A LIAR AND THE FATHER OF IT. ⁴⁵But because I tell the Truth, you do not believe Me. ⁴⁶Which of you convicts Me of sin? And if I tell the Truth, why do you not believe Me? ⁴⁷He who is of God hears God's Words; therefore, you do not hear, because you are not of God."

John 8:31-32 ³¹Then Jesus said to those Jews WHO BELIEVED HIM, "If you abide in My Word, you are My disciples indeed. ³²And you shall know the Truth, and the Truth shall make you free." (*In the Day of the Famine of the Word, those with His Word will not go hungry for they have the Word that is the Seed from which all food is brought forth and as it states in Revelation 12:16-17 the Earth will open its mouth and help God's Wisdom, and His Words are the Words of Wisdom.*)

Think on that very carefully and it should bring you to some very interesting meditation. We are taught in Psalm 33:4 that all His Works are done in Truth (*Everything that He made is made in Truth*). We are taught in Psalm 119:160 that the entirety of His Word – God's Words that the Lord always speaks in the Ways of – are Truth. And we are told in Psalm 119:142 that His Truth is Law. And this is further confirmed in Isaiah 55:11 when He says that his Words that He sends forth never come back to Him void. The Lord

makes it clear that we are to teach His Words to all the people on the earth. Tonight I would like to talk about that process so that we can see it in our minds. And we should consider how the Lord sees us right now, for I think we should see that the vast majority do not know the Way of planting the Seed of God's Words, for we have not heard of His Words.

Psalm 33:4 For the Word of the Lord is right, and **ALL HIS WORK IS IN TRUTH.**

Isaiah 55:11 ¹¹“**So shall My Word be that goes forth out of My Mouth: it shall not return unto Me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.**”

Psalm 119:103 How sweet are Your Words to my taste, sweeter than honey to my mouth!

Psalm 119:130 The entrance of Your Words gives Light; it gives Understanding to the simple.

Hosea 4:6 “**My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. Because you have rejected knowledge, I also will reject you from being a priest before Me because you have forgotten the Law of your God I also will forget your children.**” (*To reject the Knowledge of His Words when the Father causes it to be received is lawlessness.*)

John 12:48-49 ⁴⁸“He who rejects Me, and does not receive My Words, has that which judges him—the Word that I have spoken will judge him in the last Day.”

Hosea 6:5 ⁵Therefore I have hewn them by the prophets, I have slain them by the Words of My mouth; and **your Judgments are like Light that goes forth.**

Now add to this that all Seed is His Word. He is Omnipresent and His Spirit inhabits all things. Therefore, we can understand that when He tells us that the earth will be Holy for us, and we are told that His Seed that is planted in the Ways of Righteousness will not come back void but will accomplish that thing for which it was sent to do, then powerful capabilities come to those who desire to do the Will of God in the bringing forth His Words in manners that bless Him with Good for others, while also Glorifying the Father. If you are trying to plant the “Seed” of the Word of God into people, then there is nothing better to use than allowing the Lord to bring forth the multiplication of food for the Seed is Food for the Soul, and in the Ways of feeding the body you are showing the Way that the Seed of the Word is put into people. If they eat of the earth to be strengthened, then how much more will they be strengthened to eat to their full of the Spirit of God that inhabits His Word. The food came forth by the seed. You can call the SEED forth in its fullness of the Spirit to do Good Works. Not to fulfill your ego, or selfish desires, but to do the Kingdom Work of God. Do not test God with selfish glorification or you the famine of His Words will come upon you, for He will remove your garment and confuse your mind. It is time for His Kingdom to reign and not ours.

John 15:7 ⁷“**If you abide in Me, and My Words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, AND IT SHALL BE DONE FOR YOU.**” (*Again think about this great promise. Nothing is impossible for those who know the Law of God and who have understanding of His Words. In Psalm 119:130 and John 3:34 we are told His Words come with the full measure of God's Spirit.*)

1 John 5:14-15 ¹⁴Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything **according to His Will**, He hears us. ¹⁵And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him. (*Consider what this is saying. If we keep His Law, then we can know He will hear us. And, ALSO, if we have understanding of His Words and desire to enable Good Works for others for the Glory of the Kingdom of God, then we know that we are walking in His Will. If we know the Law of God that spells out His Unbreakable Parameters, and if we also know the Words that He set apart with Greater Promises when spoken in the Ways of His Pure Language that He has shown to us within the Scriptures. And we know that His Will is for all His generations to be prepared and brought into the*

Kingdom of God by the Law of God and their being doers of His Good Works so that His Name is Glorified before all mankind and before all the Creation.)

Micah 6:8 ⁸He has shown you, O man, **what is Good**; and **what does the LORD require of you but to do justly**, (*Do we know the Law of God, and are we keeping it in reality? Do we know whether we know the Law of God and have taught it to our own family? How do we do justly if we have not made known the reality of the Law of God to our children?*) **TO LOVE MERCY**, **and to walk humbly with your God?**

Here is the Parable of the Sower of the Seed. Parables About the Kingdom of Heaven (*Matthew 13:1-9; Mark 4:1-9; Luke 8:4-8*)

Matthew 13:1-9 ¹On the same day Jesus went out of the house and sat by the sea. ²And great multitudes were gathered together to Him, so that He got into a boat and sat; and the whole multitude stood on the shore. ³Then He spoke many things to them in parables, saying: “Behold, a sower went out to sow. ⁴And as he sowed, some seed fell by the wayside; and the birds came and devoured them. ⁵Some fell on stony places, where they did not have much earth; and they immediately sprang up because they had no depth of earth. ⁶But when the sun was up they were scorched, and because they had no root they withered away. ⁷And some fell among thorns, and the thorns sprang up and choked them. ⁸But others fell on good ground and yielded a crop: some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty. ⁹He who has ears to hear, let him hear!”

Mark 4:1-9 ¹And again He began to teach by the sea. And a great multitude was gathered to Him, so that He got into a boat and sat in it on the sea; and the whole multitude was on the land facing the sea. ²Then He taught them many things by parables, and said to them in His teaching: ³“Listen! Behold, a sower went out to sow. ⁴And it happened, as he sowed, that some seed fell by the wayside; and the birds of the air came and devoured it. ⁵Some fell on stony ground, where it did not have much earth; and immediately it sprang up because it had no depth of earth. ⁶But when the sun was up it was scorched, and because it had no root it withered away. ⁷And some seed fell among thorns; and the thorns grew up and choked it, and it yielded no crop. ⁸But other seed fell on good ground and yielded a crop that sprang up, increased and produced: some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some a hundred.” ⁹And He said to them, “He who has ears to hear, let him hear!”

Luke 8:4-8 ⁴And when a great multitude had gathered, and they had come to Him from every city, He spoke by a parable: ⁵“A sower went out to sow his seed. And as he sowed, some fell by the wayside; and it was trampled down, and the birds of the air devoured it. ⁶Some fell on rock; and as soon as it sprang up, it withered away because it lacked moisture. ⁷And some fell among thorns, and the thorns sprang up with it and choked it. ⁸But others fell on good ground, sprang up, and yielded a crop a hundredfold.” When He had said these things He cried, “He who has ears to hear, let him hear!”


The Parable of the Sower Explained (*Matthew 13:18-23; Mark 4:13-20; Luke 8:11-15*)

Matthew 13:18-23 ¹⁸“Therefore hear the parable of the sower: ¹⁹When anyone hears the Word of the kingdom, and does not understand it, then the wicked one comes and snatches away what was sown in his heart. This is he who received Seed by the wayside. ²⁰But he who received the Seed on stony places, this is he who hears the Word and immediately receives it with joy; ²¹yet he has no root in himself, but endures only for a while. For when tribulation or persecution arises because of the Word, immediately he stumbles. ²²Now he who received Seed among the thorns is he who hears the Word, and the cares of this world and the deceitfulness of riches choke the Word, and he becomes unfruitful. ²³But he who received Seed on the Good Ground is he who hears the Word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit and produces: some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty.”

Mark 4:13-20 ¹³And He said to them, “Do you not understand this parable? How then will you understand all the parables? ¹⁴**The sower sows the Word.** ¹⁵And these are the ones by the wayside where the Word is sown. When they hear, Satan comes immediately and takes away the Word that was sown in their hearts. ¹⁶These likewise are the ones sown on stony ground who, when they hear the Word, immediately receive it with gladness; ¹⁷and they have no root in themselves, and so endure only for a time. Afterward, when tribulation or persecution arises for the Word's sake, immediately they stumble. ¹⁸Now these are the ones sown among thorns; they are the ones who hear the Word, ¹⁹and the cares of this world, the deceitfulness of riches, and the desires for other things entering in choke the Word, and it becomes unfruitful. ²⁰But these are the ones sown on Good Ground, those who hear the Word, accept it, and bear fruit: some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some a hundred.”

Luke 8:11-15 ¹¹“**Now the parable is this: THE SEED IS THE WORD OF GOD.** ¹²Those by the wayside are the ones who hear; then the devil comes and takes away the Word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved. ¹³But the ones on the rock are those who, when they hear, receive the Word with joy; and these have no root, who believe for a while and in time of temptation fall away. ¹⁴Now the ones that fell among thorns are those who, when they have heard, go out and are choked with cares, riches, and pleasures of life, and bring no fruit to maturity. ¹⁵But the ones that fell on the Good Ground are those who, having heard the Word with a noble and Good heart, keep it and bear fruit with patience.”

From the beginning the Lord made it known that it is the entrance of the Words of God that gives Light and Understanding (*Psalm 119:130*); but the Light cannot be mixed with the words of the Darkness (*The words of the world that satan brought forth to Eve and then to Adam, and rooted it in the seed.*). From the beginning the Lord desired that He would teach all of us by the entrance of the Spirit of Truth, but the Spirit of Truth is Holy and cannot enter into anyone who is not set apart from the world (*John 14:15-17*). And in John 17:17 the Lord confirmed that it is through our setting ourselves apart from the world by receiving the entrance of the Words of God that we are able to be of God's Truth (*See John 8:43-47*). If we were of the Kingdom of God, and enabled it to come forth on earth as it is in Heaven, then we would be taught by the Lord. But, that was lost in the fall from the Garden. However, the Lord is desiring that we come back to that way, where He teaches us, and then we all gather together and stir up love and Good Works. But, we are taught by God speaking to us in the cool of the Day. In Joel 2:3 and Ezekiel 36:35 we are told that the likeness of the Garden of Eden is before us. That means we must come to that structure. Here is the old structure of the Kingdom of God that the Lord established in His people Israel:



The Way of the Transition Day – The Purpose of the 30th Day

Take notice that the Lord also made it the Law that the Firstborn are to take on the responsibility of carrying on the Work of the Kingdom that is given to the Family. This is the Transition Work of the Kingdom. Six times a year the Lord establishes for us a 30th Day to His Calendar. The number 30 is the number of the Work of being prepared to do the ministry of taking the knowledge of His Words to the world. It is to reflect upon the Way of carrying out the Transition of His Words of Truth. And seven times in 19 years He adds a 30-day month that gives an extra transition day. The number 19 is the number of the earth. This is worth some strong meditation to discern the wonder of it –
A blessing for the wise.

The new structure is to be the Lord direct to us, and we gather together and spread the Good News. The Temple veil is torn. There will be teachers and etc. But, in the old system, people had to go through the priests to get His Word, and the High Priest was only able to come into the Holy of Holies once a year. But, the Lord always intervened out of necessity, for the Priestly system, as like the shepherd system of this day would not hear of His Words, and they have turned His Good News into basically a message of prosperity that is without power. Words, in the Time of the judgment of God there will be a famine of the Word and all the shepherds and goatherds who would not hear Him will see a time of great struggle. Now is the time to gather the food of the kingdom so that there will be food in the coming famine that is promised by God (*John 9:4-5, Amos 8:11-14, and Revelation 6:5-6*).

We are required to teach the knowledge of Truth to our families, but not just our family. The Lord says that we are to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children and the hearts of the children to their fathers, and that if we fail to do this in this very time, then the Lord promises that He will come and He will curse the earth so that there is no blessing coming forth (*Malachi 4:6*). This is especially true in this summer when we are to gather the food; or the Bible makes known that we will not have any food in the Fall. Forget making it to Winter, the bible is revealing that we will be out by the Fall. The seed should have been planted in the Fall for a Spring harvest or by the first of Spring for a summer harvest.

James 5:19-20 ¹⁹Brethren, if anyone among you wanders from the truth, and someone turns him back, ²⁰let him know that he who turns a sinner from the error of his way will save a soul from death and cover a multitude of sins.

Malachi 4:1-6 ¹"For behold, the Day is coming, burning like an oven, and all the proud, yes, all who do wickedly will be stubble. And the day which is coming shall burn them up," says the LORD of hosts, "That will leave them neither root nor branch. ²But to you who fear My Name the Sun of Righteousness shall arise with healing in His wings; and you shall go out and grow fat like stall-fed calves. ³You shall trample the wicked, for they shall be ashes (*As the dust of the earth.*) under the soles of your feet on the day that I do this," says the LORD of hosts. ⁴"Remember the Law of Moses, My servant, which I commanded him in Horeb for all Israel, with the statutes and judgments. ⁵Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet (*The name of Elijah – the work of Elijah - means to make known that "the Lord our God is a strong God". Most translate Elijah as: "God the Lord, the strong Lord", or simply "The Lord (YHWH) is God".*) **before the coming of the great and dreadful Day of the LORD** (*His Day of Rest is dreadful for those who were not prepared and were thus not able to enter His Rest, and instead they were cast out with the wicked to be burned by the Ways that they rejected to receive His Words of Wisdom when the Light had still been available to them.*). ⁶**And he will turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the hearts of the children to their fathers, lest I come and strike the earth with a curse.**"

This is especially true in this summer when we are to gather the food; or the Bible makes known that we will not have any food in the Fall. Forget making it to Winter, the Bible is revealing that we will be out by the Fall. In Proverbs 6:6-8, the wise King Solomon advises the lukewarm and the lazy ones to go and observe the ant.

Proverbs 6:6-11 ⁶**Go to the ant, you sluggard! Consider her ways and be wise, ⁷which, having no captain, overseer or ruler, ⁸provides her supplies in the summer, and gathers her food in the harvest.** ⁹How long will you slumber, O sluggard?



When will you rise from your sleep? ¹⁰A little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to sleep— ¹¹So shall your poverty come on you like a prowler, and your need like an armed man.

Proverbs 30: 24-28 ²⁴There are four things which are little on the earth, but they are exceedingly wise: ²⁵The ants are a people not strong, yet they prepare their food in the summer; ²⁶the rock badgers are a feeble folk, yet they make their homes in the crags; ²⁷the locusts have no king, yet they all advance in ranks; ²⁸the spider (or lizard) skillfully grasps with its hands, and it is in kings' palaces.

Take notice that Solomon says that the ant is very wise and that we should take note of it. Why?

It is because the ant does not live its life working for the present generation, but it works for the ant kingdom to succeed into the future regardless of what might come, to the best of its ability.

An ant's life is typically about six months of time. It spends the entire summer gathering kernels such as wheat, barley, and beans. It gathers so much that when an ant hill is opened up there is usually found a huge supply of kernels. Yet, it is said that within its six months of lifetime, a single ant will only eat about a kernel and a half of wheat. It is always preparing for the generations to follow it, as well as for the survival of its colony against natural issues, such as floods, etc.

We are so busy using the resources of the world that we can gain, that we do not prepare the food that will enable the Kingdom of God to be strong and provide strength for those to come.

In Isaiah 40:22 the Lord says that His people are like grasshoppers. Consider what that means. A grasshopper is related to the locust family. And satan wants us to be like grasshoppers, and not like ants. Grasshoppers and locusts do not actually have a king. The grasshopper just goes forth eating whatever the harlot puts in front of it. Today we are like grasshoppers, for the Lord has ruled that all the kings and leaders of this day have had their authority to rule removed from them, so those that are ruling are doing so by pure military strength and bullying of others by deception, lies, oppression, and murder. I have heard people of the Crowne Trust say that the people cannot stop eating the candy. We swallow whatever they feed us. We are like grasshoppers, and many of us are like locusts. The people – the grasshoppers – do not look up and see the troubles coming. They are only interested in being grasshoppers.



His Knowledge Law and the Prophecy of the Ant



*There is a Law that must be kept to Receive His Food.
The Ant bears witness of His Prophecy of Summer Food.*

*Proverbs 6:6-8 Go to the ant, O sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise.
Without having any chief, officer, or ruler, she prepares her bread in summer and gathers her food in harvest.
Proverbs 30:24-25 Four things on earth are small, but they are exceedingly wise: the ants are a people not strong, yet they provide their food in the summer;
Genesis 3:19a "In the sweat of your face you shall eat bread..."
Isaiah 28:9-13 "Whom will He teach knowledge? And whom will He make to understand the message? Those just weaned from milk? Those just drawn from the breasts? For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept, Line upon line, line upon line, here a little, there a little." For with stammering lips and another tongue He will speak to this people.*

The lukewarm and complacent grasshopper, is the opposite of the wise ant. The grasshopper, instead of saving its food for the future, is constantly involved in eating, in the present. That is what the Lord says in Isaiah 40:22 that He sees us doing. Thus, the grasshopper is symbolic of those who think only of the here and now, materialistically. This is why the verse in this week's portion refers to grasshoppers.

Psalm 14:2-3, & Psalm 53:2-3 ²The Lord looks down from Heaven upon the children of men, to see if there are any who understand, **WHO SEEK GOD.** ³They have all turned aside, they have together become corrupt; **THERE IS NONE THAT DOES "GOOD", NO, NOT ONE.**

Isaiah 40:1-31 ¹"Comfort, yes, comfort My people!" Says your God. ²"Speak comfort to Jerusalem, and cry out to her, that her warfare is ended, that her iniquity is pardoned; for she has received from the LORD's hand double for all her sins." ³The voice of one crying in the wilderness: "Prepare the way of the LORD; make straight in the desert a highway for our God. ⁴Every valley shall be exalted and every mountain and hill brought low; the crooked places shall be made straight and the rough places smooth; ⁵the glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together; for the mouth of the LORD has spoken." ⁶The voice said, "Cry out!" And he said, "What shall I cry?" "All flesh is grass, and all its loveliness is like the flower of the field. ⁷The grass withers, the flower fades, because the breath of the LORD blows upon it; surely the people are grass. ⁸The grass withers, the flower fades, but the Word of our God stands forever." ⁹O Zion, you who bring Good tidings, get up into the high mountain; O Jerusalem, you who bring Good tidings, lift up your voice with strength, lift it up, be not afraid; say to the cities of Judah, "Behold your God!" ¹⁰Behold, the Lord GOD shall come with a strong hand, and His arm shall rule for Him; behold, His reward is with Him, and His work before Him. ¹¹He will feed His flock like a shepherd; He will gather the lambs with His arm, and carry them in His bosom, and gently lead those who are with young. ¹²Who has measured the waters in the hollow of His hand, measured heaven with a span and calculated the dust of the earth in a measure? Weighed the mountains in scales and the hills in a balance? ¹³Who has directed the Spirit of the LORD, or as His counselor has taught Him? ¹⁴With whom did He take counsel, and who instructed Him, and taught Him in the path of justice? Who taught Him knowledge, and showed Him the way of understanding? ¹⁵Behold, the nations are as a drop in a bucket, and are counted as the small dust on the scales; look, He lifts up the isles as a very little thing. ¹⁶And Lebanon is not sufficient to burn, nor its beasts sufficient for a burnt offering. ¹⁷All nations before Him are as nothing, and they are counted by Him less than nothing and worthless. ¹⁸To whom then will you liken God? Or what likeness will you compare to Him? ¹⁹The workman molds an image, the goldsmith overspreads it with gold, and the silversmith casts silver chains. ²⁰Whoever is too impoverished for such a contribution chooses a tree that will not rot; He seeks for himself a skillful workman to prepare a carved image that will not totter. ²¹Have you not known? Have you not heard? Has it not been told you from the beginning? Have you not understood from the foundations of the earth? ²²It is He who sits above the circle of the earth (The earth is not a Sphere, but a

Circle, in other words it is a flat earth.), **AND ITS INHABITANTS ARE LIKE GRASSHOPPERS,** who stretches out the heavens like a curtain (Take notice that this is not describing the dome that is above the earth as being the Heavens, for the dome of the ionosphere, etc., are not in the shape of a curtain, but rather they are exactly like the shape of a dome that exists inside of this first (Or bottom Heaven) that is called as the World.), **and spreads them out like a tent to dwell in** (This is the Pyramid shape, as I have explained in the book "A Testimony of Numbers". There are four Heavens inside this Pyramid called the Firmament. The Firmament is hardened like a cast iron mirror (The Firmament has physical walls) as is told in the book of Job. As Ezekiel explains in Ezekiel 1, the Firmament comes to a point just underneath the Throne of God, and the Bible Reveals that the

Throne of God is at the very middle of all things, thus, of all the Creation.). ²³He brings the princes to nothing; **He makes the judges of the earth useless.** (*The judges do not have jurisdiction; for God alone owns all things and holds the solidary right to all Jurisdiction. Nor do the judges have the right to make any ruling over anything without His permission, for He alone holds the copyright on all things, even to the souls of the judges. And that right has been removed from them since April 2003.*) ²⁴Scarcely shall they be planted, scarcely shall they be sown, scarcely shall their stock take root in the earth, when He will also blow on them, and they will wither (*He is going to send forth His plague of Ta'zarat upon them that will wither their limbs worse than leprosy. Judges and lawyers need to zealously consider His instruction to them that is found in Luke 16:1-13, for they are in grave trouble as he has already judged them from the Judgment Throne and He is about to execute the Separation Judgment that is of the Night and will occur before the dawn of the Morning of His Day. Thus, their time is very short.*), and the whirlwind will take them away like stubble. ²⁵"To whom then will you liken Me, or to whom shall I be equal?" says the Holy One. ²⁶Lift up your eyes on high, and see who has created these things, Who brings out their host by number; He calls them all by name, by the greatness of His might and the strength of His power; not one is missing. ²⁷Why do you say, O Jacob, and speak, O Israel: "My way is hidden from the LORD, and my just claim is passed over by my God"? ²⁸Have you not known? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth, neither faints nor is weary. His understanding is unsearchable. ²⁹He gives power to the weak, and to those who have no might He increases strength. ³⁰Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall, ³¹but those who wait on the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.

Consider that the Moses records in number 13:33 that the spies that he sent to look over the Promised Land came back and reported that they were like grasshoppers in the vineyard to the giants in the Promised Land. They declared themselves to be as grasshoppers and not like the wise ants. They did not believe in the Seed of the Word that the planted in them at Mount Sinai on what we now call as Pentecost. The result was the Father punished them and that entire generation of adults except for the family of Joshua and Caleb did not taste again of the food of the Promised Land. That is what the Lord is about to do to this generation who will not taste of the food of the Seed of the Word. And they will not store up His Promises. Today people say that they are waiting on the Lord while they eat the things of the world, and do not store up His SEED.

Numbers 13:25-33 ²⁵And they returned from spying out the land after forty days. ²⁶Now they departed and came back to Moses and Aaron and all the congregation of the children of Israel in the Wilderness of Paran, at Kadesh; they brought back word to them and to all the congregation, and showed them the fruit of the land. ²⁷Then they told him, and said: "We went to the land where you sent us. It truly flows with milk and honey, and this is its fruit. ²⁸Nevertheless the people who dwell in the land are strong; the cities are fortified and very large; moreover, we saw the descendants of Anak there. ²⁹The Amalekites dwell in the land of the South; the Hittites, the Jebusites, and the Amorites dwell in the mountains; and the Canaanites dwell by the sea and along the banks of the Jordan." ³⁰Then Caleb quieted the people before Moses, and said, "Let us go up at once and take possession, for we are well able to overcome it." ³¹But the men who had gone up with him said, "We are not able to go up against the people, for they are stronger than we." ³²And they gave the children of Israel a bad report of the land which they had spied out, saying, "The land through which we have gone as spies is a land that devours its inhabitants, and all the people whom we saw in it are men of great stature. ³³**There we saw the giants (the descendants of Anak came from the giants); AND WE WERE LIKE GRASSHOPPERS IN OUR OWN SIGHT, and so we were in their sight.**"
