

Notes of Floyd E. Taylor for Feb. 10, 2011 Teleconference Bible Study

More Scripture Mixed Bag - and the John the Baptist vision confirmation of Psalm 50.

I would like to continue with the reviewing of Scriptures from last night -Luke 9-10.

I would first like to look at Psalm 51 and consider a few Prophetic Words from today.

A Prayer of Repentance

To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David when Nathan the prophet went to him, after he had gone in to Bathsheba.

- **Psalm 51:1-19** ¹Have mercy upon me, O God, according to Your loving kindness; according to the multitude of Your tender mercies, blot out my transgressions. ²Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin. ³For I acknowledge my transgressions, and my sin is always before me. ⁴Against You, You only, have I sinned, and done this evil in Your sight— that You may be found just when You speak, and blameless when You judge. ⁵Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, and in sin my mother conceived me. ⁶Behold, You desire truth in the inward parts, and in the hidden part You will make me to know wisdom. ⁷Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. ⁸Make me hear joy and gladness, that the bones You have broken may rejoice. ⁹Hide Your face from my sins, and blot out all my iniquities. ¹⁰Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. ¹¹Do not cast me away from Your presence, and do not take Your Holy Spirit from me. ¹²Restore to me the joy of Your salvation, and uphold me by Your generous Spirit. ¹³Then I will teach transgressors Your ways, and sinners shall be converted to You. ¹⁴Deliver me from the guilt of bloodshed, O God, **the God of my salvation, and my tongue shall sing aloud of Your righteousness.** ¹⁵O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth shall show forth Your praise. ¹⁶**For You do not desire sacrifice, or else I would give it; You do not delight in burnt offering.** ¹⁷**THE SACRIFICES OF GOD ARE A BROKEN SPIRIT, A BROKEN AND A CONTRITE HEART — THESE, O GOD, YOU WILL NOT DESPISE.** ¹⁸Do Good in Your Good pleasure to Zion; build the walls of Jerusalem. ¹⁹Then You shall be pleased with the sacrifices of righteousness, with burnt offering and whole burnt offering; then they shall offer bulls on Your altar.

Let us again consider this statements of Paul and consider what Jesus said and the Authority He gives for keeping the "Love of the Truth"

- **2 Thessalonians 2:9-12** ⁹The coming of the lawless one is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and lying wonders, ¹⁰and with all unrighteous deception among those who perish, because **THEY DID NOT RECEIVE THE LOVE OF THE TRUTH, THAT THEY MIGHT BE SAVED.** ¹¹And **for this reason God will send them strong delusion**, that they should believe the lie, ¹²that they all may be condemned who did not believe the Truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness.
- **John 14:23-24** ²³Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My Word; and the Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him. ²⁴**HE WHO DOES NOT LOVE ME DOES NOT KEEP MY WORDS; and the Word which you hear is not Mine but the Fathers who sent Me."**

Suddenly – Like Lightning - the Lord is Coming to Execute His Iron Judgment!

Matthew 16:27 "For the Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and then He will reward each according to his works."

**Behold, The Bridegroom Is Coming;
Go Out To Meet Him!**

Matthew 24:27 "For as the lightning comes from the East and flashes to the West, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be."



Hello, I am Floyd E. Taylor. The Father has given me unique testimonies of His knowledge to made known. They testify He raised me up to reveal His Day.

For the past seven years and nine months the Father has been using me to make known a continuous outpouring of the knowledge of Truth from the Scriptures regarding this very Time. He has raised me up and armed me with a Testimony that could have only come forth from Him. No one else has been given the Knowledge of Truth the Father has provided through me. This was so you would know it was His Message, as He promised in Mal. 3:1-2, that He would send just before the Appearing of the Lord Jesus Christ in His Glory.

His Morning and Night has come upon the world. The Lord will now appear like Lightning that flashes from the East to the West. We have no excuse for not knowing the Appointed Time of the rising of the Lord as the Morning Star –the Sun of Righteousness – has come and that it is right now at hand! The Lord Jesus told us in Mk. 13:35-37 that we are to watch and that we are required to be prepared, and He made this statement because He said that we did not know whether the Father would be sending Him in the Evening of His Day, at the Midnight of His Day, at the Time of the Crowing of the Rooster in His Day, or in the Time of the Morning of His Day. Well, the truth is now unavoidable to miss, for the bible testifies, and the Lord Himself has testified through multiples of Prophetic visions and Prophetic Words that the first three events have already occurred. Thus, we are in the time of the Morning of the Day of the Lord. Therefore the waiting Time has expired and His Appointed Time to Appear in the Heavens in His Glory to Judge the Harvest and to give the reward to each and every person in accordance to their works is now imminent. All those who now refuse to immediately hear His Words and receive the knowledge of Truth will receive their just reward: punishment and ruin.

RED ALERT: Very Little Time Remains to Receive the Knowledge of Truth!!!!!! His Morning Has Come! The Sun is Rising! Lamps Will Be Put Out In His Night!

Mark 13:35-37 "Watch therefore, for you do not know when the master of the house is coming—in the evening, at midnight, at the crowing of the rooster, or in the morning— lest, coming suddenly, he find you sleeping. And what I say to you, I say to all: Watch!"

The Father causes the Day of the Lord to begin by causing knowledge of Truth to be received by a man sent like Jonah. April 2003

The Evening of His Day. His Wisdom calls out Her Words that gives Light and Understanding in all His Churches Apr '03 to Mar '10

The Midnight of His Day. The Morning Comes and the Night Is. 21:10-12. The virgins still sleep and they nod. End of Mar 30, 2010

His Morning Comes for the Wise and His Sun is Rises in them; but, for the complacent and the unwise the Night of His Day has come and the Affliction of Joseph has come upon them. The unwise are going into financial ruin and no food. The Great Tribulation comes and then immediately afterwards He closes the blessing of the Heavens to the Unwise and the wicked. In Mt. 24:20 He warns to hope that our flight from persecution does not come upon us in the Winter. He is saying to come out in this Winter - before the Spring '11. His last door call!
(His Brides must gain His Seal of Truth now so they can be purified, made white, refined, and made ready for His Coming in Oct. '16)

7 Year Evening of His Day – Light is Available – Zech. 14:7

7 Year Night of His Day – Light Goes out of the Unwise – Zech. 14:6, Mt. 25:8, Jn. 9:4

Never Ending Morning of His Day – the Wise take His Light – Mt. 25:1-13, Ps. 119:130

The Father causes a messenger to open the knowledge of His Truth - His Words having His Promises of Good Works with the Power to overcome the world. This fulfills His Promise of Mal. 3:1-2.

The Father draws His messenger to seek the Knowledge of Truth from the Lord. The Lord pours out His Spirit upon him, causing him to have understanding of His Words having in them all His Works – per Ps. 33:4. Through him the Father provides the knowledge of Truth to prepare the Way for the coming of His Son as the Morning Star – the Sun of Righteousness. As He did for John the Baptist, the Father gives His messenger unique knowledge and unique understanding to testify of and to prepare the Way for the coming of the Lord in His Glory. Through Floyd Taylor the Father opens the Scriptures and provides the knowledge of the Creation, the Times, and much more, so the people are able to know it is His message and it is the Time of His Appearing to rule over the new Heavens.

From Apr 2010 to Feb 2011, the Father gave three Rooster calls to warn the people to come, for Morning has come and His Sun rises.
 The Lord gives the message to the Church in April 2010 that they are about to be cast out, and that they are destroying the Glory of the Lord with their complacent teachings and false teachings. In May the Lord says His Wisdom has left the Church and gone out to the highways and hedges to call out Her Words.

 The Lord warned us in 1 Thess. 5:1-3 that when they say Peace and Safety, then know that sudden destruction comes upon these wicked and the complacent who will not hear Him. The Queen gave her speech at the UN on July 6th. On July 11th the Lord gave us a total eclipse of the sun over Easter Island. It was the sign of the confirmation that this was the speech of Gog's hook in the jaw.

 The Lord gave the Word in Sept 2010 that the Threshing Time of His harvest has come. He warned the Elect they are in Darkness.

*His Evening has past. His Midnight is gone.
His rooster has crowed. His Morning has come.
His Sun is now rising - He comes with a fiery
heat. He said that those who have not heard
His Words are not of God - Jn. 8:47.
When His Sun has risen, will you be able to
stand without His Seal of Truth?*

From the example of Peter, we see that the Lord gave the sign of the Rooster crowing to make known that the Elect are denying His Words and His Power, and they do not have understanding of His Plan for overcoming the world. When the Lord told us in Mark 13:35-37 that there will be a Rooster Crow in this Day of the Lord, we should have known that it meant that we, like Peter, are going to be caught in a snare of our Words. Peter denied the Lord three times. It was not until after the Cross when Jesus opened the knowledge of His Words to the disciples (Lk. 24:44-45) that Peter had understanding, and after that He testified of the Lord and spoke of the Truth that Jesus came into the world to bear witness of these Words of God. Likewise the church of today has denied the invitation of the Lord to receive His Words. The Cry has gone out at least three times, but they deny Him!

Malachi 4:2 But to you who fear My Name the Sun of Righteousness shall arise with healing in His wings; and you shall go out and grow fat like stall-fed calves. *(Stall-fed calves are kept by their Master until they are perfected in His Day.)*

2 Peter 1:19 And so we have the Prophetic Word confirmed, which you do well to heed as a Light that shines in a dark place, until the Day dawns and the Morning Star rises in your hearts; *(This is a Time to increase in knowledge.)*

Ps. 19: 1-6 The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament shows His handiwork. Day unto day utters speech, and night unto night reveals knowledge. There is no Speech nor Language where their Voice is not heard. Their line has gone out through all the earth, and their Words to the end of the world. In them He has set a tabernacle for the Sun, which is like a Bridegroom coming out of His chamber, and rejoices like a strong man to run its race. Its rising is from one end of heaven, and its circuit to the other end; and there is nothing hidden from its heat.

Now His Kingdom Comes

John 8:47 He who is of God hears God's Words; therefore you do not hear, because you are not of God.

Luke 21:34-36 ³⁴“But take heed to yourselves, lest your hearts be weighed down with dissipation, drunkenness, and cares of this life, and that Day come on you unexpectedly. ³⁵For it will come as a snare on all those who dwell on the face of the whole earth. ³⁶WATCH therefore, and PRAY always that you may be counted worthy to escape all these things that will come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man.”

Job 24:1 “Since times are not hidden from the Almighty, why do those who know Him see not His days?”

John 8:45-47 ⁴⁵But because I tell the Truth, you do not believe Me. ⁴⁶Which of you convicts Me of sin? And if I tell the Truth, why do you not believe Me? ⁴⁷He who is of God hears God's Words; therefore you do not hear, because you are not of God.” (*The Father and the Scriptures testify to His Words.*)

Titus 1:16 They profess to know God, but in works they deny Him, being disobedient, and disqualified for every Good Work.

Ps. 119:130 “The Entrance of His Words Gives Light, and Gives Understanding to the Simple.” (*Ps. 119:142 says His Words – His Truth - are Law!*)

Ecl. 8:4 Where the Word of a King is, there is Power; and who may say to him, “What are you doing?” (*Consider Jn. 18:37.*)

Pr. 1:23 “Turn at My reproof: Surely I will pour out My Spirit on you. I will make My Words known to you.”



It saddens me that there are so many whose light is about to be put out. I have tried to make His Words known. He warned that all of them would be caught in the snare. But, sadly they will not hear, nor do they believe the Bible they say that they love!

We are without excuse for not understanding the Times. In Job 24:1 we are asked why do we do not know the times since they are not hidden from the Father, and we claim that we know Him. The Lord told us to watch for the Word of the Father; but, just as it was in the days of Jesus the elite shepherds refused to receive the knowledge of His Words – the knowledge of Truth. Jesus was sent into the world to speak the Words of God and to show the people His Good Works. In John 3:32 it is made clear that none received His testimony. Jesus testified of this in John 18:37-38, and He made it clear that not one had heard His voice, for there was not one standing beside Him in front of Pilate. Even His disciples had fled. They did not receive the knowledge of His Words from Him until after He returned from Heaven – Lk. 24:44-45. God told the shepherds of this Day that He would send a messenger before His Appearing. They should have been watching for His single messenger making known the knowledge of His Words. But, they have rejected His Words. In so doing they have rejected the invitations of God to come and eat the bread of the Kingdom of God. They have rejected the Scroll of Truth that Jesus has opened.

RECEIVE YOUR DIVINE MOMENT

Yes, these are desperate times; rumors of wars, wars, earthquakes, hurricanes, floods, financial ruins, sickness, and marriage break-ups. In the eyes of man hopelessness and despair is running rampant upon the earth. But, I am a God who is bigger than all the struggles of life; a God of love who cares for the birds of the fields.

Yes, I am a God who cares for you, and who sent My son Jesus Christ to die on the cross so that you could be saved and redeemed. Jesus' life on earth was a divine moment. His whole life is a divine moment that redeems sinners and sets the captives free, and He desires that none should perish. As do I, The Great God Jehovah!

Many like Noah have experienced Godly encounters; yes defining moments that have brought forth change because of the response to that divine encounter. This moment of great encounter with ME, demarcates the old from the new. A defining moment is when the old ceases to exist and the new bursts forth like the spring. A defining moment is when everything changes for the one who has the divine encounter with The One True, Holy and Living God. It is a moment of transformation and transition. The person may look the same on the outside. But after that moment very little is the same at all about them. Those who are sensitive and discerning will notice a tremendous difference in the person; in their moods, their demeanor, their character, their temperament, their perspective, and most of all their faith and their ability to wait upon Me to move out and to do what I want them to do. They will wait patiently until I give them specific instructions to move, or to speak or to act. They will wait upon Me all their days just as Noah waited; patiently, faithfully and obediently.

My wind is blowing, My Holy Spirit is moving and many of you shall receive a divine moment which will bring change. As you yield to Me and do not resist Me. Say "yes" to Me, instead of "no." Some will raise their hands and be filled with My presence to overflowing. Many will have Godly encounters this year, which will be defining moments; a divine moment where you shall be endued with My power, authority and boldness.

You will have the same boldness that the three exhibited when they spoke to the earthly king, and did not fear the furnace, but trusted completely in Me. You will run with Holy Spirit fire. The trials, tests, struggles and desperate situations serve only to strengthen you and they will depart from you as My goal is achieved.

Things that used to trouble you will no longer bother you at all. You will be like battle wise warriors. Doors of Distinction

February 11, 2011

The word "door" is spoken of literally as well as being used in metaphors in the Word of God. Doors speak of entrances, access points, passages, or portals to transition from one place to another. The term "open doors" is used figuratively as an invitation or opportunity. On the other hand, the term "closed doors" speaks of preventing us from entering a particular place or restricts us from entering a particular situation.

Doors could keep you in a certain place and locked doors can prevent you from entering or exiting. In the Gospel of John chapter ten verse seven, Jesus speaks of Himself as being a door. The Lord gave me the following word. It is for our benefit to choose the right doors in the days ahead.

Doors Of Distinction

The Lord says I desire to answer your prayers, move in your life and meet all your needs, but you must first close the doors to anything that would hinder you from receiving My promises. I have given you a free will. I have placed before you doors that lead to life and doors that lead to death and I have told you to choose life. The decisions that you make today will effect your days ahead. The doors that you choose will effect your own destiny of either blessing or cursing.

I am well able to turn those situations around that are wreaking havoc in your life and bringing weariness to your soul, but you must first close those doors that lead to death and destruction. Close the doors on relationships of ungodly soul ties to people that will hinder you and

drag you down. Surround yourself with people of faith and encouragement. As you do this, you will then be able to come into the blessings that I have for you. I have provided for you all things that pertain to life and godliness. Ask Me for discernment in your personal situations and decisions to be made. As you walk through the proper doors, I will release you from the turmoil in your life and the confusion in your mind. Choose doors of wisdom and I will lead you into new beginnings and times of refreshing, says the Lord.

Deuteronomy 30:19 I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing; therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live;

Revelation 3:8 I know your works. See, I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it; for you

Peter Confesses Jesus as the Christ (*Matt. 16:13-20; Mark 8:27-30*)

- **Luke 9:18-20** ¹⁸And it happened, as He was alone praying, that His disciples joined Him, and He asked them, saying, "Who do the crowds say that I am?" ¹⁹So they answered and said, "John the Baptist, but some say Elijah; and others say that one of the old prophets has risen again." ²⁰He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" Peter answered and said, "The Christ of God."

Jesus Predicts His Death and Resurrection (*Matt. 16:20-23; Mark 8:30-33*)

- **Luke 9:21-22** ²¹And He strictly warned and commanded them to tell this to no one, ²²saying, "The Son of Man must suffer many things, and be rejected by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised the third day."

Take Up the Cross and Follow Him (*Matt. 16:24-27; Mark 8:34-38*)

- **Luke 9:23-26** ²³Then He said to *them* all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me. ²⁴For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will save it. ²⁵For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and is himself destroyed or lost? ²⁶For whoever is ashamed of Me and My Words, of him the Son of Man will be ashamed when He comes in His own glory, and in His Father's, and of the holy angels.

Jesus Transfigured on the Mount

- **Luke 9:27-36** ²⁷But I tell you truly, there are some standing here who shall not taste death till they see the kingdom of God." ²⁸Now it came to pass, about eight days after these sayings, that He took Peter, John, and James and went up on the mountain to pray. ²⁹As He prayed, the appearance of His face was altered, and His robe became white and glistening. ³⁰And behold, two men talked with Him, who were Moses and Elijah, ³¹who appeared in glory and spoke of His decease which He was about to accomplish at Jerusalem. ³²But Peter and those with him were heavy with sleep; and when they were fully awake, they saw His glory and the two men who stood with Him. ³³Then it happened, as they were parting from Him, that Peter said to Jesus, "Master, it is good for us to be here; and let us make three tabernacles: one for You, one for Moses, and one for Elijah"—not knowing what he said. ³⁴While he was saying this, a cloud came and overshadowed them; and they were fearful as they entered the cloud. ³⁵And a voice came out of the cloud, saying, "This is My beloved Son. Hear Him!" ³⁶When the voice had ceased, Jesus was found alone. But they kept quiet, and told no one in those days any of the things they had seen.

A Boy Is Healed (*Matt. 17:14-21; Mark 9:14-29*)

- **Luke 9:37-42** ³⁷Now it happened on the next day, when they had come down from the mountain, that a great multitude met Him. ³⁸Suddenly a man from the multitude cried out, saying, "Teacher, I implore You, look on my son, for he is my only child. ³⁹And behold, a spirit seizes him, and he suddenly cries out; it convulses him so that he foams at the mouth; and it departs from him with great difficulty, bruising him. ⁴⁰So I implored Your disciples to cast it out, but they could not." ⁴¹Then Jesus answered and said, "O faithless

and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you and bear with you? Bring your son here." ⁴²And **AS HE WAS STILL COMING**, the demon threw him down and convulsed him. Then Jesus rebuked the unclean spirit, healed the child, and gave him back to his father.

Jesus Again Predicts His Death (*Matt. 17:22, 23; Mark 9:30-32*)

- **Luke 9:43-45** ⁴³And they were all amazed at the majesty of God. But while everyone marveled at all the things which Jesus did, He said to His disciples, ⁴⁴"Let these words sink down into your ears, for the Son of Man is about to be betrayed into the hands of men." ⁴⁵But they did not understand this saying, and it was hidden from them so that they did not perceive it; and they were afraid to ask Him about this saying.

Who Is the Greatest? (*Matt. 18:1-5; Mark 9:33-37*)

- **Luke 9:46-48** ⁴⁶Then a dispute arose among them as to which of them would be greatest. ⁴⁷And Jesus, perceiving the thought of their heart, took a little child and set him by Him, ⁴⁸and said to them, "Whoever receives this little child in My name receives Me; and whoever receives Me receives Him who sent Me. For he who is least among you all will be great."

Jesus Forbids Sectarianism (*Mark 9:38-41*)

- **Luke 9:49-50** ⁴⁹Now John answered and said, "Master, we saw someone casting out demons in Your name, and we forbade him because he does not follow with us." ⁵⁰But Jesus said to him, "Do not forbid him, for he who is not against us is on our side."

A Samaritan Village Rejects the Savior

- **Luke 9:51-56** ⁵¹Now it came to pass, when the time had come for Him to be received up, that He steadfastly set His face to go to Jerusalem, ⁵²and sent messengers before His face. And as they went, they entered a village of the Samaritans, to prepare for Him. ⁵³But they did not receive Him, because His face was set for the journey to Jerusalem. ⁵⁴And when His disciples James and John saw this, they said, "Lord, do You want us to command fire to come down from heaven and consume them, just as Elijah did?" ⁵⁵But He turned and rebuked them, and said, "You do not know what manner of spirit you are of. ⁵⁶For the Son of Man did not come to destroy men's lives but to save *them*." And they went to another village.

The Cost of Discipleship (*Matt. 8:18-22*)

- **Luke 9:57-62** ⁵⁷Now it happened as they journeyed on the road, that someone said to Him, "Lord, I will follow You wherever You go." ⁵⁸And Jesus said to him, "Foxes have holes and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay His head." ⁵⁹Then He said to another, "Follow Me." But he said, "Lord, let me first go and bury my father." ⁶⁰Jesus said to him, "Let the dead bury their own dead, but you go and preach the kingdom of God." ⁶¹And another also said, "Lord, I will follow You, but let me first go and bid them farewell who are at my house." ⁶²But Jesus said to him, "No one, having put his hand to the plow, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God."

The Seventy Sent Out Sending the Seventy; the Good Samaritan

- **Luke 10:1-12** ¹After these things the Lord appointed seventy others also, and sent them two by two before His face into every city and place where He Himself was about to go. ²Then He said to them, "The harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest. ³Go your way; behold, I send you out as lambs among wolves. ⁴Carry neither money bag, knapsack, nor sandals; and greet no one along the road. ⁵But whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this house.' ⁶And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest on it; if not, it will return to you. ⁷And remain in the same house, eating and drinking such things as they give, for the laborer is worthy of his wages. Do not go from house to house. ⁸Whatever city you enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you. ⁹And heal the sick there, and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.' ¹⁰But whatever city you enter, and they do not receive you, go out into its streets and say, ¹¹'The very dust of your city which clings to us we wipe off against you. Nevertheless know this, that the kingdom of God has come near you.' ¹²But I say to you that it will be more tolerable in that Day for Sodom than for that city.

Woe to the Impenitent Cities (*Matt. 11:20-24*)

- **Luke 10:13-16** ¹³"Woe to you, Chorazin! (*This name means "the secret", or "here is a mystery". This seems to point out that this is bad news for the Church in this Day, for in Ephesians 5:25-32 Paul calls this Good News Message of His Words to be the Mystery hidden in the Church, and that like Chorazin, the church has not found the Mystery of God that was openly made known by the Lord and called out by the Father.*) Woe to you, Bethsaida! (*This name means "house of fruits, or of food, or of snares". This seems to indicate a similar meaning as the name for Chorazin, for their name the Father honored and they would not receive the food of His Words and they did not produce fruit even though God had called them by their Name and had shown in them the Way. Such is the result of the Church, for the Greek word in the New Testament that is translated as church means "those called out".*) For if the mighty works which were done in you had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago, sitting in sackcloth and ashes. ¹⁴But it will be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon at the judgment than for you. ¹⁵And you, Capernaum, who are exalted to heaven, will be brought down to Hades. ¹⁶He who hears you hears Me, he who rejects you rejects Me, and he who rejects Me rejects Him who sent Me."

The Seventy Return with Joy

- **Luke 10:17-20** ¹⁷Then the seventy returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your Name." ¹⁸And He said to them, "**I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven.** ¹⁹Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you. ²⁰Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice because your names are written in heaven."

Remember from past two nights that Jesus is coming suddenly - like Lightning. Lightning is wisdom being revealed.

- **Matthew 24:27** "For as the lightning comes from the East and flashes to the West, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be."

Jesus Rejoices in the Spirit (*Matt. 11:25-27*)

- **Luke 10:21-24** ²¹In that hour Jesus rejoiced in the Spirit and said, "I thank You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from the wise and prudent and revealed them to babes. Even so, Father, for so it seemed good in Your sight. ²²All things have been delivered to Me by My Father, and no one knows who the Son is except the Father, and who the Father is except the

Son, and *the one* to whom the Son wills to reveal *Him*." ²³Then He turned to His disciples and said privately, "Blessed are the eyes which see the things you see; ²⁴for I tell you that many prophets and kings have desired to see what you see, and have not seen it, and to hear what you hear, and have not heard it."

The Parable of the Good Samaritan (*Matt. 22:34-40; Mark 12:28-34*)

↪ **Luke 10:25-37** ²⁵And behold, a certain lawyer stood up and tested Him, saying, "Teacher, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?" ²⁶He said to him, "What is written in the law? What is your reading of it?" ²⁷So he answered and said, "You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and 'your neighbor as yourself.'" (No options and ifs were given in this by the Lord.) ²⁸And He said to him, "You have answered rightly; do this and you will live." (This is important in this Time of the Great Tribulation if we want to live through and fulfill what the Lord has called us to do. We cannot say that we serve Him and then disobey Him in this that He says is what is required of us in order to obtain Eternal Life. The Lord says that we are required to show Mercy even on all those who have fallen under the curse of the thieves of Babylon, as we will see in verses 29-37, for they were only taught wrongly, just like us.) ²⁹But he, wanting to justify himself, said to Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?" ³⁰Then Jesus answered and said: "A certain man went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves, who stripped him of his clothing, wounded him, and departed, leaving him half dead. ³¹Now by chance a certain priest came down that road. And when he saw him, he passed by on the other side. ³²Likewise a Levite, when he arrived at the place, came and looked, and passed by on the other side. ³³But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was. And when he saw him, he had compassion. ³⁴So he went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine; and he set him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and took care of him. ³⁵On the next day, when he departed, he took out two denarii, gave them to the innkeeper, and said to him, 'Take care of him; and whatever more you spend, when I come again, I will repay you.' ³⁶So which of these three do you think was neighbor to him who fell among the thieves?" ³⁷And he said, "He who showed mercy on him." Then Jesus said to him, "Go and do likewise."

Mary and Martha Worship and Serve

↪ **Luke 10:38-42** ³⁸Now it happened as they went that He entered a certain village; and a certain woman named Martha welcomed Him into her house. ³⁹And she had a sister called Mary, who also sat at Jesus' feet and heard His Word. ⁴⁰But Martha was distracted with much serving, and she approached Him and said, "Lord, do You not care that my sister has left me to serve alone? Therefore tell her to help me." ⁴¹And Jesus answered and said to her, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and troubled about many things. ⁴²But one thing is needed, and Mary has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her."

The Parable of the Rich Fool

↪ **Luke 12:13-21** ¹³Then one from the crowd said to Him, "Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me." ¹⁴But He said to him, "Man, who made Me a judge or an arbitrator over you?" ¹⁵And He said to them, "Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses." ¹⁶Then He spoke a parable to them, saying: "The ground of a certain rich man yielded plentifully. ¹⁷And he thought within himself, saying, 'What shall I do, since I have no room to store my crops?' ¹⁸So he said, 'I will do this: I will pull down my barns and build greater, and there I will store all my crops and my

goods. ¹⁹ And I will say to my soul, "Soul, you have many goods laid up for many years; take your ease; eat, drink, and be merry." ²⁰ BUT GOD SAID TO HIM, 'FOOL! THIS NIGHT YOUR SOUL WILL BE REQUIRED OF YOU; THEN WHOSE WILL THOSE THINGS BE WHICH YOU HAVE PROVIDED?' ²¹ SO IS HE WHO LAYS UP TREASURE FOR HIMSELF, AND IS NOT RICH TOWARD GOD."

Do Not Worry

- **Luke 12:22-34** ²²Then He said to His disciples, "Therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat; nor about the body, what you will put on. ²³Life is more than food, and the body is more than clothing. ²⁴Consider the ravens, for they neither sow nor reap, which have neither storehouse nor barn; and God feeds them. Of how much more value are you than the birds? ²⁵And which of you by worrying can add one cubit to his stature? ²⁶If you then are not able to do the least, why are you anxious for the rest? ²⁷Consider the lilies, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin; and yet I say to you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. ²⁸If then God so clothes the grass, which today is in the field and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, how much more will He clothe you, O you of little faith? ²⁹And do not seek what you should eat or what you should drink, NOR HAVE AN ANXIOUS MIND. ³⁰For all these things the nations of the world seek after, and your Father knows that you need these things. ³¹But seek the kingdom of God, and all these things shall be added to you. ³²DO NOT FEAR, LITTLE FLOCK, FOR IT IS YOUR FATHER'S GOOD PLEASURE TO GIVE YOU THE KINGDOM. ³³Sell what you have and give alms; provide yourselves money bags which do not grow old, a treasure in the heavens that does not fail, where no thief approaches nor moth destroys. ³⁴For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

The Light, the hate, and the basket Scriptures and Parables of hidden revelation are interesting. We must be careful, for He sees and reveals.

- **Mark 4:21-25** ²¹Also He said to them, "Is a lamp brought to be put under a basket or under a bed? Is it not to be set on a lampstand? ²²For there is nothing hidden which will not be revealed, nor has anything been kept secret but that it should come to light. ²³If anyone has ears to hear, let him hear." ²⁴Then He said to them, "Take heed what you hear. With the same measure you use, it will be measured to you; and to you who hear, more will be given. ²⁵For whoever has, to him more will be given; but whoever does not have, even what he has will be taken away from him."
- **Luke 8:16-21** ¹⁶"No one, when he has lit a lamp, covers it with a vessel or puts it under a bed, but sets it on a lampstand, that those who enter may see the light. ¹⁷For nothing is secret that will not be revealed, nor anything hidden that will not be known and come to light. ¹⁸Therefore take heed how you hear. For whoever has, to him more will be given; and whoever does not have, even what he seems to have will be taken from him." ¹⁹Then His mother and brothers came to Him, and could not approach Him because of the crowd. ²⁰And it was told Him by some, who said, "Your mother and Your brothers are standing outside, desiring to see You." ²¹But He answered and said to them, "My mother and My brothers are these who hear the word of God and do it."
- **Luke 12:1-3** ¹In the meantime, when an innumerable multitude of people had gathered together, so that they trampled one another, He began to say to His disciples first of all, "Beware of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy. ²For there is nothing covered that

will not be revealed, nor hidden that will not be known. ³Therefore whatever you have spoken in the dark will be heard in the light, and what you have spoken in the ear in inner rooms will be proclaimed on the housetops.

The Faithful Servant and the Evil Servant

→ **Luke 12:35-48** ³⁵"Let your waist be girded and your lamps burning; ³⁶and you yourselves be like men who wait for their master, when he will return from the wedding, that when he comes and knocks they may open to him immediately. ³⁷Blessed are those servants whom the master, when he comes, will find watching. Assuredly, I say to you that he will gird himself and have them sit down to eat, and will come and serve them. ³⁸And if he should come in the second watch, or come in the third watch, and find them so, blessed are those servants. ³⁹But know this, that if the master of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched and not allowed his house to be broken into. ⁴⁰Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect." ⁴¹Then Peter said to Him, "Lord, do You speak this parable only to us, or to all people?" ⁴²And the Lord said, "Who then is that faithful and wise steward, whom his master will make ruler over his household, to give them their portion of food in due season? ⁴³Blessed is that servant whom his master will find so doing when he comes. ⁴⁴Truly, I say to you that he will make him ruler over all that he has. ⁴⁵But if that servant says in his heart, 'My master is delaying his coming,' and begins to beat the male and female servants, and to eat and drink and be drunk, ⁴⁶the master of that servant will come on a day when he is not looking for him, and at an hour when he is not aware, and will cut him in two and appoint him his portion with the unbelievers. ⁴⁷And that servant who knew his master's will, and did not prepare himself or do according to his will, shall be beaten with many stripes. ⁴⁸But he who did not know, yet committed things deserving of stripes, shall be beaten with few. For everyone to whom much is given, from him much will be required; and to whom much has been committed, of him they will ask the more.

Christ Brings Division

→ **Luke 12:49-53** ⁴⁹"I came to send fire on the earth, and how I wish it were already kindled! ⁵⁰But I have a baptism to be baptized with, and how distressed I am till it is accomplished! ⁵¹Do you suppose that I came to give peace on earth? I tell you, not at all, but rather division. ⁵²For from now on five in one house will be divided: three against two, and two against three. ⁵³Father will be divided against son and son against father, mother against daughter and daughter against mother, mother-in-law against her daughter-in-law and daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law."

→ **Matthew 10:34-38** ³⁴"Do not think that I came to bring peace on earth. I did not come to bring peace but a sword. ³⁵For I have come to 'set a man against his father, a daughter against her mother, and a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law'; ³⁶and 'a man's enemies will be those of his own household.' ³⁷He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me. ³⁸And he who does not take his cross and follow after Me is not worthy of Me. ³⁹He who finds his life will lose it, and he who loses his life for My sake will find it.

Discern the Time

- **Luke 12:54-56** ⁵⁴Then He also said to the multitudes, "Whenever you see a cloud rising out of the west, immediately you say, 'A shower is coming'; and so it is. ⁵⁵And when you see the south wind blow, you say, 'There will be hot weather'; and there is. ⁵⁶Hypocrites! You can discern the face of the sky and of the earth, but **HOW IS IT YOU DO NOT DISCERN THIS TIME?**

Make Peace with Your Adversary

- **Luke 12:57-59** ⁵⁷"Yes, and why, even of yourselves, do you not judge what is right? ⁵⁸When you go with your adversary to the magistrate, make every effort along the way to settle with him, lest he drag you to the judge, the judge deliver you to the officer, and the officer throw you into prison. ⁵⁹I tell you, you shall not depart from there till you have paid the very last mite."

The Salt verses are interesting for they reveal some intriguing things. Also remember Lot's wife.

- **Matthew 5:13-16** ¹³"You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men. ¹⁴"You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. ¹⁵Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. ¹⁶Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.
- **Luke 14:34-35** ³⁴"Salt is good; but if the salt has lost its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? ³⁵It is neither fit for the land nor for the dunghill, but men throw it out. He who has ears to hear, let him hear!"
- **Mark 9:38-50** ³⁸Now John answered Him, saying, "Teacher, we saw someone who does not follow us casting out demons in Your name, and we forbade him because he does not follow us." ³⁹But Jesus said, "Do not forbid him, for no one who works a miracle in My name can soon afterward speak evil of Me. ⁴⁰For he who is not against us is on our side. ⁴¹For whoever gives you a cup of water to drink in My name, because you belong to Christ, assuredly, I say to you, he will by no means lose his reward. ⁴²"But whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in Me to stumble, it would be better for him if a millstone were hung around his neck, and he were thrown into the sea. ⁴³If your hand causes you to sin, cut it off. It is better for you to enter into life maimed, rather than having two hands, to go to hell, into the fire that shall never be quenched— ⁴⁴where 'Their worm does not die and the fire is not quenched.' ⁴⁵And if your foot causes you to sin, cut it off. It is better for you to enter life lame, rather than having two feet, to be cast into hell, into the fire that shall never be quenched— ⁴⁶where 'Their worm does not die and the fire is not quenched.' ⁴⁷And if your eye causes you to sin, pluck it out. It is better for you to enter the kingdom of God with one eye, rather than having two eyes, to be cast into hell fire— ⁴⁸where 'Their worm does not die and the fire is not quenched.' ⁴⁹"For everyone will be seasoned with fire, and every sacrifice will be seasoned with salt. ⁵⁰Salt is good, but if the salt loses its flavor, how will you season it? Have salt in yourselves, and have peace with one another."

Christians continue exodus from Iraq

Violence and intimidation have forced hundreds of thousands of Iraqi Christians to flee their homeland.

Experts view them as one of the biggest victims of the 2003 US-led invasion, with the minority group a continued target for extremists.

Every night Miriam gets ready for bed with her family. But it is not her bed. It is not even her house. Miriam and her family are Christian Iraqis who have been forced to flee from Baghdad to the semi-autonomous Kurdish region because they have become targets of extremist groups in the country.

In 2007, Miriam was hit by a bomb that was planted outside her house.

"I went out with my aunt just to buy some chocolate and come back. I went out and didn't see anything. I just heard the bomb and I fell to the ground," Miriam tells RT.

Miriam was lying in the street with her foot dangling from her leg. Her father, Ayad Ghranm Cherif, rushed outside.

"I saw my daughter lying on the ground. It was 11 at night," the man recalls. *"My daughter was lying on the ground and people were running, shouting. Everything was covered in dust and shards of glass. I picked up my daughter with her leg dangling. I almost lost it. I was shouting 'My daughter's dead. She's been hit by a bomb.'"*

Luckily, Ayad was able to get her to a doctor, who repaired her leg. But others have not been so lucky. In October last year, 56 people were killed in an attack on the Our Lady of Salvation Church in Baghdad. Dozens more were killed across the country in the following weeks.

Many fear that eventually Christians will be driven out of Iraq completely. Of the 800,000 Christians in the country before 2003, almost half have fled. In the past month alone, 4,000 have moved to the comparative safety of the northern Kurdish region.

Here they can worship and live in peace, but in leaving their homes, they have lost absolutely everything. Many, like Miriam's father, are now forced to make a living by cleaning toilets in bars and restaurants.

"I served for seven years in the military under Saddam. I'm an Iraqi Christian and I don't have a square foot of land to my name. Why? What's my crime?" Ayad said.

Many in the church feel that countries in the West are responsible.

"Americans are liars. We don't trust them," says Hawal Khezk Yemishow, director of the Chaldean Center. *"Their reputation is terrible, because everywhere they've been they've lied."*

"The US trained the Sunni and Shia and they just watch while they kill us. It's impossible not to see all these murders, but they don't get involved," he added.

It is the end of a long day and time for the family to go to bed. Everyone gets ready and eventually the lights are switched off. In the darkness and uncertainty, Miriam and the rest of her family are left to dream about, and hope for, a better tomorrow.
