

Notes of Floyd E. Taylor for Dec. 26, 2010 Teleconference Bible Study

Does it Matter if we are Ready bring forth His Kingdom so that we can eat the Meat of Heaven?

Tonight I would like to continue with the review of the time of David when he presented the Temple plans to Solomon and consider other issues relating to Solomon. The reason for this is that David is symbolic of the Father given the plans for building His House to the Son, our Lord Jesus Christ.

I would like to review tonight some issues relating to what is the Kingdom of God likened to that He is bringing upon the earth, and what kind of mindset that we are going to need to change to about the way that we live our lives.

Let us remember that we are receiving a Kingdom that is based on the Way of the Words that are from the Father in the Kingdom of Heaven. In Rev. 5 the father gives the Scroll to the Lord, and by the example of David we can see that it is the Way of the Father that if the Lord follows the plans that are prepared, then everything will be completed and His Words will be with Him, for He is to be strong and have Good Courage.

- **Revelation 5:1-7** ¹And I saw in **the right hand** of Him who sat on the throne **A SCROLL WRITTEN INSIDE AND ON THE BACK, SEALED WITH SEVEN SEALS.** *(Take note that the Seals meant that only the "AUTHORIZED" One could open the Scroll and read it. Here, they could not even look upon this Scroll without having the authority to do so. So the 24 Elders did not have that authority. His Words is alive; thus His Words are empowered Works.)* ²Then I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, "Who is worthy to open the scroll and to loose its seals?" ³And **no one in heaven or on the earth or under the earth was able to open the scroll, or to look at it.** ⁴**SO I WEPT MUCH, BECAUSE NO ONE WAS FOUND WORTHY TO OPEN AND READ THE SCROLL, OR TO LOOK AT IT.** ⁵But one of the elders said to me, "**DO NOT WEEP.** Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, **HAS PREVAILED TO OPEN the scroll and to loose its seven seals.**" ⁶And I looked, and behold, **in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders,** stood a Lamb as though it had been slain, **HAVING SEVEN HORNS AND SEVEN EYES, which are the seven Spirits of God sent out into all the earth.** ⁷Then He came and took the scroll out of the right hand of Him who sat on the throne.
- **Revelation 5:8-10** ⁸Now when He had taken the scroll, **THE FOUR LIVING CREATURES** and **THE TWENTY-FOUR ELDERS** **fell down before the Lamb, EACH HAVING A HARP, AND GOLDEN BOWLS FULL OF INCENSE, WHICH ARE THE PRAYERS OF THE SAINTS.** ⁹And **THEY SANG A NEW SONG, SAYING: "YOU ARE WORTHY TO TAKE THE SCROLL, AND TO OPEN ITS SEALS; FOR YOU WERE SLAIN, AND HAVE REDEEMED US TO GOD BY YOUR BLOOD OUT OF EVERY TRIBE AND TONGUE AND PEOPLE AND NATION,** ¹⁰and **HAVE MADE US KINGS AND PRIESTS TO OUR GOD; AND WE SHALL REIGN ON THE EARTH."**
- **Revelation 5:11-14** ¹¹Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne, the living creatures, and the elders; and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands, ¹²saying with a loud voice: "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing!" ¹³And every creature which is in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, I heard saying: "Blessing and honor and glory and power be to Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb, forever and ever!" ¹⁴Then the four living creatures said, "Amen!" And the twenty-four elders fell down and worshiped Him who lives forever and ever.

You may remember that the Lord recants David's testimony of Him that is recorded in Psalm 110:1, that Jesus is the Lord that sits beside His Lord. And yet David says that Jesus is of the seed of David. The Lord's statement is referred to in four books of the Bible including the book of Acts.

- **Matthew 22:44** 'The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool"'
- **Mark 12:36** "For David himself said by the Holy Spirit: 'The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool.'"
- **Luke 20:42** "Now David himself said in the Book of Psalms: 'The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand,
- **Acts 2:34** "For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he says himself: 'The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand,

Now, please consider the Way of God's plan for His Son Kingdom coming forth to build His Kingdom as it is made known in David's instruction of Psalm 110:1-7. If we consider this Psalm we should see that the Father is saying to David that the Lord Jesus Christ is coming with the Promise of the Complete plan of the Father, and that He will obtain all that is needed to accomplish the bring forth of the Kingdom of God on earth that begins with His building of His Temple within the hearts and the minds of His Elect. My point is that the Father makes clear in Psalm 110:1-7 that part of the work of His Words causing the earth to be His Footstool is that there is a work that must be accomplished that includes His Words causing the execution of many Kings and the complete annihilation of many armies. In Zechariah 14:12-15 and in Jeremiah 49-50 that the Lord is going to destroy all those who come against Him. But, do you see it is all done by His Words? This is revealed in Psalm 110:5-7.

- **Psalm 110:1-7** ¹A Psalm of David. **THE LORD SAID TO MY LORD, "SIT AT MY RIGHT HAND, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool."** **The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, till I make Your enemies Your footstool."** ²**The LORD shall send the rod of Your strength out of Zion. RULE IN THE MIDST OF YOUR ENEMIES!** ³**YOUR PEOPLE SHALL BE VOLUNTEERS IN THE DAY OF YOUR POWER; IN THE BEAUTIES OF HOLINESS, FROM THE WOMB OF THE MORNING, YOU HAVE THE DEW OF YOUR YOUTH.** ⁴**THE LORD HAS SWORN AND WILL NOT RELENT, "YOU ARE A PRIEST FOREVER ACCORDING TO THE ORDER OF MELCHIZEDEK."** ⁵**The Lord is at Your right hand; He shall execute kings in the Day of His wrath. (This means that it will be by His Words.)** ⁶**He shall judge among the nations, He shall fill the places with dead bodies, He shall execute the heads of many countries.** ⁷**He shall drink of the brook by the wayside; therefore He shall lift up the head. (This is ALL works of His Father's Words.)**

As we reviewed last night, the Lord is telling us to be strong of GOOD COURAGE. Here in Psalm 110 we are seeing that all the works of making the earth His footstool are already given within His Words in that Scroll given of His Right Hand. In Mark 10:18 the Lord Jesus said that only God the Father is Good, and in John 5:43, the Lord Jesus says that His Father is Good. Because the apostle John called Jesus as the Word, we often agree that Jesus is the Word. However, we seem to fail to attach the same correlation to the Father when Jesus called Him as Good.

- **Mark 10:17-22** ¹⁷Now as He was going out on the road, one came running, knelt before Him, and asked Him, "Good Teacher, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?" ¹⁸So Jesus said to him, **"WHY DO YOU CALL ME GOOD? NO ONE IS GOOD BUT ONE, THAT IS, GOD.** ¹⁹**You know the commandments: 'Do not commit adultery,' 'Do not murder,' 'Do not steal,' 'Do not bear false witness,' 'Do not defraud,' 'Honor your father and your mother.'"** ²⁰And he answered and said to Him, "Teacher, all these things I have kept from my youth." ²¹Then Jesus, looking at him, loved him, and said to him, **"One thing you lack: Go**

your way, sell whatever you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, take up the cross, and follow Me." ²²But he was sad at this Word, and went away sorrowful, for he had great possessions.

- **John 1:1-2** "In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God, and the Word was God, and He was in the beginning with God. He was in the beginning with God." (How more clear could John be in clarifying that before all things was the Word of God, and that means that before earthly languages were created, the Words of God existed? In these Words existed all things.)
- **John 5:43** **I HAVE COME IN MY FATHER'S NAME, and you do not receive Me; if another comes in his own name, him you will receive.** (This statement is not understood by nearly all people. What is the Father's Name? It is the Works of Good that come by the doing and speaking of His Words. Jesus said that He came to make known the Good News, and it is clear that He was sent into the world to speak the Words of God that are Truth and have all Truth within Them - Deut. 18:18-19.)
- **Deuteronomy 18:18-19** ¹⁸"I will raise up for them a Prophet (*Jesus - the Messiah - the Christ*) like you (*Moses, the Law Giver*) from among their brethren, and **will put My Words in His mouth, and He shall speak to them all that I command Him.** ¹⁹**AND IT SHALL BE THAT WHOEVER WILL NOT HEAR MY WORDS, WHICH HE SPEAKS IN MY NAME, I WILL REQUIRE IT OF HIM.**" (The Father is explaining that the doing of His Words is His Name. We need to wake up to this, for it is the Day of Judgment. He says that there will be an accounting if we do not hear His Words that Jesus spoke and that He is still speaking. That is a pretty significant event in all the Scriptures, is it not?)

Consider that Jesus said that only the Father is Good and that only the Father does the Good Works. Thus, we are able to understand that if He tells us to be of Good Courage and to be strong, it is because His Plan is given to us that we may complete the Plan that is already declared as complete. Remember that His Words are Law and unbreakable. Also, do not forget that when we know this and that we are to fight the Good Fight of Faith, and we do not do so, then it is to us as sin. His Yoke is Good - it means His Plan for His Good Works are easy to do for He does the Works for us if we just obey and be faithful servants to do the Way of His Law - His Words - as He tells us to do.

- **Deuteronomy 29:29** **"THE SECRET THINGS BELONG TO THE LORD OUR GOD, BUT THOSE THINGS WHICH ARE REVEALED BELONG TO US AND TO OUR CHILDREN FOREVER, THAT WE MAY "DO ALL THE WORDS" OF THIS LAW.**
- **James 1:22-24** ²²**BUT BE DOERS OF THE WORD, AND NOT HEARERS ONLY, DECEIVING YOURSELVES.** ²³For if anyone is a hearer of the Word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror; ²⁴for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was.
- **James 4:17** **Therefore, TO HIM WHO KNOWS TO DO GOOD AND DOES NOT DO IT, TO HIM IT IS SIN.**
- **Mathew 11:28-30** ²⁸**Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.** ²⁹**Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.** ³⁰**For MY YOKE IS GOOD AND MY BURDEN IS LIGHT."** (*Jesus said that only the Father is Good.*)
- **Psalms 119:130** "The Entrance of His Words Gives Light, and Gives Understanding to the Simple."
- **John 8:12** Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the Light of the world. **HE WHO FOLLOWS ME SHALL not walk in darkness, but HAVE THE LIGHT OF LIFE."**
- **Isaiah 40:10** Behold, the Lord GOD shall come with a strong hand, And His arm shall rule for Him; Behold, **HIS REWARD IS WITH HIM, and His work before Him.**

- John 12:48 **"HE WHO REJECTS ME, AND DOES NOT RECEIVE MY WORDS HAS THAT WHICH JUDGES HIM - the Word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day."** (*This is the same Judgment ruling as Paul reveals in Romans 2:2.*)
- Romans 2:2 **BUT WE KNOW THAT THE JUDGMENT OF GOD IS ACCORDING TO TRUTH.** (*His Word is Truth - John 17:17 and it is LAW - Psalm 119:142.*)
- 1 Timothy 2:3-4 ³For **THIS IS GOOD AND ACCEPTABLE IN THE SIGHT OF GOD OUR SAVIOR,** ⁴**who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the Truth.** (*Get Power!!*)
- 2 Timothy 2:15 ¹⁵**BE DILIGENT TO PRESENT YOURSELF APPROVED TO GOD, A WORKER WHO DOES NOT NEED TO BE ASHAMED, RIGHTLY DIVIDING THE WORD OF TRUTH.** (*Are you able to discern His Words from other words in the Bible?*)
- Psalm 33:4 For the Word of the Lord is right, and **ALL HIS WORK IS IN TRUTH.**
- Psalm 119:142 **YOUR LAW IS TRUTH.** (*God's Word is Law and His Word is the sum of all the Laws.*)
- Psalm 119:160 **THE ENTIRETY OF YOUR WORD IS TRUTH.** (*All His Words having His Pre-Ordained Promises within Them are Truth and they are Holy.*)
- Psalm 119:130 **"The Entrance of His Words Gives Light, and Gives Understanding to the Simple."** (*We will have no Light in the coming Night of His Day unless we come and eat at His Table and allow His Wisdom to give us the food of His Instruction of His Words.*)
- Hosea 6:5-6 ⁵Therefore I have hewn them by the prophets, I have slain them by the Words of My mouth; and your **JUDGMENTS ARE LIKE LIGHT THAT GOES FORTH.** ⁶For **I DESIRE "GOOD DEEDS" AND NOT SACRIFICE, AND THE "KNOWLEDGE OF GOD" MORE THAN BURNT OFFERINGS.**
- Proverbs 9:10 Understanding of the Holy is knowledge.
- John 9:39-41 ³⁹And Jesus said, **"For judgment I have come into this world, that those who do not see may see, and that those who see may be made blind."** ⁴⁰Then some Pharisees who were with Him heard these Words, and said to Him, "Are we blind also?" ⁴¹Jesus said to them, "If you were blind you would have no sin; but now you say, 'We see.' Therefore your sin remains."

Last night we reviewed 1 Chronicles 28:19-21 and saw in verse 20 that David reveals to Solomon that he should be strong and of Good Courage for the Father's Words are with Him as a promise until He finishes building His House.

- 1 Chronicles 28:19-21 ¹⁹"All this," said David, "THE LORD MADE ME UNDERSTAND IN WRITING, BY HIS HAND UPON ME, ALL THE WORKS OF THESE PLANS." ²⁰And David said to his son Solomon, "BE STRONG AND OF GOOD COURAGE, AND DO IT; DO NOT FEAR NOR BE DISMAYED, FOR THE LORD GOD—MY GOD—WILL BE WITH YOU. HE WILL NOT LEAVE YOU NOR FORSAKE YOU, UNTIL YOU HAVE FINISHED ALL THE WORK FOR THE SERVICE OF THE HOUSE OF THE LORD. ²¹Here are the divisions of the priests and the Levites for all the service of the house of God; and every willing craftsman will be with you for all manner of workmanship, for every kind of service; also the leaders and all the people will be completely at your command."

Consider the meaning of walking in Good Courage. It is God's message to us in Joel 2 when He says do not be afraid of the Northern Army.

- Numbers 13:20 "WHETHER THE LAND IS RICH OR POOR; AND WHETHER THERE ARE FORESTS THERE OR NOT. BE OF GOOD COURAGE. AND BRING SOME OF THE FRUIT OF THE LAND." NOW THE TIME WAS THE SEASON OF THE FIRST RIPE GRAPES.
- Deuteronomy 31:6 "BE STRONG AND OF GOOD COURAGE, DO NOT FEAR NOR BE AFRAID OF THEM; FOR THE LORD YOUR GOD, HE IS THE ONE WHO GOES WITH YOU. HE WILL NOT LEAVE YOU NOR FORSAKE YOU."
- Deuteronomy 31:7 THEN MOSES CALLED JOSHUA AND SAID TO HIM IN THE SIGHT OF ALL ISRAEL, "BE STRONG AND OF GOOD COURAGE, FOR YOU MUST GO WITH THIS PEOPLE TO THE LAND WHICH THE LORD HAS SWORN TO THEIR FATHERS TO GIVE THEM, AND YOU SHALL CAUSE THEM TO INHERIT IT."
- Deuteronomy 31:23 THEN HE INAUGURATED JOSHUA THE SON OF NUN, AND SAID, "BE STRONG AND OF GOOD COURAGE; FOR YOU SHALL BRING THE CHILDREN OF ISRAEL INTO THE LAND OF WHICH I SWORE TO THEM, AND I WILL BE WITH YOU."
- Joshua 1:6 "BE STRONG AND OF GOOD COURAGE, FOR TO THIS PEOPLE YOU SHALL DIVIDE AS AN INHERITANCE THE LAND WHICH I SWORE TO THEIR FATHERS TO GIVE THEM."
- Joshua 1:9 "HAVE I NOT COMMANDED YOU? BE STRONG AND OF GOOD COURAGE; DO NOT BE AFRAID, NOR BE DISMAYED, FOR THE LORD YOUR GOD IS WITH YOU WHEREVER YOU GO."
- Joshua 1:18 "WHOEVER REBELS AGAINST YOUR COMMAND AND DOES NOT HEED YOUR WORDS, IN ALL THAT YOU COMMAND HIM, SHALL BE PUT TO DEATH. ONLY BE STRONG AND OF GOOD COURAGE."
- Joshua 10:25 THEN JOSHUA SAID TO THEM, "DO NOT BE AFRAID, NOR BE DISMAYED; BE STRONG AND OF GOOD COURAGE, FOR THUS THE LORD WILL DO TO ALL YOUR ENEMIES AGAINST WHOM YOU FIGHT."
- 2 Samuel 10:12 "BE OF GOOD COURAGE, AND LET US BE STRONG FOR OUR PEOPLE AND FOR THE CITIES OF OUR GOD. AND MAY THE LORD DO WHAT IS GOOD IN HIS SIGHT."
- 1 Chronicles 19:13 "BE OF GOOD COURAGE, AND LET US BE STRONG FOR OUR PEOPLE AND FOR THE CITIES OF OUR GOD. AND MAY THE LORD DO WHAT IS GOOD IN HIS SIGHT."

We are trying to consider the Way that God is building His Kingdom on earth. In Matthew 22 there is an interesting flow of events that leads up to the revelation of the plan of God and the Way that it will be in the Kingdom of Heaven, under the Plan of the Kingdom that the Father has given to the Lord. The flow of the chapter reveals the Way of the desire of God for the entrance into the Kingdom of Heaven.

Let us consider the Parable of the Marriage Supper. It is different than the Parable of the Great Supper (*Luke 14:15-24*). You can see in the Lord's wording of verse 7 that when the Lord sends out His armies - the One World Order - that He is going to have them destroy the people of His city who were invited. That is the Great Tribulation. He is going to collect people from all over the world to become purified, refined and made white. All who call upon His Name - His Good Works in the Way of doing His Good Works - will be saved. Remember that this is a Wedding Feast where the people are eating the MEAT of the Power of His Words - the food of the Kingdom of God. The Great Supper was to come in and eat the bread of instruction.

→ **Matthew 22:1-14** ¹And Jesus answered and spoke to them again by parables and said: ²"The kingdom of heaven is like a certain king who arranged a marriage for his son, ³and sent out his servants to call those who were invited to the wedding; and they were not willing to come. ⁴Again, he sent out other servants, saying, 'Tell those who are invited, "See, I have prepared my dinner; my oxen and fatted cattle are killed, and all things are ready. Come to the wedding." ' ⁵But they made light of it and went their ways, one to his own farm, another to his business. ⁶And the rest seized his servants, treated them spitefully, and killed them. ⁷But when the king heard about it, he was furious. And he sent out his armies, destroyed those murderers, and burned up their city. ⁸**THEN HE SAID TO HIS SERVANTS, 'THE WEDDING IS READY, BUT THOSE WHO WERE INVITED WERE NOT WORTHY.** ⁹**THEREFORE GO INTO THE HIGHWAYS, AND AS MANY AS YOU FIND, INVITE TO THE WEDDING.'** ¹⁰So those servants went out into the highways and gathered together all whom they found, both bad and good. And the wedding hall was filled with guests. ¹¹"But when the king came in to see the guests, he saw a man there who did not have on a wedding garment. ¹²So he said to him, 'Friend, how did you come in here without a wedding garment?' And he was speechless. ¹³Then the king said to the servants, 'Bind him hand and foot, take him away, and cast him into outer darkness; there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.' ¹⁴"For many are called, but few are chosen."

→ **Luke 14:15-24** ¹⁵Now when one of those who sat at the table with Him heard these things, he said to Him, "**Blessed is he who shall eat bread in the kingdom of God!**" (*The Bread is instruction. Do you see that the Lord said that those who eat bread of instruction in the Words of God that are the foundation of the Kingdom of God.*) ¹⁶Then He said to him, "**A certain man gave a great supper and invited many, ¹⁷and sent his servant at supper time to say to those who were invited, 'Come, for all things are now ready.'** ¹⁸**BUT THEY ALL WITH ONE ACCORD BEGAN TO MAKE EXCUSES.** The first said to him, 'I have bought a piece of ground, and I must go and see it. I ask you to have me excused.' ¹⁹And another said, 'I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I am going to test them. I ask you to have me excused.' ²⁰Still another said, 'I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come.' ²¹So that servant came and reported these things to his master. **THEN THE MASTER OF THE HOUSE, BEING ANGRY,** said to his servant, 'Go out quickly into the streets and lanes of the city, and bring in here the poor and the maimed and the lame and the blind.' ²²And the servant said, 'Master, it is done as you commanded, and still there is room.' ²³Then the master said to the servant, 'Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel them to come in, that my house may be filled. ²⁴**FOR I SAY TO YOU THAT NONE OF THOSE MEN WHO WERE INVITED SHALL TASTE MY SUPPER.'**"

- **Proverbs 9:1-6** ¹"Wisdom has built her house, She has hewn out her seven pillars; ²She has slaughtered her meat, She has mixed her wine, She has also furnished her table. ³She has sent out her maidens, She cries out from the highest places of the city, ⁴"Whoever is simple, let him turn in here!" As for him who lacks understanding, she says to him, ⁵"Come, eat of my bread and drink of the wine I have mixed. ⁶Forsake foolishness and live, and go in the Way of Understanding."

In May 2010 the Lord Gave The Prophetic Word Wisdom Left His Church

In May 2010 the Lord gave a dramatic Prophetic Vision that Wisdom has left the Church and gone elsewhere. That is the Warning that the Third Invitation has occurred and that the time is now very short before His Door is Barred (*As can be discerned from Lk. 14:15-24, 11:5-13, Mt. 13:1-13.*) What does it mean when the Father takes His Wisdom away? It means the Compelling Event is coming, and it means the Father is angry with the Church (*Lk. 14:24*), and we will not taste His Food if we do not zealously go and get His Wisdom.



His Prophetic Word: Recently in a vision, the Lord acted as a tour guide when He drove me through an old town that was unfamiliar to me. When we came to the town's square, He stopped the vehicle and drew my attention to a statue uniquely displayed there. There before my eyes stood a tall, granite, obelisk shaped monument. On top of its base was a statue of a woman holding a large water pitcher on her right shoulder. The water was being poured out of the pitcher and flowing down over the monument. As I took a closer look I heard the Lord say, "She could recite the 23rd Psalm in every language." The names of many different languages of the world were written on all four sides of the base. From top to bottom I began to read them: Korean, Japanese, Italian, English, Chinese, Indonesian, Norwegian, Italian, Portuguese, Spanish and many more. **As I watched the water being poured out of the pitcher and over the nations He said, "The SAD THING was the woman had left the church and went elsewhere."** I realized that what I just witnessed was an outpouring of the Holy Spirit by Godly Wisdom. It had an endless flow pouring over the nations. Wisdom could recite Psalm 23, the Lord's Prayer, over all the nations of the world in their native language. So every tongue or tribe or nation could hear and understand—like on the day of Pentecost!

In Matthew 22:15-22 the Pharisees: tried to bust the teaching of the Words of God through the question of whether it is lawful to pay taxes to Caesar? (*Mark 12:13-17; Luke 20:20-26*) Consider that question and what Jesus was actually responding.

→ **Matthew 22:15-22** ¹⁵Then the Pharisees went and plotted how they might entangle Him in His talk. ¹⁶AND THEY SENT TO HIM THEIR DISCIPLES WITH THE HERODIANS, SAYING, "TEACHER, WE KNOW THAT YOU ARE TRUE, AND TEACH THE WAY OF GOD IN TRUTH; NOR DO YOU CARE ABOUT ANYONE, FOR YOU DO NOT REGARD THE PERSON OF MEN. ¹⁷TELL US, THEREFORE, WHAT DO YOU THINK? IS IT LAWFUL TO PAY TAXES TO CAESAR, OR NOT?" ¹⁸BUT JESUS PERCEIVED THEIR WICKEDNESS, AND SAID, "WHY DO YOU TEST ME, YOU HYPOCRITES? ¹⁹SHOW ME THE TAX MONEY." SO THEY BROUGHT HIM A DENARIUS. ²⁰AND HE SAID TO THEM, "WHOSE IMAGE AND INSCRIPTION IS THIS?" ²¹THEY SAID TO HIM, "CAESAR'S." AND HE SAID TO THEM, "RENDER THEREFORE TO CAESAR THE THINGS THAT ARE CAESAR'S, AND TO GOD THE THINGS THAT ARE GOD'S." ²²WHEN THEY HAD HEARD THESE WORDS, THEY MARVELED, AND LEFT HIM AND WENT THEIR WAY.

→ **Matthew 9:10-13** ¹⁰NOW IT HAPPENED, AS JESUS SAT AT THE TABLE IN THE HOUSE, THAT BEHOLD, MANY TAX COLLECTORS AND SINNERS CAME AND SAT DOWN WITH HIM AND HIS DISCIPLES. ¹¹AND WHEN THE PHARISEES SAW IT, THEY SAID TO HIS DISCIPLES, "WHY DOES YOUR TEACHER EAT WITH TAX COLLECTORS AND SINNERS?" ¹²WHEN JESUS HEARD THAT, HE SAID TO THEM, "THOSE WHO ARE WELL HAVE NO NEED OF A PHYSICIAN, BUT THOSE WHO ARE SICK. ¹³BUT GO AND LEARN WHAT THIS MEANS: 'I DESIRE MERCY AND NOT SACRIFICE.' FOR I DID NOT COME TO CALL THE RIGHTEOUS, BUT SINNERS, TO REPENTANCE."

→ **Matthew 23:23** "WOE TO YOU, SCRIBES AND PHARISEES, HYPOCRITES! FOR YOU PAY TITHE OF MINT AND ANISE AND CUMMIN, AND HAVE NEGLECTED THE WEIGHTIER MATTERS OF THE LAW: JUSTICE AND MERCY AND FAITH. THESE YOU OUGHT TO HAVE DONE, WITHOUT LEAVING THE OTHERS UNDONE."

→ **Ecclesiastes 2:26** ²⁶FOR GOD GIVES WISDOM AND KNOWLEDGE AND JOY TO A MAN WHO IS GOOD IN HIS SIGHT; BUT TO THE SINNER HE GIVES THE WORK OF GATHERING AND COLLECTING, THAT HE MAY GIVE TO HIM WHO IS GOOD BEFORE GOD. This also is vanity and grasping for the wind.

In saying that He desires mercy and not sacrifice, Jesus is teaching that He prefers it when people practice mercy and not blindly follow ritual. He is not condemning the laws of sacrifice that He set up for Israel to practice until He fulfilled them, but explaining that He is more pleased with acts of forgiveness and kindness than strict external compliance to the law.

He is telling the Pharisees that, though they were exacting in keeping the letter of the law, they had completely missed its intent. In

It is good and right to tithe to God, even to be exacting in our accounting, but not at the expense of the far more important matters of justice, mercy, and faith! These weightier matters are a Christian's priorities, so if a question of "What do I do?" ever comes up between practicing them and keeping the strict letter of the law, our judgment should lean toward these Christian virtues. If we can do both, all the better!

The Lord explains to the Sadducees about the resurrection, and in it He reveals the way of "Marrying and Marriage" in the Kingdom of Heaven. The use of Marriage on earth was to do the Way of Good. The Lord said that it was not Good for Adam to be alone. Men and women on earth have forgotten the reason for marriage on earth, and it was not made for sex, but for the purpose of being able to increase

in the knowledge of Good. On earth it is common that men, the ones who are to be the teachers of the Word, firstly do not do Good for their wives or seek that opportunity for God's glory, while they aggressively want the reward of the earthly way, and even in that the men do not make sure that their partner is satisfied before they take their pleasure. Marriage was to teach the man and the woman how to be servants of Good for each other. The physical relationship part is far down on the list. Also, men try to dominate the woman, even considering her as their possession to take from, and they miss the purpose that the Lord made the woman to the man in the first place. In this teaching of the Sadducees this mindset of "ownership" is completely unmasked by the Lord. He is saying that they do not understand the first way of God's purpose for making the woman as a helpmate to man. The seed part was a blessing, but the servant serving part was the must for both the man and the woman. We are here to learn how to become Workers of Good in the Kingdom of Heaven, and thus we miss the plan of God. The result is rampant in the world. Marriage has become a selfish centered debacle that has resulted in huge percentages of divorce, and it is on the same scale of disastrous report card as the rest of the world issues, such as the food, the economy, etc. that are not God's Kingdom Way centered. When we go back to doing Good for others as the base concept in the marriage, as well as in physical relationships, then we will again see prosperous marriages fitting for entrance in the likeness of the garden of Eden. Consider the Middle East where they tell martyrs they will each get 70 virgins for killing others. (*Genesis 2:15-25 Mark 12:18-27; Luke 20:27-40*)

→ **Matthew 22:1-14** ²³The same day the Sadducees, who say there is no resurrection, came to Him and asked Him, ²⁴saying: "Teacher, Moses said that if a man dies, having no children, his brother shall marry his wife and raise up offspring for his brother. ²⁵Now there were with us seven brothers. The first died after he had married, and having no offspring, left his wife to his brother. ²⁶Likewise the second also, and the third, even to the seventh. ²⁷Last of all the woman died also. ²⁸Therefore, in the resurrection, whose wife of the seven will she be? For they all had her." ²⁹Jesus answered and said to them, "You are mistaken, not knowing the Scriptures nor the power of God. ³⁰For in the resurrection they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels of God in heaven. ³¹But concerning the resurrection of the dead, have you not read what was spoken to you by God, saying, ³²'I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob' ? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living." ³³And when the multitudes heard this, they were astonished at His teaching.

The Lord repeats that it is the Love of God that we must have first and then the love of our neighbors as ourselves. Consider that this is placed right after the teaching about the Way in our own house and that we will be like angels in the Kingdom of God. (*Mark 12:28-34; Luke 10:25-28*)

→ **Matthew 22:34-40** ³⁴But when the Pharisees heard that He had silenced the Sadducees, they gathered together. ³⁵Then one of them, a lawyer, asked Him a question, testing Him, and saying, ³⁶"Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?" ³⁷Jesus said to him, " 'You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' ³⁸This is the first and great commandment. ³⁹And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' ⁴⁰On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets."

→ **John 14:23-24** ²³Jesus answered and said to him, "IF ANYONE LOVES ME, HE WILL KEEP MY WORD; AND THE FATHER WILL LOVE HIM, AND WE WILL COME TO HIM AND MAKE OUR HOME WITH HIM. ²⁴HE WHO DOES NOT LOVE ME DOES NOT KEEP MY WORDS; AND THE WORD WHICH YOU HEAR IS NOT MINE BUT THE FATHERS WHO SENT ME."

Now the Lord tells them that He is the King of Kings who speaks His Father's words and they will not hear Him. (*Mark 12:35-37; Luke 20:41-44*). Take note that they cannot answer "Him a Word". They could not overcome the knowledge of Truth.

→ **Matthew 22:41-46** ⁴¹While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them, ⁴²saying, "What do you think about the Christ? Whose Son is He?" They said to Him, "The Son of David." ⁴³He said to them, "How then does David in the Spirit call Him 'Lord,' saying: ⁴⁴'The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool" ' ? ⁴⁵If David then calls Him 'Lord,' how is He his Son?" ⁴⁶And no one was able to answer Him a Word, nor from that day on did anyone dare question Him anymore.

David prepared all things for Solomon just as the Father has prepared all things for the Lord to Build His Temple on earth in this Day.

→ **1 Chronicles 28:1-18** ¹Now David assembled at Jerusalem all the leaders of Israel: the officers of the tribes and the captains of the divisions who served the king, the captains over thousands and captains over hundreds, and the stewards over all the substance and possessions of the king and of his sons, with the officials, the valiant men, and all the mighty men of valor. ²Then King David rose to his feet and said, "Hear me, my brethren and my people: I had it in my heart to build a house of rest for the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and for the footstool of our God, and had made preparations to build it. ³But God said to me, 'You shall not build a house for My Name, because you have been a man of war and have shed blood.' ⁴However the LORD God of Israel chose me above all the house of my father to be king over Israel forever, for He has chosen Judah to be the ruler. And of the house of Judah, the house of my father, and among the sons of my father, He was pleased with me to make me king over all Israel. ⁵And of all my sons (for the LORD has given me many sons) He has chosen my son Solomon to sit on the throne of the kingdom of the LORD over Israel. ⁶NOW HE SAID TO ME, 'IT IS YOUR SON SOLOMON WHO SHALL BUILD MY HOUSE AND MY COURTS; FOR I HAVE CHOSEN HIM TO BE MY SON, AND I WILL BE HIS FATHER. ⁷MOREOVER I WILL ESTABLISH HIS KINGDOM FOREVER, IF HE IS STEADFAST TO OBSERVE MY COMMANDMENTS AND MY JUDGMENTS, AS IT IS THIS DAY.' ⁸NOW THEREFORE, IN THE SIGHT OF ALL ISRAEL, THE ASSEMBLY OF THE LORD, AND IN THE HEARING OF OUR GOD, BE CAREFUL TO SEEK OUT ALL THE COMMANDMENTS OF THE LORD YOUR GOD, THAT YOU MAY POSSESS THIS GOOD LAND, AND LEAVE IT AS AN INHERITANCE FOR YOUR CHILDREN AFTER YOU FOREVER. ⁹AS FOR YOU, MY SON SOLOMON, KNOW THE GOD OF YOUR FATHER, AND SERVE HIM WITH A LOYAL HEART AND WITH A WILLING MIND; FOR THE LORD SEARCHES ALL HEARTS AND UNDERSTANDS ALL THE INTENT OF THE THOUGHTS. IF YOU SEEK HIM, HE WILL BE FOUND BY YOU; BUT IF YOU FORSAKE HIM, HE WILL CAST YOU OFF FOREVER. ¹⁰CONSIDER NOW, FOR THE LORD HAS CHOSEN YOU TO BUILD A HOUSE FOR THE SANCTUARY; BE STRONG, AND DO IT." ¹¹THEN DAVID GAVE HIS SON SOLOMON THE PLANS FOR THE VESTIBULE, ITS HOUSES, ITS TREASURIES, ITS UPPER CHAMBERS, ITS INNER CHAMBERS, AND THE PLACE OF THE MERCY SEAT; ¹²AND THE PLANS FOR ALL THAT HE HAD BY THE SPIRIT, OF THE COURTS OF THE HOUSE OF THE LORD, OF ALL THE CHAMBERS ALL AROUND, OF THE TREASURIES OF THE HOUSE OF GOD, AND OF THE TREASURIES FOR THE DEDICATED THINGS; ¹³ALSO FOR THE DIVISION OF THE PRIESTS AND THE LEVITES, FOR ALL THE WORK OF THE SERVICE OF THE HOUSE OF THE LORD, AND FOR ALL THE ARTICLES OF SERVICE IN THE HOUSE OF THE LORD. ¹⁴He gave gold by weight for things of gold, for all articles used in every kind of service; also silver for all articles of silver by weight, for all articles used in

every kind of service; ¹⁵the weight for the lampstands of gold, and their lamps of gold, by weight for each lampstand and its lamps; for the lampstands of silver by weight, for the lampstand and its lamps, according to the use of each lampstand. ¹⁶And by weight he gave gold for the tables of the showbread, for each table, and silver for the tables of silver; ¹⁷also pure gold for the forks, the basins, the pitchers of pure gold, and the golden bowls—he gave gold by weight for every bowl; and for the silver bowls, silver by weight for every bowl; ¹⁸and refined gold by weight for the altar of incense. **AND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE CHARIOT, THAT IS, THE GOLD CHERUBIM THAT SPREAD THEIR WINGS AND OVERSHADOWED THE ARK OF THE COVENANT OF THE LORD.** (*This is the likeness of the two olive trees in Zech. 4:11-14, for they are filled with eyes and they are the keepers of His Words, and they pour out His Wisdom - Righteousness and Justice.*)

Consider the ways of the asking of the weakness of Solomon and for the commitments and the offerings for building the Temple

→ **1 Chronicles 29:1-9** ¹Furthermore King David said to all the assembly: **"MY SON SOLOMON, WHOM ALONE GOD HAS CHOSEN, IS YOUNG AND INEXPERIENCED; AND THE WORK IS GREAT, BECAUSE THE TEMPLE IS NOT FOR MAN BUT FOR THE LORD GOD.** ²Now for the house of my God I have prepared with all my might: gold for things to be made of gold, silver for things of silver, bronze for things of bronze, iron for things of iron, wood for things of wood, onyx stones, stones to be set, glistening stones of various colors, all kinds of precious stones, and marble slabs in abundance. ³Moreover, because I have set my affection on the house of my God, I have given to the house of my God, over and above all that I have prepared for the holy house, my own special treasure of gold and silver: ⁴three thousand talents of gold, of the gold of Ophir (*This name means "the land that is fruitful - made so by God".*), and seven thousand talents of refined silver, to overlay the walls of the houses; ⁵the gold for things of gold and the silver for things of silver, and for all kinds of work to be done by the hands of craftsmen. **WHO THEN IS WILLING TO CONSECRATE HIMSELF THIS DAY TO THE LORD?"** (*David had taught many in the Ways of His Words.*) ⁶**THEN THE LEADERS OF THE FATHERS' HOUSES, LEADERS OF THE TRIBES OF ISRAEL, THE CAPTAINS OF THOUSANDS AND OF HUNDREDS, WITH THE OFFICERS OVER THE KING'S WORK, OFFERED WILLINGLY.** ⁷They gave for the work of the house of God five thousand talents and ten thousand darics of gold, ten thousand talents of silver, eighteen thousand talents of bronze, and one hundred thousand talents of iron. ⁸And whoever had precious stones gave them to the treasury of the house of the LORD, into the hand of Jehiel the Gershonite. ⁹Then the people rejoiced, for they had offered willingly, because with a loyal heart they had offered willingly to the LORD; and King David also rejoiced greatly.

We talked last night about the number 18 that is famously associated to the woman that the Lord shamed the teachers with when He healed her from her infirmities on the Sabbath after she had it for 18 years. It is the number of the "double witness of completion to that which makes for Life and freedom from Sin".

→ **Luke 13:10-17** ¹⁰Now He was teaching in one of the synagogues on the Sabbath. ¹¹**AND BEHOLD, THERE WAS A WOMAN WHO HAD A SPIRIT OF INFIRMITY EIGHTEEN YEARS, AND WAS BENT OVER AND COULD IN NO WAY RAISE HERSELF UP.** ¹²But when Jesus saw her, He called her to Him and said to her, **"Woman, you are loosed from your infirmity."** ¹³And He laid His hands on her, and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God. ¹⁴But the ruler of the synagogue answered with indignation, because Jesus had healed on the Sabbath; and he said to the crowd, **"There are six days on which men ought to work; therefore come and be healed on them, and not on the Sabbath day."** ¹⁵**THE LORD THEN ANSWERED HIM AND**

SAID, "HYPOCRITE! DOES NOT EACH ONE OF YOU ON THE SABBATH LOOSE HIS OX OR DONKEY FROM THE STALL, AND LEAD IT AWAY TO WATER IT?"¹⁶ SO OUGHT NOT THIS WOMAN, BEING A DAUGHTER OF ABRAHAM, WHOM SATAN HAS BOUND—THINK OF IT—FOR EIGHTEEN YEARS, BE LOOSED FROM THIS BOND ON THE SABBATH?"¹⁷ And when He said these things, all His adversaries were put to shame; and all the multitude rejoiced for all the glorious things that were done by Him.

Consider David's Praise to God

→ **1 Chronicles 29:10-20** ¹⁰Therefore David blessed the LORD before all the assembly; and David said: "Blessed are You, LORD God of Israel, our Father, forever and ever. ¹¹**YOURS, O LORD, IS THE GREATNESS, THE POWER AND THE GLORY, THE VICTORY AND THE MAJESTY; FOR ALL THAT IS IN HEAVEN AND IN EARTH IS YOURS; YOURS IS THE KINGDOM, O LORD, AND YOU ARE EXALTED AS HEAD OVER ALL.** ¹²**BOTH RICHES AND HONOR COME FROM YOU, AND YOU REIGN OVER ALL.** In Your hand is power and might; in Your hand it is to make great and to give strength to all. ¹³"Now therefore, our God, we thank You and praise Your Glorious Name. ¹⁴But who am I, and who are my people, that we should be able to offer so willingly as this? For all things come from You, and of Your own we have given You. ¹⁵**FOR WE ARE ALIENS AND PILGRIMS BEFORE YOU, AS WERE ALL OUR FATHERS; OUR DAYS ON EARTH ARE AS A SHADOW, AND WITHOUT HOPE.** *(This is revealing the depth of meaning, for the Kingdom of Satan in the 2nd Heaven is called the "Shadow of Death". Satan is ruling over this world and with his rule there is no hope, for satan has none of God's Truth in him, and therefore it means that none of the works of God are*

given to the authority of satan. In Psalm 33:4 we are told by David that all His Words are done in Truth.) ¹⁶O LORD OUR GOD, ALL THIS ABUNDANCE THAT WE HAVE PREPARED TO BUILD YOU A HOUSE FOR YOUR HOLY NAME IS FROM YOUR HAND, AND IS ALL YOUR OWN. (Consider this carefully and you see that all His Works are in Truth and thus all this is of His Words - Psalm 33:4 and Psalm 119:142.) ¹⁷I KNOW ALSO, MY GOD, THAT YOU TEST THE HEART AND HAVE PLEASURE IN UPRIGHTNESS. As for me, in the uprightness of my heart I have willingly offered all these things; and now with joy I have seen Your people, who are present here to offer willingly to You. ¹⁸O LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, our fathers, keep this forever in the intent of the thoughts of the heart of Your people, and fix their heart toward You. ¹⁹AND GIVE MY SON SOLOMON A LOYAL HEART TO KEEP YOUR COMMANDMENTS AND YOUR TESTIMONIES AND YOUR STATUTES, TO DO ALL THESE THINGS, AND TO BUILD THE TEMPLE FOR WHICH I HAVE MADE PROVISION." ²⁰Then David said to all the assembly, "Now bless the LORD your God." So all the assembly blessed the LORD God of their fathers, and bowed their heads and prostrated themselves before the LORD and the king.

Solomon Anointed King (1 Kin. 1:38-40; 2:12)

→ **1 Chronicles 29:21-25** ²¹And they made sacrifices to the LORD and offered burnt offerings to the LORD on the next day: a thousand bulls, a thousand rams, a thousand lambs, with their drink offerings, and sacrifices in abundance for all Israel. ²²So they ate and drank before the LORD with great gladness on that day. And they made Solomon the son of David king the second time, and anointed him before the LORD to be the leader, and Zadok to be priest. **²³THEN SOLOMON SAT ON THE THRONE OF THE LORD AS KING INSTEAD OF DAVID HIS FATHER, AND PROSPERED; AND ALL ISRAEL OBEYED HIM.** ²⁴All the leaders and the mighty men, and also all the sons of King David, submitted themselves to King Solomon. ²⁵So the LORD exalted Solomon exceedingly in the sight of all Israel, and bestowed on him such royal majesty as had not been on any king before him in Israel.

The Close of David's Reign

→ **1 Chronicles 29:26-30** ²⁶Thus David the son of Jesse reigned over all Israel. ²⁷And the period that he reigned over Israel was forty years; seven years he reigned in Hebron, and thirty-three years he reigned in Jerusalem. ²⁸So he died in a good old age, full of days and riches and honor; and Solomon his son reigned in his place. **²⁹Now the acts of King David, first and last, indeed they are written in the book of Samuel the seer, in the book of Nathan the prophet, and in the book of Gad the seer,** ³⁰with all his reign and his might, and the events that happened to him, to Israel, and to all the kingdoms of the lands.

Now consider Solomon's great wealth and the way of it. (1 Kings 10:14-29; 2 Chronicles 1:14-17)

→ **2 Chronicles 9:13-28** ¹³The weight of gold that came to Solomon yearly was six hundred and sixty-six talents of gold, ¹⁴besides what the traveling merchants and traders brought. And all the kings of Arabia and governors of the country brought gold and silver to Solomon. ¹⁵And King Solomon made two hundred large shields of hammered gold; six hundred shekels of hammered gold went into each shield. **¹⁶HE ALSO MADE THREE HUNDRED SHIELDS OF HAMMERED GOLD; THREE HUNDRED SHEKELS OF GOLD WENT INTO EACH SHIELD. THE KING PUT THEM IN THE HOUSE OF THE FOREST OF LEBANON** (*Three hundred is the Gematria number for "the Spirit of God".*) **¹⁷MOREOVER THE KING MADE A GREAT THRONE OF IVORY, AND OVERLAID IT WITH PURE GOLD.** **¹⁸THE THRONE HAD SIX STEPS, WITH A FOOTSTOOL OF GOLD, WHICH WERE FASTENED TO THE THRONE; THERE WERE ARMRESTS ON EITHER SIDE OF THE PLACE OF THE SEAT, AND TWO LIONS STOOD BESIDE THE ARMRESTS.** ¹⁹Twelve lions stood there, one on each side of the six steps; nothing like this had been made for any other

kingdom. ²⁰All King Solomon's drinking vessels were gold, and all the vessels of the House of the Forest of Lebanon were pure gold. Not one was silver, for this was accounted as nothing in the days of Solomon. ²¹For the king's ships went to Tarshish with the servants of Hiram. Once every three years the merchant ships came, bringing gold, silver, ivory, apes, and monkeys. ²²So King Solomon surpassed all the kings of the earth in riches and wisdom. ²³And all the kings of the earth sought the presence of Solomon to hear his wisdom, which God had put in his heart. ²⁴Each man brought his present: articles of silver and gold, garments, armor, spices, horses, and mules, at a set rate year by year. ²⁵Solomon had four thousand stalls for horses and chariots, and twelve thousand horsemen whom he stationed in the chariot cities and with the king at Jerusalem. ²⁶So he reigned over all the kings from the River to the land of the Philistines, as far as the border of Egypt. ²⁷The king made silver as common in Jerusalem as stones, and he made cedar trees as abundant as the sycamores which are in the lowland. ²⁸And they brought horses to Solomon from Egypt and from all lands.

Solomon's Great Wealth and pride becomes his fall.

→ **1 Kings 14-29** ¹⁴The weight of gold that came to Solomon yearly was six hundred and sixty-six talents of gold, ¹⁵besides that from the traveling merchants, from the income of traders, from all the kings of Arabia, and from the governors of the country. ¹⁶And King Solomon made two hundred large shields of hammered gold; six hundred shekels of gold went into each shield. ¹⁷He also made three hundred shields of hammered gold; three minas of gold went into each shield. The king put them in the House of the Forest of Lebanon. ¹⁸Moreover the king made a great throne of ivory, and overlaid it with pure gold. ¹⁹The throne had six steps, and the top

of the throne was round at the back; there were armrests on either side of the place of the seat, and two lions stood beside the armrests. ²⁰Twelve lions stood there, one on each side of the six steps; nothing like this had been made for any other kingdom. ²¹All King Solomon's drinking vessels were gold, and all the vessels of the House of the Forest of Lebanon were pure gold. Not one was silver, for this was accounted as nothing in the days of Solomon. ²²For the king had merchant ships at sea with the fleet of Hiram. Once every three years the merchant ships came bringing gold, silver, ivory, apes, and monkeys. ²³So King Solomon surpassed all the kings of the earth in riches and wisdom. ²⁴Now all the earth sought the presence of Solomon to hear his wisdom, which God had put in his heart. ²⁵Each man brought his present: articles of silver and gold, garments, armor, spices, horses, and mules, at a set rate year by year. ²⁶And Solomon gathered chariots and horsemen; he had one thousand four hundred chariots and twelve thousand horsemen, whom he stationed in the chariot cities and with the king at Jerusalem. ²⁷The king made silver as common in Jerusalem as stones, and he made cedar trees as abundant as the sycamores which are in the lowland. ²⁸**ALSO SOLOMON HAD HORSES IMPORTED FROM EGYPT AND KEVEH; THE KING'S MERCHANTS BOUGHT THEM IN KEVEH AT THE CURRENT PRICE. ²⁹NOW A CHARIOT THAT WAS IMPORTED FROM EGYPT COST SIX HUNDRED SHEKELS OF SILVER, AND A HORSE ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY; AND THUS, THROUGH THEIR AGENTS, THEY EXPORTED THEM TO ALL THE KINGS OF THE HITTITES AND THE KINGS OF SYRIA.**

→ **2 Chronicles 1:1-12** ¹Now Solomon the son of David was strengthened in his kingdom, and the LORD his God was with him and exalted him exceedingly. ²And Solomon spoke to all Israel, to the captains of thousands and of hundreds, to the judges, and to every leader in all Israel, the heads of the fathers' houses. ³Then Solomon, and all the assembly with him, went to the high place that was at Gibeon; for the tabernacle of meeting with God was there, which Moses the servant of the LORD had made in the wilderness. ⁴But David had brought up the ark of God from Kirjath Jearim to the place David had prepared for it, for he had pitched a tent for it at Jerusalem. ⁵Now the bronze altar that Bezalel the son of Uri, the son of Hur, had made, he put before the tabernacle of the LORD; Solomon and the assembly sought Him there. ⁶And Solomon went up there to the bronze altar before the LORD, which was at the tabernacle of meeting, and offered a thousand burnt offerings on it. ⁷On that night God appeared to Solomon, and said to him, "Ask! What shall I give you?" ⁸And Solomon said to God: "You have shown great mercy to David my father, and have made me king in his place. ⁹Now, O LORD God, let Your promise to David my father be established, for You have made me king over a people like the dust of the earth in multitude. ¹⁰Now give me wisdom and knowledge, that I may go out and come in before this people; for who can judge this great people of Yours?" ¹¹Then God said to Solomon: "Because this was in your heart, and you have not asked riches or wealth or honor or the life of your enemies, nor have you asked long life—but have asked wisdom and knowledge for yourself, that you may judge My people over whom I have made you king— ¹²wisdom and knowledge are granted to you; and I will give you riches and wealth and honor, such as none of the kings have had who were before you, nor shall any after you have the like."

Solomon's Military and Economic Power (*1 Kin. 10:26-29; 2 Chr. 9:25-28*)

→ **2 Chronicles 1:13-17** ¹³So Solomon came to Jerusalem from the high place that was at Gibeon, from before the tabernacle of meeting, and reigned over Israel. ¹⁴And Solomon gathered chariots and horsemen; he had one thousand four hundred chariots and twelve thousand horsemen, whom he stationed in the chariot cities and with the king in Jerusalem. ¹⁵Also the king made silver and

gold as common in Jerusalem as stones, and he made cedars as abundant as the sycamores which are in the lowland. ¹⁶And Solomon had horses imported from Egypt and Keveh; the king's merchants bought them in Keveh at the current price. ¹⁷They also acquired and imported from Egypt a chariot for six hundred shekels of silver, and a horse for one hundred and fifty; thus, through their agents, they exported them to all the kings of the Hittites and the kings of Syria.

Consider again the story of the Queen of Sheba and how it is today.

→ **1 Kings 10:1-13** ¹**NOW WHEN THE QUEEN OF SHEBA** (*This name "Sheba" means an "oath", so you can say "she is likened to a Queen is search of the Truth"*) **HEARD OF THE FAME OF SOLOMON CONCERNING THE NAME OF THE LORD, SHE CAME TO TEST HIM WITH HARD QUESTIONS.** ²**SHE CAME TO JERUSALEM WITH A VERY GREAT RETINUE, WITH CAMELS THAT BORE SPICES, VERY MUCH GOLD, AND PRECIOUS STONES; AND WHEN SHE CAME TO SOLOMON, SHE SPOKE WITH HIM ABOUT ALL THAT WAS IN HER HEART.** (*It is clear that she asked of everything- science, religion, power, etc., but understand that she came bearing gifts, for in her heart she recognized that if this was true, then the value of these Words of God are greater than any treasure on earth, and sweeter than any gift that is possible to receive.*) ³**SO SOLOMON ANSWERED ALL HER QUESTIONS; THERE WAS NOTHING SO DIFFICULT FOR THE KING THAT HE COULD NOT EXPLAIN IT TO HER.** ⁴**AND WHEN THE QUEEN OF SHEBA HAD SEEN ALL THE WISDOM OF SOLOMON, THE HOUSE THAT HE HAD BUILT,** ⁵**THE FOOD ON HIS TABLE, THE SEATING OF HIS SERVANTS, THE SERVICE OF HIS WAITERS AND THEIR APPAREL, HIS CUPBEARERS, AND HIS ENTRYWAY BY WHICH HE WENT UP TO THE HOUSE OF THE LORD, THERE WAS NO MORE SPIRIT IN HER.** ⁶**THEN SHE SAID TO THE KING: "IT WAS A TRUE REPORT WHICH I HEARD IN MY OWN LAND ABOUT YOUR WORDS AND YOUR WISDOM.** ⁷**HOWEVER I DID NOT BELIEVE THE WORDS UNTIL I CAME AND SAW WITH MY OWN EYES; AND INDEED THE HALF WAS NOT TOLD ME. YOUR WISDOM AND PROSPERITY EXCEED THE FAME OF WHICH I HEARD.** ⁸**HAPPY ARE YOUR MEN AND HAPPY ARE THESE YOUR SERVANTS, WHO STAND CONTINUALLY BEFORE YOU AND HEAR YOUR WISDOM!** ⁹**BLESSED BE THE LORD YOUR GOD, WHO DELIGHTED IN YOU, SETTING YOU ON THE THRONE OF ISRAEL! BECAUSE THE LORD HAS LOVED ISRAEL FOREVER, THEREFORE HE MADE YOU KING, TO DO JUSTICE AND RIGHTEOUSNESS."** ¹⁰**THEN SHE GAVE THE KING ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY TALENTS OF GOLD, SPICES IN GREAT QUANTITY, AND PRECIOUS STONES.** (*This number 120 is the symbol of "The Pillar of Perfection", or "The Pillar of Strength", for she found that the Power of God is in His Words.*) **THERE NEVER AGAIN CAME SUCH ABUNDANCE OF SPICES AS THE QUEEN OF SHEBA GAVE TO KING SOLOMON.** ¹¹Also, the ships of Hiram (*This name means a "exaltation of Life"*), which brought gold from Ophir (*This name means a "fruitful place"*), brought great quantities of almug wood and precious stones from Ophir. ¹²And the king made steps of the almug wood for the house of the LORD and for the king's house, also harps and stringed instruments for singers. There never again came such almug wood, nor has the like been seen to this day. ¹³Now King Solomon gave the queen of Sheba all she desired, whatever she asked, besides what Solomon had given her according to the royal generosity. So she turned and went to her own country, she and her servants.

→ **2 Chronicles 9:1-12** ¹Now when the queen of Sheba heard of the fame of Solomon, she came to Jerusalem to test Solomon with hard questions, having a very great retinue, camels that bore spices, gold in abundance, and precious stones; and when she came to Solomon, she spoke with him about all that was in her heart. ²So Solomon answered all her questions; there was nothing so difficult for Solomon that he could not explain it to her. ³And when the queen of Sheba had seen the wisdom of Solomon, the house that he

had built, ⁴the food on his table, the seating of his servants, the service of his waiters and their apparel, his cupbearers and their apparel, and his entryway by which he went up to the house of the LORD, there was no more spirit in her. ⁵Then she said to the king: "It was a true report which I heard in my own land about your words and your wisdom. ⁶However I did not believe their words until I came and saw with my own eyes; and indeed the half of the greatness of your wisdom was not told me. You exceed the fame of which I heard. ⁷Happy are your men and happy are these your servants, who stand continually before you and hear your wisdom! ⁸Blessed be the LORD your God, who delighted in you, setting you on His throne to be king for the LORD your God! Because your God has loved Israel, to establish them forever, therefore He made you king over them, to do justice and righteousness." ⁹And she gave the king one hundred and twenty talents of gold, spices in great abundance, and precious stones; there never were any spices such as those the queen of Sheba gave to King Solomon. ¹⁰Also, the servants of Hiram and the servants of Solomon, who brought gold from Ophir, brought algum wood and precious stones. ¹¹And the king made walkways of the algum wood for the house of the LORD and for the king's house, also harps and stringed instruments for singers; and there were none such as these seen before in the land of Judah. ¹²Now King Solomon gave to the queen of Sheba all she desired, whatever she asked, much more than she had brought to the king. So she turned and went to her own country, she and her servants.

Now consider Solomon records that seeking all the pleasures of this life are vain and in the end they are of nothing but vanity. For both the wise of men and the fool of men are worthless without walking in the Way of the Father under the "Sun of God" - Jesus Christ (*1 Kin. 4:20-28*).

→ **Ecclesiastes 2:1-26** ¹I said in my heart, "Come now, I will test you with mirth; therefore enjoy pleasure"; but surely, this also was vanity. ²I said of laughter—"Madness!"; and of mirth, "What does it accomplish?" ³I searched in my heart how to gratify my flesh with wine, while guiding my heart with wisdom, and how to lay hold on folly, till I might see what was good for the sons of men to do under heaven all the days of their lives. ⁴I made my works great, I built myself houses, and planted myself vineyards. ⁵I made myself gardens and orchards, and I planted all kinds of fruit trees in them. ⁶I made myself water pools from which to water the growing trees of the grove. ⁷I acquired male and female servants, and had servants born in my house. Yes, I had greater possessions of herds and flocks than all who were in Jerusalem before me. ⁸I also gathered for myself silver and gold and the special treasures of kings and of the provinces. I acquired male and female singers, the delights of the sons of men, and musical instruments of all kinds. ⁹So I became great and excelled more than all who were before me in Jerusalem. Also my wisdom remained with me. ¹⁰Whatever my eyes desired I did not keep from them. I did not withhold my heart from any pleasure, for my heart rejoiced in all my labor; and this was my reward from all my labor. ¹¹**THEN I LOOKED ON ALL THE WORKS THAT MY HANDS HAD DONE AND ON THE LABOR IN WHICH I HAD TOILED;** and indeed all was vanity and grasping for the wind. There was no profit under the sun. ¹²Then I turned myself to consider wisdom and madness and folly; for what can the man do who succeeds the king?— Only what he has already done. ¹³Then I saw that wisdom excels folly as light excels darkness. ¹⁴The wise man's eyes are in his head, but the fool walks in darkness. Yet I myself perceived that the same event happens to them all. ¹⁵So I said in my heart, "As it happens to the fool, it also happens to me, and why was I then more wise?" Then I said in my heart, "this also is vanity." ¹⁶For there is no more remembrance of the wise than of the fool forever, since all that now is will be forgotten in the days to come. And how does a wise man die? As the fool! ¹⁷Therefore I hated life because the work that was done under the sun was distressing to me, for all is vanity and grasping for the wind. ¹⁸Then I hated all my labor in which I had toiled under the sun, because I must leave it to the man who will come after me. ¹⁹And who knows whether he will be wise or a fool? Yet he will rule over all my labor in which I toiled and in which I have shown myself wise under the sun. This also is vanity. ²⁰Therefore I turned my heart and despaired of all the labor in which I had toiled under the sun. ²¹For there is a man whose labor is with wisdom, knowledge, and skill; yet he must leave his heritage to a man who has not labored for it. This also is vanity and a great evil. ²²For what has man for all his labor, and for the striving of his heart with which he has toiled under the sun? ²³For all his days are sorrowful, and his work burdensome; even in the night his heart takes no rest. This also is vanity. ²⁴Nothing is better for a man than that he should eat and drink, and that his soul should enjoy good in his labor. This also, I saw, was from the hand of God. ²⁵For who can eat, or who can have enjoyment, more than I? ²⁶For God gives wisdom and knowledge and joy to a man who is good in His sight; but to the sinner He gives the work of gathering and collecting, that He may give to him who is Good before God. This also is vanity and grasping for the wind.

Do You Know How To Ride Upon His Four Spirits of the Heavens

In Section 2 of this Part 2 of The Top Secret, we considered the following Prophetic Word of God that as given on May 5, 2010. We have just read Zech. 6:1-8 regarding His Four Horses that are His Four Spirits of the Heavens that are sent out to give Rest to His Spirit – His Words – that are in the Heavens. Consider this Prophetic Word and then we will consider the Ways of His Four Spirits.

The May 5th, 2010, Prophetic Word About His Call To Ride His Four Spirits of the Heavens:

“START SEEKING ME. DO NOT STALL AND DO NOT THINK TO DO SO LATER.

My Time is fast approaching and all must be ready and in place.

TAKE CARE THAT YOU KNOW MY VOICE ,

Look! Do you see the people? Look at them flee, while none give chase. They run to the hills. But you ... you must run to the mountain, for mighty is a mountain. **MOUNT UP ON YOUR WINGS AND REACH THE PEAK. TO ZION! TO ZION!**

(Today's church is following the words of unwise leaders instead of seeking the Wisdom of His Power and Plan for man, but the Lord is calling them to seek His Mountain - per Jer. 50:6)
