"Your Right On Time In My Time"

March 9, 2011: You are My anointed, and I have raised you up to do all that is in My heart and in My mind. Your faithfulness goes before you in the spiritual realm to establish the way of favor. Hindrances have to give way to the light of those who walk upright and go forth with integrity and humility. You belong to Me and are My chosen, says the Lord.

Psalms 84:5 Blessed is the man whose strength is in You, whose heart is set on pilgrimage.

THE LOVE OF GOD FOR HIS PEOPLE NEVER FAILS

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 9, 2011

While reading Psalm 13, I was impressed to send you a few words of encouragement I have gleaned from this blessed chapter.

David penned the words contained in this Psalm. He asked, "How long will you forget me, Lord? Forever? How long will you hide your face from me? How long shall I have sorrow in my heart daily? How long will the enemy be exalted over me?"

It sounds as if David felt that God had altogether left him to suffer, to wake up each day with a black cloud hanging over him. For a season, David spoke out of despair: "God, will this feeling of isolation go on forever? When will my prayers be answered?"

When troubles assail us though we know we love the Lord - when deliverance seems distant and hopeless - we sink under the pressure. Right now, someone reading these words is sinking under the awful pressure of a situation that seems to be unsolvable. They are on the verge of total despair, hoping a calm will come if only for a break in their trial.

In the midst of his own trial, David asked, "How long shall I take counsel in my soul?" He had formed one plan after another, trying to devise ways out of his trouble - but all his plans, all arrangements, had failed. Now he had nothing else to think of, no workable solution. He was at the end of it all.

How upsetting it is to see a ray of hope, a bit of sunshine, but then despair once again sets in. Keep in mind, this all happened to a godly man, someone after God's heart. David was a man who testified of having great trust in the Lord. Yet, like us, David went through hard times, as he describes in this Psalm.

How did David arise from this pit of despair? "I will trust in your mercy... I will sing."

Let me share with you reasons to keep trusting your way through your present trials:

- No matter how the storms may rage, our precious Lord will still be feeding the fowls of the air, dressing the lilies of the field, and supplying an ocean full of fish with their daily needs. "Your heavenly Father feedeth them..." Not one bird ever falls to the ground without the Father's eye upon it.

- What kind of Father would feed all the creatures of the earth and yet neglect his children? Jesus exhorted us to "give no thought" to everyday needs and problems, "for he careth for you."

Truly, the Lord loves you, and he will not turn a deaf ear to your cries. Hold on to his promises. Move on in faith. Wait on him patiently. He will never fail you.

Let us consider the depth of the meaning of David in Psalm 13. In many ways it is like the wait that we have faced. But, consider the importance of the eye salve of verse 3. It is comparable to Revelation 3:16-22. This is a parable that explains the choice we must make to set ourselves apart from our own words and our own ways - doing what we believe in our minds is correct (Verse 2), and to repent and become zealous to seek Him and that we must ask the Lord to open our eyes through correction of our faults at seeing His Works and discerning the Promises in His Words. He pours out His Spirit and causes His Words (Thus, His Works - Ps. 33:4, Ps. 119:160, and John 17:17) to be made known to us (Proverbs 1:23).

→ **Psalm 13:1-6** ¹How long, O LORD? Will You forget me forever? How long will You hide Your face from me? ²How long shall I take counsel in my soul, having sorrow in my heart daily? How long will my enemy be exalted over me? ³Consider and hear me, O LORD my God; enlighten my eyes, lest I sleep the sleep of death; ⁴lest my enemy say, "I have prevailed against him"; lest those who trouble me rejoice when I am moved. ⁵But I have trusted in Your mercy; my heart shall rejoice in Your salvation. ⁶I will sing to the LORD, because He has dealt bountifully with me.

The same issue of Psalm 13 is the issue of Rev. 3:14-22 - the 7th church. The work of the 7th Spirit is the work of the review of His Works - like the 7th Day of Creation works. We have failed to discern the Ways of His words and how He does His Good Works. Thus we do not have the knowledge of Truth and therefore we are lukewarm and about to be cast out - disapproved in the Faith (2 Tim. 3:1-9, Prov. 1:24-36). Consider the seriousness of the eyes and the eye salve. Consider what is the meaning of the 7th church. It means that the people of these days have had the full testimony of all the seven spirits and the seven major works of the Lord for His church, and thus this generation, with all the testimony of God's blessings, is found to be without excuses for their lukewarm walk before the Lord.

→ **Revelation 3:14-22** ¹⁴And to the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write, 'These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness (He is the Witness to the Promises of God that is given to us within His Words), the Beginning of the creation of God (Take note that He is testifying He was the beginning of the Creation, and since He is "the Word", the Lord was created with the Words, and at the same time as the Words and it was at the first of the Creation). ¹⁵**I KNOW YOUR WORKS, THAT YOU ARE NEITHER COLD NOR HOT. I COULD WISH YOU WERE COLD OR HOT.** ¹⁶**SO THEN, BECAUSE YOU ARE LUKEWARM, AND NEITHER COLD NOR HOT, I WILL VOMIT YOU OUT OF MY MOUTH.** ¹⁷**BECAUSE YOU SAY, 'I AM RICH, HAVE BECOME WEALTHY, AND HAVE NEED OF NOTHING' --AND DO NOT KNOW THAT YOU ARE WRETCHED, MISERABLE, POOR, BLIND, AND NAKED--** ¹⁸**I COUNSEL YOU TO BUY FROM ME GOLD REFINED IN THE FIRE, THAT YOU MAY BE RICH; AND WHITE GARMENTS, THAT YOU MAY BE CLOTHED, THAT THE SHAME OF YOUR NAKEDNESS MAY NOT BE REVEALED; AND ANOINT YOUR EYES WITH EYE SALVE, THAT YOU MAY SEE.** ¹⁹As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Therefore be zealous and repent. ²⁰Behold, I stand at the door and knock. **If anyone hears My Voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.** (Class, please pay attention to what He is saying. YOU must open the Door to Him - to His Words - first.)

²¹To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne (*This is likened to being in His house in the Time of the Night.*), as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne. ²²He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches."

- **Isaiah 60:1-3** "Arise, shine; for your light has come, and the glory of the LORD has risen upon you. For behold, darkness will cover the earth, and deep darkness the peoples; but the LORD will rise upon you, and His glory will appear upon you. And nations will come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your rising." (*He will first rise in His Glory of His Throne and rule over the Heavens for Good.*)
- **Ecclesiastes 7:11** "Wisdom is Good with an inheritance, and profitable to those who see the Sun." (*He will appear as like the Sun.*)
- **Psalms 119:130** The Entrance of Your Words Gives Light; It gives Understanding to the Simple. (*Full of Light = Full of His Words.*)
- **Matthew 6:22** "The lamp of the body is the eye. If therefore your eye is Good, your whole body will be full of Light.
- **Luke 11:34** "The lamp of the body is the eye. Therefore, when your eye is good, your whole body also is full of light. But when your eye is bad, your body also is full of darkness. (*The Sun is on a path set by the Father - it reveals Him. We are not of God if we do not hear His Words.*)
- **Proverbs 13:9** "The light of the righteous rejoices, but the lamp of the wicked will be put out." (*His Words enable His Promises.*)
- **Proverbs 15:30** "The light of the eyes rejoices the heart, and a Good report makes the bones healthy."
- **Proverbs 6:23** For the commandment is a lamp, and the Law a Light; reproofs of instruction are the way of life, (*Ps. 119:130, 142*)
- **Zephaniah 1:12** **"AND IT SHALL COME TO PASS AT THAT TIME THAT I WILL SEARCH JERUSALEM WITH LAMPS, AND PUNISH THE MEN."** (SEE BELOW - AFTER THESE VERSES).
- **Zephaniah 1:1-18** ¹The Word of the LORD which came to Zephaniah the son of Cushi, the son of Gedaliah, the son of Amariah, the son of Hezekiah, in the days of Josiah the son of Amon, king of Judah. ²"I will utterly consume everything from the face of the land," Says the LORD; ³"I will consume man and beast; I will consume the birds of the heavens, the fish of the sea (*Symbolic of His Words that He is taking away from us - Amos 8:11*), and the stumbling blocks along with the wicked. I will cut off man from the face of the land," says the LORD. ⁴"I will stretch out My hand against Judah, and against all the inhabitants of Jerusalem. I will cut off every trace of Baal from this place, the names of the idolatrous priests with the pagan priests — ⁵Those who worship the host of heaven on the housetops; those who worship and swear oaths by the LORD, but who also swear by Milcom; ⁶those who have turned back from following the LORD, and have not sought the LORD, nor inquired of Him." ⁷Be silent in the presence of the Lord GOD; for the day of the LORD is at hand, for the LORD has prepared a sacrifice; He has invited His guests. ⁸"And it shall be, in the day of the LORD's sacrifice, that I will punish the princes and the king's children, and all such as are clothed with foreign apparel. ⁹In the same day I will punish all those who leap over the threshold, who fill their masters' houses with violence and deceit. ¹⁰"And there shall be on that day," says the LORD, "The sound of a mournful cry from the Fish Gate, a wailing from the Second Quarter, and a loud crashing from the hills. ¹¹Wail, you inhabitants of Maktesh! For all the merchant people are cut down; all those who handle money are cut off. ¹²"And it shall come to pass at that time That I will search Jerusalem with lamps, and punish the men who are settled in complacency, who say in their heart, 'The LORD will not do good, nor will He do evil.' ¹³ Therefore their goods shall become booty, And their houses a desolation; they shall build houses, but not inhabit them; They shall plant vineyards, but not drink their wine." ¹⁴The great day of the LORD is near; it is near and hastens quickly. The noise of the day of the LORD is bitter; there the mighty men shall cry out. ¹⁵That day is a day of wrath, a day

of trouble and distress, a day of devastation and desolation, a day of darkness and gloominess, a day of clouds and thick darkness, ¹⁶a day of trumpet and alarm against the fortified cities and against the high towers. ¹⁷"I will bring distress upon men, and they shall walk like blind men, because they have sinned against the LORD; their blood shall be poured out like dust, and their flesh like refuse."

¹⁸Neither their silver nor their gold shall be able to deliver them in the day of the LORD's wrath; but the whole land shall be devoured by the fire of His jealousy, for He will make speedy riddance of all those who dwell in the land.

Let us consider carefully the words of Zechariah 13, for they are for the times of the coming months, immediately after the Lord has appeared as the King of kings ruling over the heavens with a rod of iron.

→ **Zechariah 13:1-9** ¹In that day a fountain shall be opened for the house of David and for the inhabitants of Jerusalem, for sin and for uncleanness. ²"It shall be in that day," says the Lord of hosts, "that I will cut off the names of the idols from the land, and they shall no longer be remembered. I will also cause the prophets and the unclean spirit to depart from the land. ³It shall come to pass that if anyone still prophesies, then his father and mother who begot him will say to him, 'You shall not live, because you have spoken lies in the name of the Lord.' And his father and mother who begot him shall thrust him through when he prophesies. ⁴"**And it shall be in that day that every prophet will be ashamed of his vision when he prophesies; they will not wear a robe of coarse hair to deceive. ⁵But he will say, 'I am no prophet, I am a farmer; for a man taught me to keep cattle from my youth.'** ⁶And one will say to him, 'What are these wounds between your arms?' Then he will answer, 'Those with which I was wounded in the house of my friends.'
⁷"**AWAKE, O SWORD, AGAINST MY SHEPHERD, AGAINST THE MAN WHO IS MY COMPANION," SAYS THE LORD OF HOSTS. "STRIKE THE SHEPHERD, AND THE SHEEP WILL BE SCATTERED; THEN I WILL TURN MY HAND AGAINST THE LITTLE ONES."** ⁸**AND IT SHALL COME TO PASS IN ALL THE LAND," SAYS THE LORD, "THAT TWO-THIRDS IN IT SHALL BE CUT OFF AND DIE, BUT ONE-THIRD SHALL BE LEFT IN IT: ⁹I WILL BRING THE ONE-THIRD THROUGH THE FIRE** (*The Compelling Event that is bringing the awakening of His Words by the manifestation of the truth of His anger and jealousy, then His answers to His Words*), **WILL REFINED THEM AS SILVER IS REFINED, AND TEST THEM AS GOLD IS TESTED. They will call on My Name** (*Revelation 19:13 tells you that His Name in this very time is the "Word of God"*), **AND I WILL ANSWER THEM. I will say, 'This is My people'; and each one will say, 'The Lord is my God.'**"

An interesting Psalm 84 of the sons of Korah regarding the blessedness of dwelling in the "House of God" in the Day of the Harvest Judgment, when the Lord searches out all people by their lamp - Zeph. 1:12.

→ **Psalm 84:1-12** ¹How lovely is Your tabernacle, O LORD of hosts! ²My soul longs, yes, even faints for the courts of the LORD; my heart and my flesh cry out for the living God. ³Even the sparrow has found a home, and the swallow a nest for herself, where she may lay her young— even Your altars, O LORD of hosts, my King and my God. ⁴Blessed are those who dwell in Your house; they will still be praising You. Selah. ⁵Blessed is the man whose strength is in You, whose heart is set on pilgrimage. ⁶As they pass through the Valley of Baca (*The valley of the Mulberry-Tree. This means the valley of inspection when the Lord comes for the Harvest Judgment. The place where the Lord came to Abraham just prior to the Lord and His two witnesses going forth to inspect Sodom and Gomorrah.*), they make it a spring; the rain also covers it with pools. ⁷They go from strength to strength; each one appears before God in Zion. ⁸O LORD God of hosts, hear my prayer; give ear, O God of Jacob! Selah. ⁹O God, behold our shield, and look upon the face of Your anointed. ¹⁰For a day in Your courts is better than a thousand. I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of wickedness.

¹¹For the LORD God is a sun and shield; the LORD will give grace and glory; no Good thing will He withhold from those who walk uprightly. ¹²O LORD of hosts, blessed is the man who trusts in You!

Christ Crucified; Spiritual Wisdom

→ **1 Corinthians 2:1-16** ¹And I, brethren, when I came to you, did not come with excellence of speech or of wisdom declaring to you the testimony of God. ²For I determined not to know anything among you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified. ³I was with you in weakness, in fear, and in much trembling. ⁴And my speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, ⁵that your faith should not be in the wisdom of men but in the power of God. ⁶However, we speak wisdom among those who are mature, yet not the wisdom of this age, nor of the rulers of this age, who are coming to nothing. ⁷But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, the hidden wisdom which God ordained before the ages for our glory, ⁸which none of the rulers of this age knew; for had they known, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory. ⁹**BUT AS IT IS WRITTEN: "EYE HAS NOT SEEN, NOR EAR HEARD, NOR HAVE ENTERED INTO THE HEART OF MAN THE THINGS WHICH GOD HAS PREPARED FOR THOSE WHO LOVE HIM."** ¹⁰But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God. ¹¹For what man knows the things of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so no one knows the things of God except the Spirit of God. ¹²Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God. ¹³These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual. ¹⁴But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. ¹⁵But he who is spiritual judges all things, yet he himself is rightly judged by no one. ¹⁶For "who has known the mind of the LORD that he may instruct Him?" But we have the mind of Christ.

Consider that Paul is taking Scripture from Isaiah's prayer for help on those who will seek Him after He strikes the Temple. This is what is coming very soon, likely in April. Will we do what Isaiah, in the Way of wisdom, instructs us to do?

→ **Isaiah 64:1-12** ¹Oh, that You would rend the heavens! That You would come down! That the mountains might shake at Your presence—²as fire burns brushwood, as fire causes water to boil—to make Your name known to Your adversaries, that the nations may tremble at Your presence! ³When You did awesome things for which we did not look, You came down, the mountains shook at Your presence. ⁴For since the beginning of the world men have not heard nor perceived by the ear, nor has the eye seen any God besides You, who acts for the one who waits for Him. ⁵You meet him who rejoices and does righteousness, who remembers You in Your ways. You are indeed angry, for we have sinned (*Consider Zech. 10:3, for example*) — in these ways we continue; and we need to be saved. ⁶But we are all like an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are like filthy rags; **WE ALL FADE AS A LEAF**, (*This means that we lose our water of the Spirit, we dry up, and we fall off the tree because of our sins.*), and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away. ⁷And there is no one who calls on Your name, who stirs himself up to take hold of You; for You have hidden Your face from us, and have consumed us because of our iniquities. ⁸But now, O LORD, You are our Father; we are the clay, and You our potter; and all we are the work of Your hand. ⁹Do not be furious, O LORD, nor remember iniquity forever; indeed, please look—we all are Your people! ¹⁰Your holy cities are a wilderness, Zion is a wilderness, Jerusalem a desolation. ¹¹Our holy and beautiful temple, where our fathers praised You, is burned up with fire; and all our pleasant things are laid waste. ¹²Will You restrain Yourself because of these things, O LORD? Will You hold Your peace, and afflict us very severely?

Paul also refers to Isaiah 40, and in that chapter, Isaiah is revealing a call from the Lord to go forth and comfort His people AFTER He has dealt with them, paying them back double for their sins, and they have repented and turned back to Him. The Lord says that then they will turn and receive the knowledge of truth - the message of the Father has sent and had it cried out in the Wilderness - cried out to a rebellious and blindly lost people.

The Majesty of the LORD

→ **Isaiah 40:1-31** ¹"Comfort, yes, comfort My people!" Says your God. ²"Speak comfort to Jerusalem, and cry out to her, that her warfare is ended, that her iniquity is pardoned; for she has received from the LORD's hand double for all her sins." ³The voice of one crying in the wilderness: "Prepare the way of the LORD; make straight in the desert a highway for our God. ⁴Every valley shall be exalted and every mountain and hill brought low; the crooked places shall be made straight and the rough places smooth; ⁵**THE GLORY OF THE LORD SHALL BE REVEALED, AND ALL FLESH SHALL SEE IT TOGETHER; FOR THE MOUTH OF THE LORD HAS SPOKEN.**" ⁶The voice said, "Cry out!" And he said, "What shall I cry?" "All flesh is grass, and all its loveliness is like the flower of the field. ⁷The grass withers, the flower fades, because the breath of the LORD blows upon it; surely the people are grass. ⁸The grass withers, the flower fades, but the Word of our God stands forever." ⁹**O ZION, YOU WHO BRING GOOD TIDINGS, GET UP INTO THE HIGH MOUNTAIN; O JERUSALEM, YOU WHO BRING GOOD TIDINGS, LIFT UP YOUR VOICE WITH STRENGTH, LIFT IT UP, BE NOT AFRAID; SAY TO THE CITIES OF JUDAH, "BEHOLD YOUR GOD!"** ¹⁰Behold, the Lord GOD shall come with a strong hand, and His arm shall rule for Him; behold, His reward is with Him, and His work before Him. ¹¹He will feed His flock like a shepherd; He will gather the lambs with His arm, and carry them in His bosom, and gently lead those who are with young. ¹²Who has measured the waters in the hollow of His hand, measured heaven with a span and calculated the dust of the earth in a measure? Weighed the mountains in scales and the hills in a balance? ¹³Who has directed the Spirit of the LORD, or as His counselor has taught Him? ¹⁴With whom did He take counsel, and who instructed Him, and taught Him in the path of justice? Who taught Him knowledge, and showed Him the way of understanding? ¹⁵Behold, the nations are as a drop in a bucket, and are counted as the small dust on the scales; look, He lifts up the isles as a very little thing. ¹⁶And Lebanon is not sufficient to burn, nor its beasts sufficient for a burnt offering. ¹⁷All nations before Him are as nothing, and they are counted by Him less than nothing and worthless. ¹⁸To whom then will you liken God? Or what likeness will you compare to Him? ¹⁹**The workman molds an image, the goldsmith overspreads it with gold, and the silversmith casts silver chains.** ²⁰Whoever is too impoverished for such a contribution chooses a tree that will not rot; He seeks for himself a skillful workman to prepare a carved image that will not totter. ²¹**HAVE YOU NOT KNOWN? HAVE YOU NOT HEARD? HAS IT NOT BEEN TOLD YOU FROM THE BEGINNING? HAVE YOU NOT UNDERSTOOD FROM THE FOUNDATIONS OF THE EARTH?** ²²It is He who sits above the circle of the earth, and its inhabitants are like grasshoppers, who stretches out the heavens like a curtain, and spreads them out like a tent to dwell in. ²³He brings the princes to nothing; He makes the judges of the earth useless. ²⁴Scarcely shall they be planted, scarcely shall they be sown, scarcely shall their stock take root in the earth, when He will also blow on them, and they will wither, and the whirlwind will take them away like stubble. ²⁵"To whom then will you liken Me, or to whom shall I be equal?" says the Holy One. ²⁶Lift up your eyes on high, and see who has created these things, Who brings out their host by number; He calls them all by name, by the greatness of His might and the strength of His power; not one is missing. ²⁷Why do you say, O Jacob, and speak, O Israel: "My way is hidden from the LORD, and my just claim is passed over by my God"? ²⁸Have you not known? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth, neither faints nor is weary. His understanding is

unsearchable. ²⁹He gives power to the weak, and to those who have no might He increases strength. ³⁰Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall, ³¹but those who wait on the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.

John the Baptist cried out just before the Lord did, and it is interesting He quoted the text of Isaiah 40, as follows in Luke 3. It was a similar way of the people as it is today.

- **Luke 3:1-6** ¹Now in the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius (*This name means, son of "Tiber", but, it is also used as "Tiberias" as in the Sea of Tiberias, and that means "good vision" or "navel"*) Caesar (*This name is believed to mean "head of hair"*), Pontius (*This name means "the sea"*) Pilate (*This name means "armed with a dart"*) being governor of Judea (*This name means "praise of the Lord", "confession"*), Herod (*This name means "son of a hero"*) being tetrarch of Galilee (*This name means "wheel", "circuit", or "compass"*), his brother Philip (*This name means "warlike", or "lover of horses"*) tetrarch of Iturea (*This name means "guarded", or "mountainous"*) and the region of Trachonitis (*This name means "stony"*), and Lysanias (*This name means "that drives away sorrow"*) tetrarch of Abilene (*This name means "the father of mourning"*), ²while Annas (*This name means "one who answers", or "humble"*) and Caiaphas (*This name means "he that seeks with diligence", or "one that vomits"*) were high priests, the Word of God came to John (*This name means "the grace or mercy of the Lord"*) the son of Zacharias (*This name means "the Lord remembers"*) in the wilderness. ³And he went into all the region around the Jordan, preaching a baptism of repentance for the remission of sins, ⁴as it is written in the book of the words of Isaiah the prophet, saying: "The voice of one crying in the wilderness: 'Prepare the way of the LORD; make His paths straight. ⁵Every valley shall be filled and every mountain and hill brought low; the crooked places shall be made straight and the rough ways smooth; ⁶And all flesh shall see the salvation of God.'"

Here are the verses using Tiberias. Take note that it is tied to the Sea of Galilee.

- **John 6:1** After these things Jesus went over the Sea of Galilee, which is the Sea of **Tiberias**.
- **John 6:23** however, other boats came from **Tiberias**, near the place where they ate bread after the Lord had given thanks—
- **John 21:1** After these things Jesus showed Himself again to the disciples at the Sea of **Tiberias**, and in this way He showed Himself:

John revealed what the Lord was about to do, even in this day, as we have done today about the Harvest warning.

- **Luke 3:7-20** ⁷Then he said to the multitudes that came out to be baptized by him, "Brood of vipers! Who warned you to flee from the wrath to come? ⁸Therefore bear fruits worthy of repentance, and do not begin to say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as our father.' For I say to you that God is able to raise up children to Abraham from these stones. ⁹And even now the ax is laid to the root of the trees. Therefore every tree which does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire." ¹⁰So the people asked him, saying, "What shall we do then?" ¹¹He answered and said to them, "He who has two tunics, let him give to him who has none; and he who has food, let him do likewise." ¹²Then tax collectors also came to be baptized, and said to him, "Teacher, what shall we do?" ¹³And he said to them, "Collect no more than what is appointed for you." ¹⁴Likewise the soldiers asked him, saying, "And what shall we do?" So he said to them, "Do not intimidate anyone or accuse falsely, and be content with your wages." ¹⁵Now as the people were in expectation, and all reasoned in their hearts about John, whether he was the Christ or not, ¹⁶John answered, saying to all, "I indeed baptize you with water; but One mightier than I is coming, whose sandal strap I am not worthy to loose. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. ¹⁷His winnowing fan is in His hand, and He will thoroughly clean out His threshing floor, and gather the wheat into His barn; but the chaff He will burn with unquenchable fire." ¹⁸And with many other exhortations he preached to the people. ¹⁹But Herod the

tetrarch, being rebuked by him concerning Herodias, his brother Philip's wife, and for all the evils which Herod had done, ²⁰also added this, above all, that he shut John up in prison.

→ **Ephesians 5:22-27, 32** ²²Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. ²³For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body. ²⁴Therefore, just as the church is subject to Christ, so *let the wives be* to their own husbands in everything. ²⁵Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, ²⁶**that He might sanctify** (*Set her apart as Holy can only come by the Word of Truth, as Jesus likewise did - John 17:17*) **and CLEANSE HER WITH THE WASHING OF WATER BY THE WORD,** ²⁷**THAT HE MIGHT PRESENT HER TO HIMSELF A GLORIOUS CHURCH, NOT HAVING SPOT OR WRINKLE OR ANY SUCH THING, BUT THAT SHE SHOULD BE HOLY AND WITHOUT BLEMISH.....** ³²This is a great mystery, but I speak concerning Christ and the church.

→ **Daniel 12:9-10** ⁹And He said, "Go your way, Daniel, for **the Words are closed up and sealed till the Time of the End.** ¹⁰**Many shall be purified, made white, and refined,** but the wicked shall do wickedly; and none of the wicked shall understand, **BUT THE WISE SHALL UNDERSTAND.**"

The Lord warns this church that is the 7th church (This means the church that has had the fullness of His Works of His Seen Spirits and therefore is appointed as being the Church of the fullness of His Appointed Time Harvest Judgment). You can see that this is the Church to be in place when He comes to rule over the Heavens and let them to eat of His food of Heaven and that they are to do the Righteous Acts that feeds Him with honor and Glory and makes the knowledge of His Glory to cover the earth as the waters covers the Sea - IS. 11:9, Hab. 2:14, Num. 14:21.).

Let us now look at the Lord's Way. In several books I have described John chapter 21 and how it shows His Way. But, also David gives us Psalm 107 that is an instruction in the Ways of the Lord. It is a great parable, just as the apostle John gives us a phenomenal parable of divine instruction in John chapter 21, in which He writes that this is the Way that the Lord manifested His Way - meaning that in this Way of His works in chapter 21 He revealed to them His Ways. Take notice that in verse 11 of Psalm 107 King David reveals that the ones who are punished by God are those who would not do two things: (1) receive the knowledge of the Words of God; and (2) would not obey the instructions of God, such as the ways of the Laws of Moses and the Ten Commandments. The second part is the counsel of God, while the first part is the Law of God (His Words are the summation - the entirety - of His Law - per Psalm 119:142 and Deuteronomy 18:18-19).

→ **Psalm 107:1-43** ¹**OH, GIVE THANKS TO THE LORD, FOR HE IS GOOD!** For His mercy endures forever. ²Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, whom He has redeemed from the hand of the enemy, ³and gathered out of the lands, from the east and from the west, from the north and from the south. ⁴They wandered in the wilderness in a desolate way; they found no city to dwell in. ⁵Hungry and thirsty, their soul fainted in them. ⁶Then they cried out to the LORD in their trouble, and He delivered them out of their distresses. ⁷And He led them forth by the right way, that they might go to a city for a dwelling place. ⁸Oh, that men would give thanks to the LORD for His goodness, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! ⁹For He satisfies the longing soul, and fills the hungry soul with goodness. ¹⁰Those who sat in darkness and in the shadow of death, bound in affliction and irons— ¹¹**BECAUSE THEY REBELLED AGAINST THE WORDS OF GOD, AND DESPISED THE COUNSEL OF THE MOST HIGH,** ¹²therefore He brought down their heart with labor; they fell down, and there was none to help. ¹³Then they cried out to the LORD in their trouble, and He saved them out of their distresses. ¹⁴He brought them out of darkness and the shadow of death, and broke their chains in pieces. ¹⁵Oh, that men would give thanks to the LORD for His goodness, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! ¹⁶For He has broken the gates of

- **Psalm 14:2-3, & Psalm 53:2-3** ²The Lord looks down from Heaven upon the children of men, to see if there are any who understand, **WHO SEEK GOD.** ³They have all turned aside, they have together become corrupt; **THERE IS NONE THAT DOES "GOOD", NO, NOT ONE.**
- **James 1:17** Every Good Gift and every perfect Gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of Lights (*David makes clear in Psalm 119:130 that it is the entrance of His Words that gives Light, and the Father created these set apart Words from before the foundations of the World.*), with whom there is no variance, neither shadow of turning (*This has the meaning that His Words never change and their Promises never depart from His Words. Therefore our key is to understand the Way of His Words and what is His Perfect Will, for that clearly releases His Good Works that are given to us as Promises within His Words.*)

Many analysts fear that if the crisis in Libya escalates or if the chaos in the Middle East spreads that we could see the all-time record of 147 dollars a barrel broken by the end of the year. That would be absolutely disastrous for the global economy.

But it isn't just the chaos in the Middle East that is driving oil prices. The truth is that oil prices have been moving upwards for months. The recent revolutions in the Middle East have only accelerated the trend.

Let's just hope that the "day of rage" being called for in Saudi Arabia later this month does not turn into a full-blown revolution like we have seen in other Middle Eastern countries. The Saudis keep a pretty tight grip on their people, but at this point anything is possible. A true revolution in Saudi Arabia would send oil prices into unprecedented territory very quickly.

But even without all of the trouble in the Middle East the world was already heading for an oil crunch. The global demand for oil is rising at a very vigorous pace. For example, last year Chinese demand for oil increased by almost 1 million barrels per day. That is absolutely staggering. The Chinese are now buying more new cars every year than Americans are, and so Chinese demand for oil is only going to continue to increase.

Much could be done to increase the global supply of oil, but so far our politicians and the major oil company executives are sitting on their hands. They seem to like the increasing oil prices.

So for now it looks like oil prices will continue to rise and this is going to result in much higher prices at the gas pump.

Already, ABC News is reporting that regular unleaded gasoline is going for \$5.29 a gallon at one gas station in Orlando, Florida.

The U.S. economy in particular is vulnerable to rising oil prices because our entire economic system is designed around cheap gasoline. If the price of gas goes up to 5 or 6 dollars a gallon and it stays there it is going to have a catastrophic effect on the U.S. economy.

Just remember what happened back in 2008. The price of oil hit an all-time high of \$147 a barrel and then a few months later the entire financial system had a major meltdown.

Well, as the price of oil rises it is going to create a whole lot of imbalances in the global financial system once again.

This is definitely a situation that we should all be watching.

But it is not just the price of oil that could cause a global economic disaster.

The global price of food could potentially be even more concerning. As you read this, there are about 3 billion people around the globe that live on the equivalent of 2 dollars a day or less. Those people cannot afford for food prices to go up much.

But global food prices **are** rising. According to the United Nations, the global price of food has risen for 8 consecutive months. Last month, the global price of food set a brand new all-time record high. Many are starting to fear that we could actually be in the early stages of a major global food crisis.

The price of just about every major agricultural commodity has been absolutely soaring during the past year....

*The price of corn has doubled over the last six months.

*The price of wheat has more than doubled over the past year.

*The price of soybeans is up about 50% since last June.

*The price of cotton has more than doubled over the past year.

*The commodity price of orange juice has doubled since 2009.

*The price of sugar is the highest it has been in 30 years.

Unfortunately, the production of food in most countries around the world is very highly dependent on oil, so as oil goes up in price this is going to make the food crisis even worse.

Hold on to your hats folks.

Also, as I have written about previously, the world is facing some very serious problems when it comes to water. Due to the greed of the global elite, there is not nearly enough fresh water to go around. The following are some very disturbing facts about the global water situation....

*Worldwide demand for fresh water tripled during the last century, and is now doubling every 21 years.

*According to USAID, one-third of all humans will face severe or chronic water shortages by the year 2025.

Our politicians and the global elite could be doing something about this if they really wanted to, but right now they seem perfectly fine with what is happening.

Could 'supermoon' next week disrupt Earth's weather?

Moon comes at its closest approach for 19 years

It promises a unique photo opportunity for amateur astronomers.

Earth will next week be at its closest point to the moon since 1992.

The March 19 event - known as a 'lunar perigee' - will see the moon pass just 221,567 miles away from our planet.

Earth will be at its closest point - some 221,567 miles away - to the moon in 19 years on March 19. Some fear the 'lunar perigee' will affect our climate pattern

But the Internet is awash with conspiracy-minded amateur scientists warning that such a 'supermoon' could disrupt Earth's climate patterns and may even cause earthquakes and volcanic activity.

Previous supermoons took place in 1955, 1974, 1992 and 2005 - all years that had extreme weather events.

The tsunami that killed hundreds of thousands of people in Indonesia happened two weeks before the January 2005 supermoon. And on Christmas Day 1974, Cyclone Tracy laid waste to Darwin, Australia.

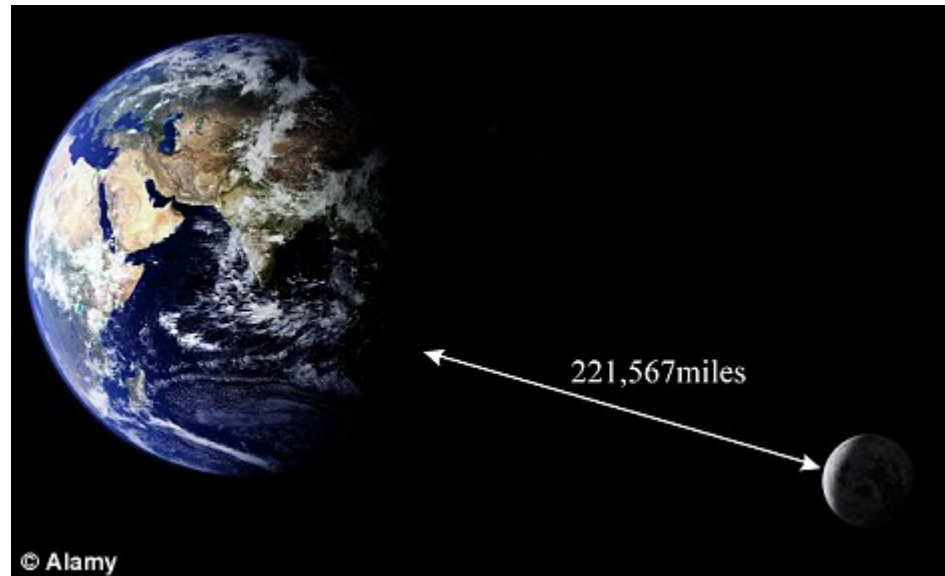

But Pete Wheeler of the International Centre for Radio Astronomy said to treat any warnings of an impending apocalypse with scepticism.

'There will be no earthquakes or volcanoes erupting, unless they are to happen anyway,' he told news.com.au.

'The Earth will experience just a lower than usual low tide and a higher than usual high tide around the time of the event, but nothing to get excited about.'

Australian astronomer David Reneke agrees, pointing out that conspiracy theorists will always be able to find a natural disaster to link to a certain time and blame it on a supermoon.





Whatever does or doesn't happen, we are still learning about the moon all the time.

In January, it emerged that signals from seismic sensors left on the lunar surface by Apollo astronauts in 1971 have revealed that the moon has a liquid core similar to Earth's.

Scientists at Nasa applied contemporary seismological techniques to the data being emitted from sensors placed by their colleagues during the U.S. space program's heyday.

The research suggested the moon possesses a solid, iron-rich inner core with a radius of nearly 150 miles and a fluid, primarily liquid-iron outer core with a radius of roughly 205 miles.

Where it differs from Earth is a partially molten boundary layer around the core estimated to have a radius of nearly 300 miles.

The data sheds light on the evolution of a lunar dynamo - a natural process by which our moon may have generated and maintained its own strong magnetic field.

He told the website: 'If you try hard enough you can chronologically associate almost any natural disaster or event to anything in the night sky - comet, planet, sun.

'Remember in the past, planetary alignments were going to pull the sun apart. It didn't happen. Astrologers draw a very long bow most times.
