

Notes of Floyd E. Taylor for Jan. 31, 2011 Teleconference Bible Study

Considering the Time of His Executing of the Harvest Judgment has come!

The Lord has given some special things for us tonight. What a day of revelation of knowledge of Truth from the Scriptures this has been. I do not have the time to write everything in the notes for tonight. I will tell you about these things. Also, the Lord gave Bobbie Westfall a vision that is as amazing in importance as was the two given to Christine. I will tell you what it was and reveal the meaning of this Prophetic Vision tonight. It was given at 7:00 AM this morning - the break of Dawn and that in itself should reveal how important it was.

- **Lamentations 1:1** How lonely sits the city that was full of people! How like a widow is she, Who was great among the nations! The princess among the provinces Has become a slave!

- **Genesis 49:21** "Naphtali is a deer let loose; he uses beautiful Words.
- **Deuteronomy 33:23** And of Naphtali he said: "O Naphtali, satisfied with favor, and full of the blessing of the LORD, possess the west and the south."
- **Psalms 22:1-31** ¹My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me? Why are You so far from helping Me, and from the Words of My groaning? ²O My God, I cry in the daytime, but You do not hear; and in the night season, and am not silent. ³But You are holy, enthroned in the praises of Israel. ⁴Our fathers trusted in You; they trusted, and You delivered them. ⁵They cried to You, and were delivered; they trusted in You, and were not ashamed. ⁶But I am a worm, and no man; a reproach of men, and despised by the people. ⁷All those who see Me ridicule Me; they shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying, ⁸"He trusted in the LORD, let Him rescue Him; let Him deliver Him, since He delights in Him!" ⁹But You are He who took Me out of the womb; You made Me trust while on My mother's breasts. ¹⁰I was cast upon You from birth. From My mother's womb You have been My God. ¹¹Be not far from Me, for trouble is near; for there is none to help. ¹²Many bulls have surrounded Me; strong bulls of Bashan have encircled Me. ¹³They gape at Me with their mouths, like a raging and roaring lion. ¹⁴I am poured out like water, and all My bones are out of joint; My heart is like wax; it has melted within Me. ¹⁵My strength is dried up like a potsherd, and My tongue clings to My jaws; You have brought Me to the dust of death. ¹⁶For dogs have surrounded Me; the congregation of the wicked has enclosed Me. They pierced My hands and My feet; ¹⁷I can count all My bones. They look and stare at Me. ¹⁸They divide My garments among them, and for My clothing they cast lots. ¹⁹But You, O LORD, do not be far from Me; O My Strength, hasten to help Me! ²⁰Deliver Me from the sword, My precious life from the power of the dog. ²¹Save Me from the lion's mouth and from the horns of the wild oxen! You have answered Me. ²²I will declare Your name to My brethren; in the midst of the assembly I will praise You. ²³You who fear the LORD, praise Him! All you descendants of Jacob, glorify Him, and fear Him, all you offspring of Israel! ²⁴For He has not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; nor has He hidden His face from Him; but when He cried to Him, He heard. ²⁵My praise shall be of You in the great assembly; I will pay My vows before those who fear Him. ²⁶The poor shall eat and be satisfied; those who seek Him will praise the LORD. Let your heart live forever! ²⁷All the ends of the world shall remember and turn to the LORD, and all the families of the nations shall worship before You. ²⁸For the kingdom is the LORD's, and He rules over the nations. ²⁹All the prosperous of the earth shall eat and worship; all those who go down to the dust shall

bow before Him, even he who cannot keep himself alive. ³⁰A posterity shall serve Him. It will be recounted of the Lord to the next generation, ³¹they will come and declare His righteousness to a people who will be born, that He has done this.

The Birth and Childhood of Jesus

→ **Luke 2:1-7** ¹And it came to pass in those days that a decree went out from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be registered. ²This census first took place while Quirinius was governing Syria. ³So all went to be registered, everyone to his own city. ⁴Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David, ⁵to be registered with Mary, his betrothed wife, who was with child. ⁶So it was, that while they were there, the days were completed for her to be delivered. ⁷And she brought forth her firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.

Glory in the Highest

→ **Luke 2:8-14** ⁸Now there were in the same country shepherds living out in the fields, keeping watch over their flock by night. ⁹And behold, an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were greatly afraid. ¹⁰Then the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people. ¹¹For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. ¹²And this will be the sign to you: You will find a Babe wrapped in swaddling cloths, lying in a manger." ¹³And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying: ¹⁴"Glory to God in the highest,

And on earth peace, goodwill toward men!"

→ **Luke 2:15-20** ¹⁵So it was, when the angels had gone away from them into heaven, that the shepherds said to one another, "Let us now go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has come to pass, which the Lord has made known to us." ¹⁶And they came with haste and found Mary and Joseph, and the Babe lying in a manger. ¹⁷Now when they had seen Him, they made widely known the saying which was told them concerning this Child. ¹⁸And all those who heard it marveled at those things which were told them by the shepherds. ¹⁹But Mary kept all these things and pondered them in her heart. ²⁰Then the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told them.

Circumcision of Jesus

→ **Luke 2:21** ²¹And when eight days were completed for the circumcision of the Child, His name was called JESUS, the name given by the angel before He was conceived in the womb.

Jesus Presented in the Temple

- **Luke 2:22-24** ²²Now when the days of her purification according to the law of Moses were completed, they brought Him to Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord ²³(as it is written in the law of the Lord, "Every male who opens the womb shall be called holy to the LORD"), ²⁴and to offer a sacrifice according to what is said in the law of the Lord, "A pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons."

Simeon Sees God's Salvation

- **Luke 2:25-35** ²⁵And behold, there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon, and this man was just and devout, waiting for the Consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him. ²⁶And it had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ. ²⁷So he came by the Spirit into the temple. And when the parents brought in the Child Jesus, to do for Him according to the custom of the law, ²⁸he took Him up in his arms and blessed God and said: ²⁹"Lord, now You are letting Your servant depart in peace, according to Your Word; ³⁰for my eyes have seen Your salvation ³¹which You have prepared before the face of all peoples, ³²a light to bring revelation to the Gentiles, and the glory of Your people Israel." ³³And Joseph and His mother marveled at those things which were spoken of Him. ³⁴Then Simeon blessed them, and said to Mary His mother, "Behold, this Child is destined for the fall and rising of many in Israel, and for a sign which will be spoken against ³⁵(yes, a sword will pierce through your own soul also), that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed."

Anna Bears Witness to the Redeemer

- **Luke 2:36-38** ³⁶Now there was one, Anna, a prophetess, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was of a great age, and had lived with a **husband seven years** from her virginity; ³⁷and this woman was a widow of about eighty-four years (*This is the Gematria number for such words as "wise, teach, son, blood, mercy, Enoch", and many more.*), who did not depart from the temple, but served God with fastings and prayers night and day. ³⁸And coming in that instant she gave thanks to the Lord, and spoke of Him to all those who looked for redemption in Jerusalem.

The Family Returns to Nazareth

- **Luke 2:39-40** ³⁹So when they had performed all things according to the law of the Lord, they returned to Galilee, to their own city, Nazareth. ⁴⁰And the Child grew and became strong in spirit, filled with wisdom; and the grace of God was upon Him.

The Boy Jesus Amazes the Scholars

- **Luke 2:41-50** ⁴¹His parents went to Jerusalem every year at the Feast of the Passover. ⁴²And when He was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem according to the custom of the feast. ⁴³When they had finished the days, as they returned, the Boy Jesus lingered behind in Jerusalem. And Joseph and His mother did not know it; ⁴⁴but supposing Him to have been in the company, they went a day's journey, and sought Him among their relatives and acquaintances. ⁴⁵So when they did not find Him, they returned to Jerusalem, seeking Him. ⁴⁶Now so it was that after three days they found Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, both listening to them and asking them questions. ⁴⁷And all who heard Him were astonished at His understanding and answers. ⁴⁸So when they saw Him, they were amazed; and His mother said to Him, "Son, why have You done this to us? Look, Your father and I have sought You anxiously."

⁴⁹And He said to them, "Why did you seek Me? Did you not know that I must be about My Father's business?" ⁵⁰But they did not understand the statement which He spoke to them.

Jesus Advances in Wisdom and Favor

→ **Luke 2:51** ⁵¹Then He went down with them and came to Nazareth, and was subject to them, but His mother kept all these things in her heart. ⁵²And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men.

THE THIRD PART

January 30, 2011

The Lord awakened me at 4:40 a.m., and I knew the number "44" was significant. He then began to speak to me from 2 Kings 4:44.

2 Kings 4:42-44 - "Now a man came from Baal-Shalishah, and brought the man of God bread of the first fruits, twenty loaves of barley and fresh ears of grain in his sack. And he said, 'Give them to the people that they may eat.'" "And his attendant said, 'What, shall I set this before a hundred men?' But he said, 'Give them to the people that they may eat, for thus says the Lord, "They shall eat and have some left over.'" "So he set it before them, and they ate, and had some left over, according to the Word of the Lord."

The Lord quickened me to look up the meaning of "Baal-Shalishah". "Shalishah" means "third part". The Lord spoke:

Zech.13:9 - "And I (have brought) the third part through the fire, refined them as silver is refined, and tested them as gold is tested. They will call on My name, and I will answer them; I will say, 'They are My people.' And they will say, 'The Lord is my God.'"

For the past number of years, the Word of the Lord has been testing His body. Each time we have received a revelation, it has been tested and proven in our lives. We've been through the refining fires of the Holy Spirit so that the Word of the Lord is now a "pure" word in our mouths, proceeding from a pure heart.

be released as a confirmation of His word spoken under the unction of the Holy Spirit. After Elijah raised the widow's son from the dead, she said, "Now I know that you are a man of God, and that the word of the Lord in your mouth is truth!" (1 Kings 17:24).

We will know the people of "the third part" by the signs that follow. One of the key ways in which the Lord will be moving is in the area of multiplication of resources. That which is dedicated to the Lord (as in first fruits) will multiply, resulting in ample provision for those that we're ministering to. There will also be an overflow, so that our own needs will be amply met.

Let us be alert to the new thing the Lord is doing in this season! Let us walk by faith and not by sight, expecting the supernatural in our midst. Let our words not be "in persuasive words of wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power!" (1 Cor. 2:4)

LET DEBORAH AND BARAK ARISE!

January 21, 2011

Most prophetic voices agree that the Lord, the Captain of the Host, is calling His people to the battle lines as never before. The enemy is amassing an army, and the body of Christ is now being required to go on the offensive. We are to receive His strategy and march according to His command.

The Lord gave me a vision in which three battle-worn commanders of the Lord's army, one woman and two men, were consulting with one another about a course of action. They had been in the process of setting a group of prisoners free (mostly women), then arming and training them for the upcoming battle. These three knew the enemy was coming, and were expecting an onslaught. However, it was reported that the enemy didn't have horses, and this was slowing them down. Where previously the commanders had been waiting for an attack, they now decided to go on the offensive. Instead of fighting in ankle-deep mud in the current location, people could position themselves on flat, solid rock for better footing. The commanders went about arming the people and training them for hand-to-hand combat.

We are in a time of arming and preparation. The war has been raging, and there have already been casualties. The Lord is now calling His Deborahs and Baraks to unite in battle, leading His people to sure victory. These are the men and women who have fought and overcome many battles with the enemy. They are established in their faith and have gained credibility in their places of service, just as Deborah was an established prophetess and judge. The Lord revealed both His will and strategy to this noble woman, who then summoned Barak.

Judges 4:6 - "Now she sent and summoned Barak... and said to him, 'Behold, the Lord, the God of Israel, has commanded, "Go and march to Mount Tabor, and take with you ten thousand men..."'"

Note that Barak didn't initiate this course of action, nor did he decide to "include" Deborah in the campaign. Instead, He realized that he couldn't proceed without her at his side.

Judges 4:8 - "Then Barak said to her, 'If you will go with me, then I will go; but if you will not go with me, I will not go.'"

Deborah had the anointing required for battle. She had been given the strategy for victory. Both were God's chosen instruments to lead the army of God at His command. So, too, is it in this day. As many have prophesied, men and women will be going out as one man in battle. One cannot go forth without the other. Watch for many supernatural "joinings" as the Lord continues to muster and prepare His troops for the battles ahead.

IT'S TIME FOR THE HORSES

January 17, 2011

I believe the Spirit of God spoke that He has now released the horses for those in the bridal company who have prepared themselves. Jesus has come as Captain of the Hosts of the Lord, and He is calling forth His army. No longer are we to be on the defensive against the enemy, but He is now leading a mighty throng against injustice in the land.

A horse is indicative of great strength, swiftness, and authority in the Spirit, and the Lord is calling forth those people and ministries that He has birthed and equipped for this hour. The focus will not be on individuals, but only on the Captain of the Host. Heavenly portals have been opened throughout the land for the "King of Glory.... The Lord strong and mighty.... The Lord mighty in battle." (Psalm 24:8) Those who have prepared themselves will be following Him on these spiritual horses, as a foreshadowing of the Bride at the time of the end.

Rev.19:11-15 - "And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat upon it is called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and wages war..... And the armies which are in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, were following Him on white horses."

Many have prophesied of a time of acceleration in this new year, accompanied by great manifestations of His glory, with miracles, signs, and wonders. Those who are now being given a horse have "run with the footmen in a land of peace" (Jeremiah 12:5), and are now qualified to "run with horses".

Psalm 104:1-35 ¹Bless the LORD, O my soul! O LORD my God, You are very great: You are clothed with honor and majesty, ²Who cover Yourself with light as with a garment, Who stretch out the heavens like a curtain. ³He lays the beams of His upper chambers in the waters, Who makes the clouds His chariot, Who walks on the wings of the wind, ⁴Who makes His angels spirits, His ministers a flame of fire. ⁵You who laid the foundations of the earth, so that it should not be moved forever, ⁶You covered it with the deep as with a garment; the waters stood above the mountains. ⁷At Your rebuke they fled; at the voice of Your thunder they hastened away. ⁸They went up over the mountains; they went down into the valleys, to the place which You founded for them. ⁹You have set a boundary that they may not pass over, that they may not return to cover the earth. ¹⁰He sends the springs into the valleys; they flow among the hills. ¹¹They give drink to every beast of the field; the wild donkeys quench their thirst. ¹²By them the birds of the heavens have their home; they sing among the branches. ¹³He waters the hills from His upper chambers; the earth is satisfied with the fruit of Your works. ¹⁴He causes the grass to grow for the cattle, and herbs (vegetation) for the service of man, that he may bring forth food from the earth, ¹⁵and wine that makes glad the heart of man, oil to make his face shine, and bread which strengthens man's heart. ¹⁶The trees of the LORD are full of sap, the cedars of Lebanon (This name means "incense", or "white") which He planted, ¹⁷Where the birds make their nests; the stork has her home in the fir trees. ¹⁸The high hills are for the wild goats; the cliffs are a refuge for the rock badgers. ¹⁹He appointed the moon for seasons; the sun knows its going down. ²⁰You make darkness, and it is night, in which all the beasts of the forest creep about. ²¹The young lions roar after their prey, and seek their food from God. ²²When the sun rises, they gather together and lie down in their dens. ²³Man goes out to his work and to his labor until the evening. ²⁴O LORD, how manifold are Your works! In wisdom You have made them all. The earth is full of Your possessions—²⁵This great and wide sea, in which are innumerable teeming things, living things both small and great. ²⁶There the ships sail about; there is that Leviathan which You have made to play there. ²⁷These all wait for You, that You may give them their food in due season. ²⁸What You give them they gather in; You open Your hand, they are filled with good. ²⁹You hide Your face, they are troubled; You take away their breath, they die and return to their dust. ³⁰You send forth Your Spirit, they are created; and You renew the face of the earth. ³¹May the glory of the LORD endure forever; may the LORD rejoice in His works. ³²He looks on the earth, and it trembles; He touches the hills, and they smoke. ³³I will sing to the LORD as long as I live; I will sing praise to my God while I have my being. ³⁴May my meditation be sweet to Him; I will be glad in the LORD. ³⁵May sinners be consumed from the earth, and the wicked be no more. Bless the LORD, O my soul! Praise the LORD!

I would like to review Rev. 13 about the emergence of the False Prophet in Rev. 13 and it clarifies the Times.

- **Revelation 13:1-10** ¹Then I stood on the sand of the sea. And I saw a beast rising up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and on his horns ten crowns, and on his heads a blasphemous name. ²Now the beast which I saw was like a leopard, his feet were like the feet of a bear, and his mouth like the mouth of a lion. The dragon gave him his power, his throne, and great authority. ³And I saw one of his heads as if it had been mortally wounded, and his deadly wound was healed. And all the world marveled and followed the beast. ⁴So they worshiped the dragon who gave authority to the beast; and they worshiped the beast, saying, "Who is like the beast? Who is able to make war with him?" ⁵And he was given a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies, and he was given authority to continue for forty-two months. ⁶Then he opened his mouth in blasphemy against God, to blaspheme His name, His tabernacle, and those who dwell in heaven. ⁷It was granted to him to make war with the saints and to overcome them. And authority was given him over every tribe, tongue, and nation. ⁸All who dwell on the earth will worship him, whose names have not been written in the Book of Life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world. ⁹If anyone has an ear, let him hear. ¹⁰He who leads into captivity shall go into captivity; he who kills with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the faith of the saints.
- **Revelation 13:11-18** ¹¹Then I saw another beast coming up out of the earth, and he had two horns like a lamb and spoke like a dragon. ¹²And he exercises all the authority of the first beast in his presence, and causes the earth and those who dwell in it to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed. ¹³He performs great signs, so that he even makes fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men. ¹⁴And he deceives those who dwell on the earth by those signs which he was granted to do in the sight of the beast, telling those who dwell on the earth to make an image to the beast who was wounded by the sword and lived. ¹⁵He was granted power to give breath to the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak and cause as many as would not worship the image of the beast to be killed. ¹⁶He causes all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a mark on their right hand or on their foreheads, ¹⁷and that no one may buy or sell except one who has the mark or the name of the beast, or the number of his name. ¹⁸Here is wisdom. Let him who has understanding calculate the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man: His number is 666.

The Great Tribulation

- **Matthew 24:15-28** ¹⁵"Therefore when you see the 'abomination of desolation,' spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place" (whoever reads, let him understand), ¹⁶"then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains. ¹⁷Let him who is on the housetop not go down to take anything out of his house. ¹⁸And let him who is in the field not go back to get his clothes. ¹⁹But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! ²⁰And pray that your flight may not be in winter or on the Sabbath. ²¹For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be. ²²And unless those days were shortened, no flesh would be saved; but for the elect's sake those days will be shortened. ²³"Then if anyone says to you, 'Look, here is the Christ!' or 'There!' do not believe it. ²⁴For false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. ²⁵See, I have told you beforehand. ²⁶"Therefore if they say to you, 'Look, He is in the desert!' do not go out; or 'Look, He is in the inner rooms!' do not believe it. ²⁷For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. ²⁸For wherever the carcass is, there the eagles will be gathered together.

The Great Tribulation

- **Mark 13:14-23** ¹⁴"So when you see the 'abomination of desolation,' spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not" (let the reader understand), ¹⁵"then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains. ¹⁶Let him who is on the housetop not go down into the house, nor enter to take anything out of his house. ¹⁷And let him who is in the field not go back to get his clothes. ¹⁸But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! ¹⁹And pray that your flight may not be in winter. ²⁰For *in* those days there will be tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the creation which God created until this time, nor ever shall be. ²¹And unless the Lord had shortened those days, no flesh would be saved; but for the elect's sake, whom He chose, He shortened the days. ²²Then if anyone says to you, 'Look, here *is* the Christ!' or, 'Look, He is there!' do not believe it. ²³For false christs and false prophets will rise and show signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. ²⁴But take heed; see, I have told you all things beforehand.

The Destruction of Jerusalem

- **Luke 21:20-24** ²⁰"But when you see Jerusalem surrounded by armies, then know that its desolation is near. ²¹Then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains, let those who are in the midst of her depart, and let not those who are in the country enter her. ²²For these are the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled. ²³But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! For there will be great distress in the land and wrath upon this people. ²⁴And **THEY WILL FALL BY THE EDGE OF THE SWORD, AND BE LED AWAY CAPTIVE INTO ALL NATIONS. And JERUSALEM WILL BE TRAMPLED BY GENTILES UNTIL THE TIMES OF THE GENTILES ARE FULFILLED.**
- **Habakkuk 3:1-19** ¹A prayer of Habakkuk the prophet, on Shigionoth. ²O LORD, I have heard Your speech and was afraid; O LORD, revive Your work in the midst of the years! In the midst of the years make it known; in wrath remember mercy. ³God came from Teman (*This Name means from "of the South", or "of perfection". And, take note that the South is also the Waters, and the Place of God's storehouses of double blessing.*), the Holy One from Mount Paran (*This name means the Mountain of: "beauty", "glory", or "ornament". Selah His Glory covered the heavens, and the earth was full of His praise. ⁴His brightness was like the light (Consider Revelation 18:1-2); He had rays flashing from His hand, and there His power was hidden (He is coming to Judge the world by their Words, for it is His Words that gives Light - Psalm 119:130, and it is by His Words that we are going to be judged - John 12:48, and in Hosea 6:5 we are told that our Judgment comes like Light.) ⁵Before Him went pestilence, and fever followed at His feet. ⁶He stood and measured the earth; He looked and startled the nations. And the everlasting mountains were scattered, the perpetual hills bowed (He takes over the heavens and does it by the roll call of Rev. 6:13-16). His ways are everlasting. ⁷I saw the tents of Cushan (*The name Cushan means "a Way or place where darkness dwells") in affliction; the curtains of the land of Midian trembled (The name of Midian means the "covering" or the "ways of traditions" or the "ways of habits"). ⁸O LORD, were You displeased with the rivers, was Your anger against the rivers, was Your wrath against the sea, that You rode on Your horses, Your chariots of salvation? ⁹YOUR BOW WAS MADE QUITE READY; OATHS WERE SWORN OVER YOUR ARROWS. SELAH. YOU DIVIDED THE EARTH WITH RIVERS. (These seem to be new rivers that He is going to cut and it is also the pouring out of His Spirit that He is going to pour out to those who will hear Him - Proverbs 1:23.) ¹⁰THE MOUNTAINS SAW YOU AND TREMBLED; THE OVERFLOWING OF THE WATER PASSED BY. THE DEEP UTTERED ITS VOICE, AND LIFTED ITS HANDS ON HIGH. ¹¹THE SUN AND MOON STOOD STILL IN THEIR**

HABITATION; AT THE LIGHT OF YOUR ARROWS THEY WENT, AT THE SHINING OF YOUR GLITTERING SPEAR. ¹²You marched through the land in indignation; You trampled the nations in anger. ¹³You went forth for the salvation of Your people, for salvation with Your Anointed. You struck the head from the house of the wicked, by laying bare from foundation to neck. Selah. ¹⁴You thrust through with his own arrows the head of his villages. They came out like a whirlwind to scatter me; their rejoicing was like feasting on the poor in secret. ¹⁵You walked through the sea with Your horses, through the heap of great waters. ¹⁶When I heard, my body trembled; my lips quivered at the voice; rottenness entered my bones; and I trembled in myself, that I might rest in the day of trouble. When He comes up to the people, He will invade them with His troops. ¹⁷Though the fig tree may not blossom, nor fruit be on the vines; though the labor of the olive may fail, and the fields yield no food; though the flock may be cut off from the fold, and there be no herd in the stalls—¹⁸Yet I will rejoice in the Lord, I will joy in the God of my salvation. ¹⁹**The Lord God is my strength; He will make my feet like deer's feet, and He will make me walk on my high hills. To the Chief Musician. With my stringed instruments.**

David has some advice for right now: An exuberant declaration of Faith

- **Psalm 27:1-14** ¹The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? ²When the wicked came against me to eat up my flesh, my enemies and foes, they stumbled and fell. ³Though an army may encamp against me, my heart shall not fear; though war may rise against me, in this I will be confident. ⁴One thing I have desired of the LORD, that will I seek: That I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD, and to inquire in His temple. ⁵For in the time of trouble He shall hide me in His pavilion; in the secret place of His tabernacle He shall hide me; He shall set me high upon a rock. ⁶And now my head shall be lifted up above my enemies all around me; therefore I will offer sacrifices of joy in His tabernacle; I will sing, yes, I will sing praises to the LORD. ⁷Hear, O LORD, when I cry with my voice! Have mercy also upon me, and answer me. ⁸When You said, "Seek My face," my heart said to You, "Your face, LORD, I will seek." ⁹Do not hide Your face from me; do not turn Your servant away in anger; you have been my help; do not leave me nor forsake me, O God of my salvation. ¹⁰When my father and my mother forsake me, then the LORD will take care of me. ¹¹Teach me Your way, O LORD, and lead me in a smooth path, because of my enemies. ¹²Do not deliver me to the will of my adversaries; for false witnesses have risen against me, and such as breathe out violence. ¹³I would have lost heart, unless I had believed that I would see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living. ¹⁴Wait on the LORD; be of good courage, and He shall strengthen your heart; wait, I say, on the LORD!

He has come to Judge and it is by His Words. Psalm 50 is important to remember in these days.

- **Psalm 50:1-6** ¹The Mighty One, God the LORD, has spoken and called the earth from the rising of the sun to its going down. ²Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God will shine forth. ³Our God shall come, and shall not keep silent; a fire shall devour before Him, and it shall be very tempestuous all around Him. ⁴He shall call to the heavens from above, and to the earth, that He may judge His people: ⁵"Gather My saints together to Me, those who have made a covenant with Me by sacrifice." ⁶Let the heavens declare His righteousness, for God Himself is Judge. Selah
- **Psalm 50:7-23** ⁷"Hear, O My people, and I will speak, O Israel, and I will testify against you; I am God, your God! ⁸I will not rebuke you for your sacrifices or your burnt offerings, which are continually before Me. ⁹I will not take a bull from your house, nor goats out of your folds. ¹⁰For every beast of the forest is Mine, and the cattle on a thousand hills. ¹¹I know all the birds of the mountains, and the

wild beasts of the field are Mine. ¹²"If I were hungry, I would not tell you; for the world is Mine, and all its fullness. ¹³Will I eat the flesh of bulls, or drink the blood of goats? ¹⁴Offer to God thanksgiving, and pay your vows to the Most High. ¹⁵Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify Me." ¹⁶**But to the wicked God says: "What right have you to declare My statutes, or take My covenant in your mouth, ¹⁷seeing you hate instruction and cast My Words behind you?"** ¹⁸When you saw a thief, you consented with him, and have been a partaker with adulterers. ¹⁹You give your mouth to evil, and your tongue frames deceit. ²⁰You sit and speak against your brother; you slander your own mother's son. ²¹These things you have done, and I kept silent; you thought that I was altogether like you; but I will rebuke you, and set them in order before your eyes. ²²**NOW CONSIDER THIS, YOU WHO FORGET GOD, LEST I TEAR YOU IN PIECES, AND THERE BE NONE TO DELIVER:** (*This is important when you consider His Warning of Matthew 24:20 and Mark 13:18*). ²³Whoever offers praise glorifies Me; and to him who orders his conduct aright I will show the salvation of God."

The Heritage of the Righteous and the Calamity of the Wicked

→ **Psalm 37:1-40** ¹Do not fret because of evildoers, nor be envious of the workers of iniquity. ²For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, and wither as the green herb. ³Trust in the LORD, and do Good; dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness. ⁴Delight yourself also in the LORD, and He shall give you the desires of your heart. ⁵Commit your way to the LORD, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass. ⁶He shall bring forth your righteousness as the Light, and your justice as the noonday. ⁷Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for Him; do not fret because of him who prospers in his way, because of the man who brings wicked schemes to pass. ⁸Cease from anger, and forsake wrath; do not fret—it only causes harm. ⁹**FOR EVILDOERS SHALL BE CUT OFF; BUT THOSE WHO WAIT ON THE LORD, THEY SHALL INHERIT THE EARTH.** ¹⁰**FOR YET A LITTLE WHILE AND THE WICKED SHALL BE NO MORE; INDEED, YOU WILL LOOK CAREFULLY FOR HIS PLACE, BUT IT SHALL BE NO MORE.** ¹¹**BUT THE MEEK SHALL INHERIT THE EARTH, AND SHALL DELIGHT THEMSELVES IN THE ABUNDANCE OF** peace. (*Wonderful promises in verse 9-11, for this is about to come to completion, as we are now in the Year of His Recompense that started at Rosh Hashanah in September 2010. The Bible reveals that within this year this will be completed.*) ¹²**THE WICKED PLOTS AGAINST THE JUST, AND GNASHES AT HIM WITH HIS TEETH.** (*The teeth in this case is the symbol of the Words of their mind being formed for evil. The teeth are likened to the recorded Word. When the Lord gives a tooth and says to become part of His Threshing Sledge, He is saying to be a doer of the recorded instruction of God's Words.*) ¹³The Lord laughs at him, for He sees that his Day is coming. ¹⁴**THE WICKED HAVE DRAWN THE SWORD AND HAVE BENT THEIR BOW, TO CAST DOWN THE POOR AND NEEDY, TO SLAY THOSE WHO ARE OF UPRIGHT CONDUCT** (*The Lord told us that in this Day they will do this - Mt. 24:20 and Mk. 13:18.*) ¹⁵**THEIR SWORD SHALL ENTER THEIR OWN HEART, AND THEIR BOWS SHALL BE BROKEN** (*The Lord is saying that the words that they have spoken will be the punishment that comes upon them. In other words, when Prince Philip of the UK said that he wanted to return as a virus to kill 95% of the people upon the earth, then it is likely that the Lord is going to destroy him with terrible viruses so that all the world will know of his wicked end. Likewise, when Henry Kissinger said that military men are just worthless pawns to be used for the purposes of the elite, then it is likely that his death will come by torture from the hands of many former military men who were under his hand. When Obama allowed people to call him to be like a god, then it is likely that the Lord will strike him in the same manner that he struck King Herod wherein he was suddenly stricken and eaten from the inside out by worms. Likewise when the Rothschild family say that they are like a god over the earth and that they can do what they will without the fear of the armies and peoples of a nation, then their children are*

likely to see the same reduction to eating grass like the cattle in the field as like occurred to King Nebuchadnezzar.) ¹⁶**A LITTLE THAT A RIGHTEOUS MAN HAS IS BETTER THAN THE RICHES OF MANY WICKED.** (This is a very important instruction to us of this Day, for the Lord is saying that it is better to go into Battle with His Words and His Promises of Good Works that the Father placed within His Words, than to have any of the weapons and laws made by the arms of man, for in verse 17 He reveals that all these weapons and works of man for evil and for power, shall be destroyed and cut off. Their missiles are going to cease and their weapons will not fire, when those who Love Him become hearers and doers of His Words.) ¹⁷**FOR THE ARMS OF THE WICKED SHALL BE BROKEN, BUT THE LORD UPHOLDS THE RIGHTEOUS.** ¹⁸The LORD knows the days of the upright, and their inheritance shall be forever (We are now in the Appointed Time when the Righteous shall receive their inheritance of the Kingdom of God.). ¹⁹They shall not be ashamed in the evil time, and in the days of famine they shall be satisfied. ²⁰But the wicked shall perish; and the enemies of the LORD, like the splendor of the meadows, shall vanish. Into smoke they shall vanish away. ²¹The wicked borrows and does not repay, but the righteous shows mercy and gives. ²²For those blessed by Him shall inherit the earth, but those cursed by Him shall be cut off. ²³The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD, and He delights in his way. ²⁴Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down; for the LORD upholds him with His hand. ²⁵I have been young, and now am old; yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his descendants begging bread. ²⁶He is ever merciful, and lends; and his descendants are blessed. ²⁷Depart from evil, and do Good; and dwell forevermore. (This is such a wonderful Promise of the Lord.) ²⁸For the LORD loves justice, and does not forsake His saints; they are preserved forever (Consider what He has just revealed very carefully, and you will see your future that is at hand if you will be persistent to seek His Words and to do the Ways of His Words.), but the descendants of the wicked shall be cut off. ²⁹The righteous shall inherit the land, and dwell in it forever. (Here is the promise of the fulfillment of Daniel 2:44 that is now at hand, for it is for this very day - the Year of His Recompense - the Year that He brings forth His Elect to Light and turns them into children of God - the Saints of the Most High God.) ³⁰The mouth of the righteous speaks wisdom, and his tongue talks of justice. ³¹The Law of his God is in his heart (In Psalm 119:142 it becomes clear that this Law is to be a hearer of His Words and then going forth to be a doer of His Words); none of his steps shall slide. ³²The wicked watches the righteous, and seeks to slay him. ³³The LORD will not leave him in his hand, nor condemn him when he is judged. ³⁴Wait on the LORD, and keep His Way (We are to be hearers of His Words and then be doers of the Ways of Good so that we can enable Him to do His Good Works for others and for the bringing forth of His Kingdom of Light.), and He shall exalt you to inherit the land; when the wicked are cut off, you shall see it. ³⁵I have seen the wicked in great power, and spreading himself like a native green tree. ³⁶Yet he passed away, and behold, he was no more; indeed I sought him, but he could not be found. ³⁷Mark the blameless man, and observe the upright; for the future of that man is peace. ³⁸But the transgressors shall be destroyed together; the future of the wicked shall be cut off. ³⁹But the salvation of the righteous is from the LORD; He is their strength in the time of trouble. ⁴⁰And the LORD shall help them and deliver them; He shall deliver them from the wicked, and save them, because they trust in Him.

Last month we considered that the 23rd Psalm comes after the Psalm of the Promise of the Lord's overcoming the world. Thus, the 23rd Psalm is as it is a Promise of God to us for our overcoming of the world. Take notice that it is a Psalm that is set to the song of "The Deer of the Dawn." And it is a Psalm of David. Jesus is the Sun that rises as Dawn of the Morning. This now makes much more sense. In Psalm 19 David told us that the sun is the symbol of the Promise of the Way of the coming of the Bridegroom. In Isaiah 21:10-12 we are told that the Dawn of the Morning

comes at the same time as the Night. Such is the Promise of Psalm 23. There is a promised time when Jesus will rule over the nations before He destroys them who will not turn.

→ **Psalm 22:1-30** ¹My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me? Why are You so far from helping Me, and from the Words of My groaning? ²O My God, I cry in the daytime, but You do not hear; and in the night season, and am not silent. ³But You are holy, enthroned in the praises of Israel. ⁴Our fathers trusted in You; they trusted, and You delivered them. ⁵They cried to You, and were delivered; they trusted in You, and were not ashamed. ⁶But I am a worm, and no man; a reproach of men, and despised by the people. ⁷All those who see Me ridicule Me; they shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying, ⁸"He trusted in the LORD, let Him rescue Him; let Him deliver Him, since He delights in Him!" ⁹But You are He who took Me out of the womb; You made Me trust while on My mother's breasts. ¹⁰I was cast upon You from birth. From My mother's womb You have been My God. ¹¹Be not far from Me, for trouble is near; for there is none to help. ¹²Many bulls have surrounded Me; strong bulls of Bashan have encircled Me. (*Consider the meaning of Bashan is "in the tooth", or "in ivory". Solomon's throne had ivory. It is symbolic of the words spoken to be of the root of Truth. In this case this is revealing that the strong bulls of Bashan are the priests and leaders of the people of Israel who would crucify Him and justify it with their false words, claiming that it was for the Glory of God. Because they did not know His words they could not discern the knowledge of this verse, and it is a testimony against their lack of knowledge and foolish wisdom.*) ¹³They gape at Me with their mouths, like a raging and roaring lion. ¹⁴I am poured out like water, and all My bones are out of joint; My heart is like wax; it has melted within Me. ¹⁵My strength is dried up like a potsherd, and My tongue clings to My jaws; You have brought Me to the dust of death. ¹⁶For dogs have surrounded Me; the congregation of the wicked has enclosed Me. They pierced My hands and My feet; ¹⁷I can count all My bones. They look and stare at Me. ¹⁸They divide My garments among them, and for My clothing they cast lots. ¹⁹But You, O LORD, do not be far from Me; O My Strength, hasten to help Me! ²⁰Deliver Me from the sword, My precious life from the power of the dog. ²¹Save Me from the lion's mouth and from the horns of the wild oxen! You have answered Me. ²²I will declare Your name to My brethren; in the midst of the assembly I will praise You. ²³You who fear the LORD, praise Him! All you descendants of Jacob, glorify Him, and fear Him, all you offspring of Israel! ²⁴For He has not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; nor has He hidden His face from Him; but when He cried to Him, He heard. ²⁵My praise shall be of You in the great assembly; I will pay My vows before those who fear Him. ²⁶The poor shall eat and be satisfied; those who seek Him will praise the LORD. Let your heart live forever! ²⁷**ALL THE ENDS OF THE WORLD SHALL REMEMBER AND TURN TO THE LORD, AND ALL THE FAMILIES OF THE NATIONS SHALL WORSHIP BEFORE YOU.** ²⁸**FOR THE KINGDOM IS THE LORD'S, AND HE RULES OVER THE NATIONS.** ²⁹**ALL THE PROSPEROUS OF THE EARTH SHALL EAT AND WORSHIP; ALL THOSE WHO GO DOWN TO THE DUST SHALL BOW BEFORE HIM, EVEN HE WHO CANNOT KEEP HIMSELF ALIVE.** ³⁰**A POSTERITY SHALL SERVE HIM. IT WILL BE RECOUNTED OF THE LORD TO THE NEXT GENERATION,** ³¹**THEY WILL COME AND DECLARE HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS TO A PEOPLE WHO WILL BE BORN, THAT HE HAS DONE THIS.**

Likewise the 24th Psalm that follows the 23rd Psalm confirms of the Kingdom of Glory of the King of Glory.

→ **Psalm 24:1-10** ¹The earth is the LORD's, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein. ²For He has founded it upon the seas, and established it upon the waters. ³Who may ascend into the hill of the LORD? Or who may stand in His holy place? ⁴He who has clean hands and a pure heart, who has not lifted up his soul to an idol, nor sworn deceitfully. ⁵He shall receive blessing from the LORD, and righteousness from the God of his salvation. ⁶This is Jacob, the generation of those who seek Him, who seek Your face. Selah.

⁷Lift up your heads, O you gates! And be lifted up, you everlasting doors! And the King of glory shall come in. ⁸Who is this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle. ⁹Lift up your heads, O you gates! Lift up, you everlasting doors! And the King of glory shall come in. ¹⁰Who is this King of glory? The LORD of hosts, He is the King of glory. Selah
