

Notes of Floyd E. Taylor for Jan. 30, 2011 Teleconference Bible Study

Considering the Time of His Executing of the Harvest Judgment has come!

The Lord has given some special things for us tonight. What a day of revelation of knowledge of Truth from the Scriptures this has been. I do not have the time to write everything in the notes for tonight. I will tell you about these things. Also, the Lord gave Bobbie Westfall a vision that is as amazing in importance as was the two given to Christine. I will tell you what it was and reveal the meaning of this Prophetic Vision tonight. It was given at 7:00 AM this morning - the break of Dawn and that in itself should reveal how important it was.

- **Genesis 49:21** "Naphtali is a deer let loose; he uses beautiful Words.
- **Deuteronomy 33:23** And of Naphtali he said: "O Naphtali, satisfied with favor, and full of the blessing of the LORD, possess the west and the south."
- **Job 39:1** "Do you know the time when the wild mountain goats bear young? Or can you mark when the deer gives birth?"
- **Psa 29:9** The voice of the LORD makes the deer give birth, and strips the forests bare; and in His temple everyone says, "Glory!"
- **Psalm 50:1-6** ¹The Mighty One, God the LORD, has spoken and called the earth from the rising of the sun to its going down. ²Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God will shine forth. ³Our God shall come, and shall not keep silent; a fire shall devour before Him, and it shall be very tempestuous all around Him. ⁴He shall call to the heavens from above, and to the earth, that He may judge His people: ⁵"Gather My saints together to Me, those who have made a covenant with Me by sacrifice." ⁶Let the heavens declare His righteousness, for God Himself is Judge. Prophetic Vision (I will explain this Vision as we read it):

The Two Deer Let Loose On Earth

It was dawn, about 7 AM, and I had a Vision. I was in a large pickup truck with a back seat. I was sitting alongside a road near the woods. It was like when I was a youth and we went hunting with my father. He would have us sit in the truck alongside the road and wait on him while he went hunting. I was sitting in the front seat behind the wheel. There was a boy and another woman, whom I believe was my mother, sitting in the back seat. I believe the boy was my youngest son, but he was so much younger. I believe that was him because I heard his name called during this vision. In the back of the truck were our dogs.

I saw two very unusual deer come out from the woods on my left in front of me. The first deer was massively huge. It was like it was as big as a moose, but it was a deer. I have never heard of such a huge deer. Its neck was as big as a tree trunk. Its head was huge and its eyes glowed red. From its head there were eight horns, with four on each side. They were not like normal horns. They were each independent and yet there were four on one side and four on the other. They were each very tall. They were each like the long Jewish horn and they point straight up. They were like trees branches with a twist but yet straight. I knew the four represented the four spirits and the root of truth. But, there were four on both sides of the head. I know that the left represents justice and the right represents righteousness. Each horn was likened to a tree.



Following just behind the huge deer was a smaller deer. It also had the four horns on each side of its head but it was much smaller. However, there was something amazing about this deer. At the bottom of the horns on its head there were flowers growing all around the base of the horns. These flowers were all white like what grows in the forest. (They are called Baby's Breath, and it is what the brides carry.)

The young boy in the back seat opened the door and got out and started walking towards the big deer. The deer turned and started to come towards him. It was massive and its eyes were red, so the woman in the truck called out to the young boy to come and get back into the truck. He came back and got into the back seat. The massive deer kept coming and the other smaller deer followed it. The deer came and stood just outside my window and it stared at me with those red eyes. We were just staring at each other. Then the deer lowered its head and snorted from its nose and it pawed at the ground with its hoof. It then repeated this. It snorted again and pawed at the ground with its hoof again. Then it walked off. I then was looking at the face of the second deer. It was very pleasing and I felt comfortable. It nodded at me like it was reassuring me, and then it went off following the big deer. I then woke up.



I also want to reveal what I believe is a shocking revelation from Revelation 19 tonight. You will understand it once you see it, but it is like a total shock. The world was not expecting this.

- **John 9:4-5** ⁴"I must work the works of Him who sent Me while it is the day; for the Night is coming when no man can work. ⁵As long as I am in the world, I am the Light of the world."
- **Zechariah 14:6-7** ⁶It shall come to pass in that Day that there will be no Light; the glorious ones will diminish. (*It is important to discern the Lord promises that the Elect will diminish, for this is the Time of Judgment of the Midnight when 2/3's of His Church will be cast off per Zech. 13:8-9. The Day He is speaking of is the Gift of the Kingdom at Midnight when the wise virgins will shine like the Morning Star.*) ⁷It shall be one day which is known to the Lord - **NEITHER DAY NOR NIGHT**. But **AT EVENING TIME IT SHALL HAPPEN THAT IT WILL BE LIGHT**.
- **Revelation 19:1-21** ¹After these things I heard a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, "Alleluia! Salvation and glory and honor and power belong to the Lord our God! ²For true and righteous are His judgments, because He has judged the great harlot who corrupted the earth with her fornication; and He has avenged on her the blood of His servants shed by her." ³Again they said, "Alleluia! Her smoke rises up forever and ever!" ⁴And the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshiped God who sat on the throne, saying, "Amen! Alleluia!" ⁵Then a voice came from the throne, saying, "Praise our God, all you His servants and those who fear Him, both small and great!" ⁶And I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude, as the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty thunderings, saying, "Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns! ⁷Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready." ⁸And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints. ⁹Then he said to me, "Write: 'Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!' " And he said to me, "These are the true sayings of God." ¹⁰And I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, "See that you do not do that! I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy." ¹¹Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. ¹²His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. ¹³He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and **His name is called The Word of God**. ¹⁴And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. ¹⁵Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. ¹⁶And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: **KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS**. ¹⁷Then I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the birds that fly in the midst of heaven, "Come and gather together for the supper of the great God," ¹⁸that you may eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them, and the flesh of all people, free and slave, both small and great." ¹⁹**AND I SAW THE BEAST, THE KINGS OF THE EARTH, AND THEIR ARMIES, GATHERED TOGETHER TO MAKE WAR AGAINST HIM WHO SAT ON THE HORSE AND AGAINST HIS ARMY**. ²⁰Then the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image. These two were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone. ²¹And the rest were killed with the sword which proceeded from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse. And all the birds were filled with their flesh.

- **Daniel 7:9-14** "I watched till thrones were put in place, and the Ancient of Days was seated; His garment was white as snow, and the hair of His head was like pure wool. His throne was a fiery flame, its wheels a burning fire; a fiery stream issued and came forth from before Him. A thousand thousands ministered to Him; ten thousand times ten thousand stood before Him. The court was seated, and the books were opened. "I watched then because of the sound of the pompous words which the horn was speaking; I watched till the beast was slain, and its body destroyed and given to the burning flame. As for the rest of the beasts (*The 6th Beast Kingdom of the 10 kings, and the 7th Beast Kingdom of the Antichrist*), they had their dominion taken away, yet their lives were prolonged for a season and a time. "I was watching in the night visions, and behold, One like the Son of Man, coming with the clouds of heaven! He came to the Ancient of Days, and they brought Him near before Him. Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed."
- **Daniel 2:44** And in the days of these kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which shall never be destroyed; and the kingdom shall not be left to other people; it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand forever.
- **Jer 31:35** Thus says the LORD, **Who gives the sun for a light by day, The ordinances of the moon and the stars for a light by night**, Who disturbs the sea, and its waves roar (The LORD of hosts is His name):
- **Jhn 11:10** "But if one walks in the night, he stumbles, because the light is not in him."
- **Rom 13:12** The night is far spent, the day is at hand. Therefore let us cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light.
- **1 Thess. 5:5** You are all sons of light and sons of the day. We are not of the night nor of darkness.
- **Rev. 22:5** There shall be no night there: They need no lamp nor light of the sun, for the Lord God gives them light. And they shall reign forever and ever.

Consider the description of the emergence of the False Prophet in Rev. 13 and it clarifies the Times.

- **Revelation 13:1-10** ¹Then I stood on the sand of the sea. And I saw a beast rising up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and on his horns ten crowns, and on his heads a blasphemous name. ²Now the beast which I saw was like a leopard, his feet were like the feet of a bear, and his mouth like the mouth of a lion. The dragon gave him his power, his throne, and great authority. ³And I saw one of his heads as if it had been mortally wounded, and his deadly wound was healed. And all the world marveled and followed the beast. ⁴So they worshiped the dragon who gave authority to the beast; and they worshiped the beast, saying, "Who is like the beast? Who is able to make war with him?" ⁵And he was given a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies, and he was given authority to continue for forty-two months. ⁶Then he opened his mouth in blasphemy against God, to blaspheme His name, His tabernacle, and those who dwell in heaven. ⁷It was granted to him to make war with the saints and to overcome them. And authority was given him over every tribe, tongue, and nation. ⁸All who dwell on the earth will worship him, whose names have not been written in the Book of Life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world. ⁹If anyone has an ear, let him hear. ¹⁰He who leads into captivity shall go into captivity; he who kills with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the faith of the saints.
- **Revelation 13:11-18** ¹¹Then I saw another beast coming up out of the earth, and he had two horns like a lamb and spoke like a dragon. ¹²And he exercises all the authority of the first beast in his presence, and causes the earth and those who dwell in it to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed. ¹³He performs great signs, so that he even makes fire come down from heaven on the earth

in the sight of men. ¹⁴And he deceives those who dwell on the earth by those signs which he was granted to do in the sight of the beast, telling those who dwell on the earth to make an image to the beast who was wounded by the sword and lived. ¹⁵He was granted power to give breath to the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak and cause as many as would not worship the image of the beast to be killed. ¹⁶He causes all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a mark on their right hand or on their foreheads, ¹⁷and that no one may buy or sell except one who has the mark or the name of the beast, or the number of his name. ¹⁸Here is wisdom. Let him who has understanding calculate the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man: His number *is* 666.

The Great Tribulation

→ **Matthew 24:15-28** ¹⁵"Therefore when you see the 'abomination of desolation,' spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place" (whoever reads, let him understand), ¹⁶"then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains. ¹⁷Let him who is on the housetop not go down to take anything out of his house. ¹⁸And let him who is in the field not go back to get his clothes. ¹⁹But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! ²⁰And pray that your flight may not be in winter or on the Sabbath. ²¹For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be. ²²And unless those days were shortened, no flesh would be saved; but for the elect's sake those days will be shortened. ²³"Then if anyone says to you, 'Look, here *is* the Christ!' or 'There!' do not believe *it*. ²⁴For false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. ²⁵See, I have told you beforehand. ²⁶"Therefore if they say to you, 'Look, He is in the desert!' do not go out; *or* 'Look, He is in the inner rooms!' do not believe *it*. ²⁷For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. ²⁸For wherever the carcass is, there the eagles will be gathered together.

The Great Tribulation

→ **Mark 13:14-23** ¹⁴"So when you see the 'abomination of desolation,' spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not" (let the reader understand), "then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains. ¹⁵Let him who is on the housetop not go down into the house, nor enter to take anything out of his house. ¹⁶And let him who is in the field not go back to get his clothes. ¹⁷But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! ¹⁸And pray that your flight may not be in winter. ¹⁹For *in* those days there will be tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the creation which God created until this time, nor ever shall be. ²⁰And unless the Lord had shortened those days, no flesh would be saved; but for the elect's sake, whom He chose, He shortened the days. ²¹"Then if anyone says to you, 'Look, here *is* the Christ!' or, 'Look, He is there!' do not believe *it*. ²²For false christs and false prophets will rise and show signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. ²³But take heed; see, I have told you all things beforehand.

The Destruction of Jerusalem

→ **Luke 21:20-24** ²⁰"But when you see Jerusalem surrounded by armies, then know that its desolation is near. ²¹Then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains, let those who are in the midst of her depart, and let not those who are in the country enter her. ²²For these are the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled. ²³But woe to those who are pregnant and to those

who are nursing babies in those days! For there will be great distress in the land and wrath upon this people. ²⁴And **THEY WILL FALL BY THE EDGE OF THE SWORD, AND BE LED AWAY CAPTIVE INTO ALL NATIONS.** And **JERUSALEM WILL BE TRAMPLED BY GENTILES UNTIL THE TIMES OF THE GENTILES ARE FULFILLED.**

→ **Habakkuk 3:1-19** ¹A prayer of Habakkuk the prophet, on Shigionoth. ²O LORD, I have heard Your speech and was afraid; O LORD, revive Your work in the midst of the years! In the midst of the years make it known; in wrath remember mercy. ³God came from Teman (*This Name means from "of the South", or "of perfection". And, take note that the South is also the Waters, and the Place of God's storehouses of double blessing.*), the Holy One from Mount Paran (*This name means the Mountain of: "beauty", "glory", or "ornament"*). Selah His Glory covered the heavens, and the earth was full of His praise. ⁴His brightness was like the light (*Consider Revelation 18:1-2*); He had rays flashing from His hand, and there His power was hidden (*He is coming to Judge the world by their Words, for it is His Words that gives Light - Psalm 119:130, and it is by His Words that we are going to be judged - John 12:48, and in Hosea 6:5 we are told that our Judgment comes like Light.*) ⁵Before Him went pestilence, and fever followed at His feet. ⁶He stood and measured the earth; He looked and startled the nations. And the everlasting mountains were scattered, the perpetual hills bowed (*He takes over the heavens and does it by the roll call of Rev. 6:13-16*). His ways are everlasting. ⁷I saw the tents of Cushan (*The name Cushan means "a Way or place where darkness dwells"*) in affliction; the curtains of the land of Midian trembled (*The name of Midian means the "covering" or the "ways of traditions" or the "ways of habits"*). ⁸O LORD, were You displeased with the rivers, was Your anger against the rivers, was Your wrath against the sea, that You rode on Your horses, Your chariots of salvation? ⁹**YOUR BOW WAS MADE QUITE READY; OATHS WERE SWORN OVER YOUR ARROWS. SELAH. YOU DIVIDED THE EARTH WITH RIVERS.** (*These seem to be new rivers that He is going to cut and it is also the pouring out of His Spirit that He is going to pour out to those who will hear Him - Proverbs 1:23.*) ¹⁰**THE MOUNTAINS SAW YOU AND TREMBLED; THE OVERFLOWING OF THE WATER PASSED BY. THE DEEP UTTERED ITS VOICE, AND LIFTED ITS HANDS ON HIGH.** ¹¹**THE SUN AND MOON STOOD STILL IN THEIR HABITATION; AT THE LIGHT OF YOUR ARROWS THEY WENT, AT THE SHINING OF YOUR GLITTERING SPEAR.** ¹²You marched through the land in indignation; You trampled the nations in anger. ¹³You went forth for the salvation of Your people, for salvation with Your Anointed. You struck the head from the house of the wicked, by laying bare from foundation to neck. Selah. ¹⁴You thrust through with his own arrows the head of his villages. They came out like a whirlwind to scatter me; their rejoicing was like feasting on the poor in secret. ¹⁵You walked through the sea with Your horses, through the heap of great waters. ¹⁶When I heard, my body trembled; my lips quivered at the voice; rottenness entered my bones; and I trembled in myself, that I might rest in the day of trouble. When He comes up to the people, He will invade them with His troops. ¹⁷Though the fig tree may not blossom, nor fruit be on the vines; though the labor of the olive may fail, and the fields yield no food; though the flock may be cut off from the fold, and there be no herd in the stalls—¹⁸Yet I will rejoice in the Lord, I will joy in the God of my salvation. ¹⁹**The Lord God is my strength; He will make my feet like deer's feet, and He will make me walk on my high hills. To the Chief Musician. With my stringed instruments.**

David has some advice for right now: An exuberant declaration of Faith

→ **Psalms 27:1-14** ¹The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? ²When the wicked came against me to eat up my flesh, my enemies and foes, they stumbled and fell. ³Though an army may encamp against me, my heart shall not fear; though war may rise against me, in this I will be confident. ⁴One thing I have desired of the

LORD, that will I seek: That I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD, and to inquire in His temple. ⁵For in the time of trouble He shall hide me in His pavilion; in the secret place of His tabernacle He shall hide me; He shall set me high upon a rock. ⁶And now my head shall be lifted up above my enemies all around me; therefore I will offer sacrifices of joy in His tabernacle; I will sing, yes, I will sing praises to the LORD. ⁷Hear, O LORD, when I cry with my voice! Have mercy also upon me, and answer me. ⁸When You said, "Seek My face," my heart said to You, "Your face, LORD, I will seek." ⁹Do not hide Your face from me; do not turn Your servant away in anger; you have been my help; do not leave me nor forsake me, O God of my salvation. ¹⁰When my father and my mother forsake me, then the LORD will take care of me. ¹¹Teach me Your way, O LORD, and lead me in a smooth path, because of my enemies. ¹²Do not deliver me to the will of my adversaries; for false witnesses have risen against me, and such as breathe out violence. ¹³I would have lost heart, unless I had believed that I would see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living. ¹⁴Wait on the LORD; be of good courage, and He shall strengthen your heart; wait, I say, on the LORD!

He has come to Judge and it is by His Words. Psalm 50 is important to remember in these days.

- **Psalm 50:1-6** ¹The Mighty One, God the LORD, has spoken and called the earth from the rising of the sun to its going down. ²Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God will shine forth. ³Our God shall come, and shall not keep silent; a fire shall devour before Him, and it shall be very tempestuous all around Him. ⁴He shall call to the heavens from above, and to the earth, that He may judge His people: ⁵"Gather My saints together to Me, those who have made a covenant with Me by sacrifice." ⁶Let the heavens declare His righteousness, for God Himself is Judge. Selah
- **Psalm 50:7-23** ⁷"Hear, O My people, and I will speak, O Israel, and I will testify against you; I am God, your God! ⁸I will not rebuke you for your sacrifices or your burnt offerings, which are continually before Me. ⁹I will not take a bull from your house, nor goats out of your folds. ¹⁰For every beast of the forest is Mine, and the cattle on a thousand hills. ¹¹I know all the birds of the mountains, and the wild beasts of the field are Mine. ¹²"If I were hungry, I would not tell you; for the world is Mine, and all its fullness. ¹³Will I eat the flesh of bulls, or drink the blood of goats? ¹⁴Offer to God thanksgiving, and pay your vows to the Most High. ¹⁵Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify Me." ¹⁶But to the wicked God says: "What right have you to declare My statutes, or take My covenant in your mouth, ¹⁷seeing you hate instruction and cast My Words behind you?" ¹⁸When you saw a thief, you consented with him, and have been a partaker with adulterers. ¹⁹You give your mouth to evil, and your tongue frames deceit. ²⁰You sit and speak against your brother; you slander your own mother's son. ²¹These things you have done, and I kept silent; you thought that I was altogether like you; but I will rebuke you, and set them in order before your eyes. ²²"NOW CONSIDER THIS, YOU WHO FORGET GOD, LEST I TEAR YOU IN PIECES, AND THERE BE NONE TO DELIVER;" (*This is important when you consider His Warning of Matthew 24:20 and Mark 13:18*). ²³Whoever offers praise glorifies Me; and to him who orders his conduct aright I will show the salvation of God."

The Heritage of the Righteous and the Calamity of the Wicked

- **Psalm 37:1-40** ¹Do not fret because of evildoers, nor be envious of the workers of iniquity. ²For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, and wither as the green herb. ³Trust in the LORD, and do Good; dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness. ⁴Delight yourself also in the LORD, and He shall give you the desires of your heart. ⁵Commit your way to the LORD, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass. ⁶He shall bring forth your righteousness as the Light, and your justice as the noonday. ⁷Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently

for Him; do not fret because of him who prospers in his way, because of the man who brings wicked schemes to pass. ⁸Cease from anger, and forsake wrath; do not fret—it only causes harm. ⁹**FOR EVILDOERS SHALL BE CUT OFF; BUT THOSE WHO WAIT ON THE LORD, THEY SHALL INHERIT THE EARTH.** ¹⁰**FOR YET A LITTLE WHILE AND THE WICKED SHALL BE NO MORE; INDEED, YOU WILL LOOK CAREFULLY FOR HIS PLACE, BUT IT SHALL BE NO MORE.** ¹¹**BUT THE MEEK SHALL INHERIT THE EARTH, AND SHALL DELIGHT THEMSELVES IN THE ABUNDANCE OF** peace. (*Wonderful promises in verse 9-11, for this is about to come to completion, as we are now in the Year of His Recompense that started at Rosh Hashanah in September 2010. The Bible reveals that within this year this will be completed.*) ¹²**THE WICKED PLOTS AGAINST THE JUST, AND GNASHES AT HIM WITH HIS TEETH.** (*The teeth in this case is the symbol of the Words of their mind being formed for evil. The teeth are likened to the recorded Word. When the Lord gives a tooth and says to become part of His Threshing Sledge, He is saying to be a doer of the recorded instruction of God's Words.*) ¹³The Lord laughs at him, for He sees that his Day is coming. ¹⁴**THE WICKED HAVE DRAWN THE SWORD AND HAVE BENT THEIR BOW, TO CAST DOWN THE POOR AND NEEDY, TO SLAY THOSE WHO ARE OF UPRIGHT CONDUCT** (*The Lord told us that in this Day they will do this - Mt. 24:20 and Mk. 13:18.*) ¹⁵**THEIR SWORD SHALL ENTER THEIR OWN HEART, AND THEIR BOWS SHALL BE BROKEN** (*The Lord is saying that the words that they have spoken will be the punishment that comes upon them. In other words, when Prince Philip of the UK said that he wanted to return as a virus to kill 95% of the people upon the earth, then it is likely that the Lord is going to destroy him with terrible viruses so that all the world will know of his wicked end. Likewise, when Henry Kissinger said that military men are just worthless pawns to be used for the purposes of the elite, then it is likely that his death will come by torture from the hands of many former military men who were under his hand. When Obama allowed people to call him to be like a god, then it is likely that the Lord will strike him in the same manner that he struck King Herod wherein he was suddenly stricken and eaten from the inside out by worms. Likewise when the Rothschild family say that they are like a god over the earth and that they can do what they will without the fear of the armies and peoples of a nation, then their children are likely to see the same reduction to eating grass like the cattle in the field as like occurred to King Nebuchadnezzar.*) ¹⁶**A LITTLE THAT A RIGHTEOUS MAN HAS IS BETTER THAN THE RICHES OF MANY WICKED.** (*This is a very important instruction to us of this Day, for the Lord is saying that it is better to go into Battle with His Words and His Promises of Good Works that the Father placed within His Words, than to have any of the weapons and laws made by the arms of man, for in verse 17 He reveals that all these weapons and works of man for evil and for power, shall be destroyed and cut off. Their missiles are going to cease and their weapons will not fire, when those who Love Him become hearers and doers of His Words.*) ¹⁷**FOR THE ARMS OF THE WICKED SHALL BE BROKEN, BUT THE LORD UPHOLDS THE RIGHTEOUS.** ¹⁸The LORD knows the days of the upright, and their inheritance shall be forever (*We are now in the Appointed Time when the Righteous shall receive their inheritance of the Kingdom of God.*) ¹⁹They shall not be ashamed in the evil time, and in the days of famine they shall be satisfied. ²⁰But the wicked shall perish; and the enemies of the LORD, like the splendor of the meadows, shall vanish. Into smoke they shall vanish away. ²¹The wicked borrows and does not repay, but the righteous shows mercy and gives. ²²For those blessed by Him shall inherit the earth, but those cursed by Him shall be cut off. ²³The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD, and He delights in his way. ²⁴Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down; for the LORD upholds him with His hand. ²⁵I have been young, and now am old; yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his descendants begging bread. ²⁶He is ever merciful, and lends; and his descendants are blessed. ²⁷Depart from evil, and do Good; and dwell forevermore. (*This is such a wonderful Promise of the Lord.*) ²⁸For the LORD loves justice, and does not forsake His saints; they

are preserved forever (*Consider what He has just revealed very carefully, and you will see your future that is at hand if you will be persistent to seek His Words and to do the Ways of His Words.*), but the descendants of the wicked shall be cut off. ²⁹The righteous shall inherit the land, and dwell in it forever. (*Here is the promise of the fulfillment of Daniel 2:44 that is now at hand, for it is for this very day - the Year of His Recompense - the Year that He brings forth His Elect to Light and turns them into children of God - the Saints of the Most High God.*) ³⁰The mouth of the righteous speaks wisdom, and his tongue talks of justice. ³¹The Law of his God is in his heart (*In Psalm 119:142 it becomes clear that this Law is to be a hearer of His Words and then going forth to be a doer of His Words*); none of his steps shall slide. ³²The wicked watches the righteous, and seeks to slay him. ³³The LORD will not leave him in his hand, nor condemn him when he is judged. ³⁴Wait on the LORD, and keep His Way (*We are to be hearers of His Words and then be doers of the Ways of Good so that we can enable Him to do His Good Works for others and for the bringing forth of His Kingdom of Light.*), and He shall exalt you to inherit the land; when the wicked are cut off, you shall see it. ³⁵I have seen the wicked in great power, and spreading himself like a native green tree. ³⁶Yet he passed away, and behold, he was no more; indeed I sought him, but he could not be found. ³⁷Mark the blameless man, and observe the upright; for the future of that man is peace. ³⁸But the transgressors shall be destroyed together; the future of the wicked shall be cut off. ³⁹But the salvation of the righteous is from the LORD; He is their strength in the time of trouble. ⁴⁰And the LORD shall help them and deliver them; He shall deliver them from the wicked, and save them, because they trust in Him.

Last month we considered that the 23rd Psalm comes after the Psalm of the Promise of the Lord's overcoming the world. Thus, the 23rd Psalm is as it is a Promise of God to us for our overcoming of the world. Take notice that it is a Psalm that is set to the song of "The Deer of the Dawn." And it is a Psalm of David. Jesus is the Sun that rises as Dawn of the Morning. This now makes much more sense. In Psalm 19 David told us that the sun is the symbol of the Promise of the Way of the coming of the Bridegroom. In Isaiah 21:10-12 we are told that the Dawn of the Morning comes at the same time as the Night. Such is the Promise of Psalm 23. There is a promised time when Jesus will rule over the nations before He destroys them who will not turn.

→ **Psalm 22:1-30** ¹My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me? Why are You so far from helping Me, and from the Words of My groaning? ²O My God, I cry in the daytime, but You do not hear; and in the night season, and am not silent. ³But You are holy, enthroned in the praises of Israel. ⁴Our fathers trusted in You; they trusted, and You delivered them. ⁵They cried to You, and were delivered; they trusted in You, and were not ashamed. ⁶But I am a worm, and no man; a reproach of men, and despised by the people. ⁷All those who see Me ridicule Me; they shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying, ⁸"He trusted in the LORD, let Him rescue Him; let Him deliver Him, since He delights in Him!" ⁹But You are He who took Me out of the womb; You made Me trust while on My mother's breasts. ¹⁰I was cast upon You from birth. From My mother's womb You have been My God. ¹¹Be not far from Me, for trouble is near; for there is none to help. ¹²Many bulls have surrounded Me; strong bulls of Bashan have encircled Me. (*Consider the meaning of Bashan is "in the tooth", or "in ivory". Solomon's throne had ivory. It is symbolic of the words spoken to be of the root of Truth. In this case this is revealing that the strong bulls of Bashan are the priests and leaders of the people of Israel who would crucify Him and justify it with their false words, claiming that it was for the Glory of God. Because they did not know His words they could not discern the knowledge of this verse, and it is a testimony against their lack of knowledge and foolish wisdom.*) ¹³They gape at Me with their mouths, like a raging and roaring lion. ¹⁴I am poured out like water, and all My bones are out of joint; My heart is like wax; it has melted within Me.

¹⁵My strength is dried up like a potsherd, and My tongue clings to My jaws; You have brought Me to the dust of death. ¹⁶For dogs have surrounded Me; the congregation of the wicked has enclosed Me. They pierced My hands and My feet; ¹⁷I can count all My bones. They look and stare at Me. ¹⁸They divide My garments among them, and for My clothing they cast lots. ¹⁹But You, O LORD, do not be far from Me; O My Strength, hasten to help Me! ²⁰Deliver Me from the sword, My precious life from the power of the dog. ²¹Save Me from the lion's mouth and from the horns of the wild oxen! You have answered Me. ²²I will declare Your name to My brethren; in the midst of the assembly I will praise You. ²³You who fear the LORD, praise Him! All you descendants of Jacob, glorify Him, and fear Him, all you offspring of Israel! ²⁴For He has not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; nor has He hidden His face from Him; but when He cried to Him, He heard. ²⁵My praise shall be of You in the great assembly; I will pay My vows before those who fear Him. ²⁶The poor shall eat and be satisfied; those who seek Him will praise the LORD. Let your heart live forever! ²⁷ALL THE ENDS OF THE WORLD SHALL REMEMBER AND TURN TO THE LORD, AND ALL THE FAMILIES OF THE NATIONS SHALL WORSHIP BEFORE YOU. ²⁸FOR THE KINGDOM IS THE LORD'S, AND HE RULES OVER THE NATIONS. ²⁹ALL THE PROSPEROUS OF THE EARTH SHALL EAT AND WORSHIP; ALL THOSE WHO GO DOWN TO THE DUST SHALL BOW BEFORE HIM, EVEN HE WHO CANNOT KEEP HIMSELF ALIVE. ³⁰A POSTERITY SHALL SERVE HIM. IT WILL BE RECOUNTED OF THE LORD TO THE NEXT GENERATION, ³¹THEY WILL COME AND DECLARE HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS TO A PEOPLE WHO WILL BE BORN, THAT HE HAS DONE THIS.

Likewise the 24th Psalm that follows the 23rd Psalm confirms of the Kingdom of Glory of the King of Glory.

→ **Psalm 24:1-10** ¹The earth is the LORD's, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein. ²For He has founded it upon the seas, and established it upon the waters. ³Who may ascend into the hill of the LORD? Or who may stand in His holy place? ⁴He who has clean hands and a pure heart, who has not lifted up his soul to an idol, nor sworn deceitfully. ⁵He shall receive blessing from the LORD, and righteousness from the God of his salvation. ⁶This is Jacob, the generation of those who seek Him, who seek Your face. Selah. ⁷Lift up your heads, O you gates! And be lifted up, you everlasting doors! And the King of glory shall come in. ⁸Who is this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle. ⁹Lift up your heads, O you gates! Lift up, you everlasting doors! And the King of glory shall come in. ¹⁰Who is this King of glory? The LORD of hosts, He is the King of glory. Selah
